Maintaining Trade: You don't have to list the trade partners that you want to maintain trade with in your orders.

A Quick Start Guide on How to Fill Out Your Army Movement Orders: This procedure was developed by Thomas Harlan after years of trial and error and I think is a clear and concise way to write down your leader actions.

- 1. Please write clearly.
- 2. List your movements in order. Army #1 first, then #2 on down. To understand what an Army # is look at your stat sheet. Your King is Army #1; your heir is #2; your first BL leader is #3, et cetra. (remember that when constructing new units which you wish to assign to your armies).
- 3. List both Army # and your leader stats with each block of movement orders.
- 4. List the starting contents of each army as well as the ending contents (as far as you can tell). Separate them using a slash (/) character.
- 5. If necessary add a short paragraph of explanation about whatever your army (or leader) is up to.
- 6. You don't have to list the monthly cost of your movement and actions on your orders. That's my job to deal with.

# THE REALM OF THE FLOWING SANDS (2.4C/B)

Kotakaeyo, Master of the Trade Caravans

The Trading Nation suffered even more when the Songhai Emir backstabbed Kotakaeyo and aided the enemy, the Quantified Governor, Habib. With their armies merged together, the new Songhai forces (so they called themselves) trampled the Sandy homeland of Mali and played some volleyball while sieging Timbuktu. Timbuktu's defender Duchado gave up after being denied barbecued goat dogs for three years (da da da "Fluffy fluffy eggs" da da dum "Do it with chicken"). Young Yatackko the heir and his lovely wife Olga have been taken prisoner by Habib. "They're so cute together, they make me sick!" With capital and homeland occupied, the governing apparatus was disabled. In the process, Garou, Marampa, Adawara and all the cases waved their homer hankies and were outta there. The claim on Susu was voided. Kotakeayo was chased to Sequiby the Rat Chief, angry his daughter is now in the hands of some ruffians. sparsely populated Kebbi, now separated form the rest, joined Songhai.

The Sandy treasury was taken as was the crown

The new famine has prolonged and deepened the depression.
