Role Playing: Get involved with your country, guys. Make your nation an interesting place. Be creative! It make for a much more interesting write up if (for example) your Emperor Snorkel opens hairdresser salons atop mountains.

Maintaining Trade: You don't have to list the trade partners that you want to maintain trade with in your orders.

Urban Battles: As demonstrated this turn in the battles of Liege and Paris this turn, I have developed a system for battles inside cities. A defending city acts like 5 field forts per City GPV. These will act to resist an invading army, especially if supported by a leader and an army. Cavalry units are more liable to being killed than ground troopers in the city. Urban Battles will destroy half of a city's PWB. If an invader conquers the city through Urban Warfare then the city will lose 1 GPV. Though it may sound masty, this may the last stand for a defender that has lost the city walls (or have no wells).

Internal Trade Fleet Income: On your order form, please add the income you get from internal fleet activity to the Inter-City Trade income.

A Culck Start Guide on How to Fill Out Your Army Movement Orders: This procedure was developed by Thomas Harlan after years of trial and error and I think is a clear and concise way to write down your leader actions.

- Please write clearly.
- 2. List your movements in order. Army #1 first, then #2 on down. To understand what an Army # is look at your stat sheet. Your King is Army #1; your heir is #2; your first BL leader is #3, et cetra. (remember that when constructing new units which you wish to assign to your armies).
- 3. List both Army # and your leader stats with each block of movement orders.
- List the starting contents of each army as well as the ending contents (as far as you can tell). Separate them using a slash (/) character.
- If necessary add a short paragraph of explanation about whatever your army (or leader) is up to.

Example:

#1 KBB Gaius Julius Caesar 100i / 80i 20c

From: Massilla

Via: Lugdunum (+20c), Helvetica

To: Cenabum [A] (-20i)

Orders: March north to crush the Gauls in Cenabum, picking up some cavalry in Lugdunum. Leave a garrison in Cenadum of 20i.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 500 specialists and requisite equipment. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning lots of ramparts, towers, walls. An auxiliary point = approximately 50 small platform boats with 5 man craws. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's meanest, most gnarty warriors.

THE REALM OF THE FLOWING SANDS (X)

The Sandy Realm could not defend itself against the obviously more-well-prepared-for-war Gaoti. King Kotakeayo was killed in Segu attempting to flee. Chazahud claimed all the king's titles including 'Lifeguard of Malibu' but the sorry dude was no better a lord than Kotakeayo. Golthuz II of Gambia restored total political autonomy. Niani and Khalem not wanting to side with a loser jumped off the bandwagon so they could help put the Flowing Sands out of business. Chazahud now with no kingdom to rule snuck his way to Accra to become an advisor to the Quantified Ones.

THE EMIRATE OF GAOTA (6.8C/B)

Kareem Abdul Habib, Emir of Gao, All Pro Center

DIPLOMACY: Adwaghost(t), Hausa(t to Quantity)

With no reservations, the Gaoti ignored the rich lands of Quantity to secure their backyard. To this end, King Habib and the Songhay army marched west for the spankling blue ocean. Even with cultivation, there were still plenty of swamps in Segu and that slowed the army down. After stomping muddy feet on the Sandy people, Segu had to pay protection. The same treatment was dished out to neutral Ghana (though the mud had flake off the feet by then). Habib successfully intimidated Adwaghost by threatening the salt trade. The Lion of Zion, he build bigger cities. Jerusalem, yeahmon, that town be bigger. Aqaba, that place got more huts in it now. Hey, old Scubi died after 54 years, that's 324 in dog years. They buried him in the pet cemetery.

The newest Barbary port, Algiers, was formed out of pure energy in Algeria. Pirates and corsairs now have a new safe harbor to mess around in. Young Husayn was too young to travel in a dangerous world. The legion of six-foot-telepathic-cockroaches are screwing about in the dark yet again.

THE GAIDHEALTACHD NA EIRE (2.4B/G)

Vercin ui Niall, High King of the Emerald Islands, Lorde of Magryn Keepe

Trade Partners: none DIPLOMACY: Mercia(t)

King Vercin chose to resist those Saxon mongrels when the Duke's War spread to the emerald islands. Even as Saxon knights skipped their way across Britain, Vercin was preparing for his sneaky, canny plan. In August of 1173, Cardinal Bishop Gregory, a papal legate working for the Saxons, was patrolling the Irish Sea with 130 galleys when from out of the fog appeared 70 cargo ships, 20 galleys, all carrying 11,500 barbarians. The Irish raiders grappled with the Saxon ships and started wailing upon the galley rowers. 50 Saxon ships were rendered useless and the other 50 were captured by the Celts, before the good bishop decided it was a good time to flee. He ported in Comwall and visited the local chapels, wearing green so he wouldn't get pinched. Lothian, neutral Lancaster, Northumbria and Mercia were taken by the dusky Saxon knights. Of these, Mercia was revisited by the High King. Mercia cheered them and threw shamrocks at the Irish liberators. The county pledged their half pences to Magwyn Keepe. Lord Vercin and his 4500 archers, 2500 lancers and 4500 mace-wielding cavalry stopped by Sussex itself to fill up with unleaded. He was immediately contested by Edgar of Kent with 5000 horse macemen and 1000 jousting knights. They had all rode like hell from Lothian just to protect the homeland from being sullied. Too late, the Irish had already messed up the nicely manicured lawns and were now whipping themselves up into some kind of frenzy. To Edgar's dismay the Irish were twice as tough as his own allotment and were trounced. Edgar was hurt but managed to slip away to hide within London's wafer thin walls. Endless waves of maddened Celts pushed down the cardboard defenses and swarmed into London itself. Edgar died and his dead body was thrown into the Thames. Once the Irish got their grubby hands on London, they sacked it so they could buy more ale.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA (18.8C/VG)

Robert the Great, King of the Sexons and of the Normans

Trade Partners: Mahidia, Andalus, Thaery', Francia, Russia--, Byzantion-DIPLOMACY: Poitou(a)

Charles of Flanders with one of the greatest armies on the continent was wounded by an archer and had to sit the entire turn out. The Danes, however, didn't seem to miss him. King Robert moved to Neustria ('Neustria pretty much corresponds to Northern France, or the France controlled by Saxonia) and took command of the Poitou encampment. He was angered when he heard that he was outbid substantially by the Flemish for the Knights who Say 'Nyeh'. he moved anyway to Brittany and joined with the Bretenage and forced tribute from Maine, sweeping aside the Nyeh Knights on the way. In England, a Saxon army got Mercia, Northumbria, Lancaster and Lothian to pay tribute. King Robert then entered lie de France intending to collect some tribute there too. The Bretenage withdrew their forces muttering something about "not wanting to fight anymore". Robert found the Flemish defenders hiding in Paris itself so the Great King went into town to root these devils out. And so Lords of the Earth's very first Urban Battle was fought. Lemant of Maine had rallied the Parisians (an unruly mob, originally descended from Celtic stock) to resist the invaders. They threw rocks, sticks, bricks, dead cats, old shoes and shit on King Robert's shiny armored army. The cavalry were especially vulnerable in urban settings and were easily picked off mostly by drunken labourers. Robert held firm and gained control of Paris when Lemarc was killed in a sword duel in a nobleman's garden. This spared Paris from really being harrowed. The Duke - remember the Duke? He's the guy with the black hat - regained control of Languedoc and it was up to Richard the Norman to drive him out. Richard was outflanked right from the start and suffered a total, humiliating loss in battle. He fled back to Armagnac and attended seminars on self motivation to regain his net positive ego feedback. Edgar was having his way in Britain until he heard the Irish were trashing Sussex but he got creamed. The loss and sack of London was catastrophic, the government was crippled. Lothian, Lancaster, Northumbria and Cornwall revolted. The London based shipping moved to Gotham under Danish escort.

THE SLAMMED DUCHY OF FLANDERS (3.6C/G)

Michael Baldwin, Dux Flanderium, Most Misunderstood Man in Europe Trade Partners: Mahidia-, Byzantion--

DIPLOMACY: Brittany(ea to Saxony)

The Flemish tried to make a comeback but in many theatres were harnstrung and incapable of defense. Furthermore, they didn't have the cash that they thought they could get away with. The Flemish armies were also scattered all over the map and so it was easy to pick them off one by one. In April of 1171, Rinaldo of Lyonnais after being entertained by the Swedish Bilkini Team revolted from Flanders and attacked the Duke ("Things can't get much better than this"). But Rinaldo's 29,000 knights were no match to the Dukes

combined arms of 25,500. Rinaldo was killed (he died happy) and the Duke was wounded. Lyonnais had to be pacified. Michael now waited for the Graf of Swabia to cross the Alps from Italy and carry out his will on the Riviera. Reinhart arrived in July 1173 and soon after tributized Languedoc and reduced Séte. There was an abortive raid on Catalonia that occured right before the Saxons arrival. Richard the Norman with Saxon troops were beaten by Reinhart's Italians and so Flanders, at least in the south, was able to hold its own. In the north things just weren't cool. Maine and France were conquered and the ally from Maine died. Brabant, Holland and Friesland capitulated to the Nordiks. Hesse fell to the Francians.

THE ALMORAVAID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA (10.0C/G)

Azim. Emir as Sevilla

Trade Partners: Mahdia, Saxon, Liguria~, Byzantion*

DIPLOMACY: Merrakesh(a), Talavera(a)

The Almoravids suffered a governmental shake-up when Abu Nurab died. Beg all Buney proclaimed himself an Emir but became irrelevant when Salamanca and Leon revolted. Stimpy Alum and the Cap'n of Toledo held the land together for their new ruler, Azim

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH (1.8C/VB)

Urban III, Pope of Rome, Vicar of Christ, God's Chancellor Upon This Earth Trade Partners: 1000e

DIPLOMACY: Amiata(h), Orcia(h), Cecina(h), Pisa(c), Marche(h), Chiana(h)

The Pope hiked through central Italy and angered many important (soon to be excommunicated) people, he returned to Rome and issued this statement:

To the people of Europe: As of the day of Christ's Mass in the Year of Our Lord one thousand one hundred seventy five, I invoke, in Jesus' name, the Pax Vatica. Let no man raise his sword against one of the fold of the Holy Mother Church, else he and all who follow him be damned to eternal torment. People, I say to you: Follow your liege, and his vision, as you follow thine own right eye. But keep thyself righteous. If any man's vision leads you against the Will of God Almighty, heed the words of our saviour, Jesus Christ: "...And if thy right eye offends thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee, for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish, and not that thy whole body should be cast into hell." [Mat. 5:29]. Rejoice, brethren, for peace be with us. Praise God, and fear Him. Bask in the warmth of his love. Amen."

A Papai Edict was handed down calling for peace on Christmas Day 1175. Usury was outlawed again. The selling of indulgences was proscribed. During this time tithe was not levied but he faithful still donated to the collection bowl anyway. A new monastery was built in Cimini.

Berengar, King of Liguria

DIPLOMACY: Langhe(nt), Tortona(nt), Emeliano(nt), Polesine(c)

The Ligurians milled about looking for new friends. A Ligurian envoy arrived in Catania and found the region to be solidly in Mahidia's control.

THE REPUBLIC OF FLORENCE (3.0C/VB)

Devide di Nervi, Urban Manager of Firenze

Trade:Partners: none

DIPLOMACY: Romagna(nt), Lucca(f), Pistoia(f), Chiana(ea)

Davide got some trade concessions from Bologna even with Franken interference. Everyone's hungry still.

THE DUCHY OF SPOLETO (3.2C/B)

Cino de Sica, Lagobard Doge of Spoleto

Trade Partners: none

DIPLOMACY: Tronto(nt), Marche(t), Sabini(c), Molise(nt), Matese(c)

The Spoleti Lombards canvassed the neighborhood. The Sabini did not believe Cino de Sica could build them a city.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM (2.0C/N)

Alexander Drymitinos, Despot of Taranto

Trade Partners: Liguria DIPLOMACY: Apulia(a)

Cyril the Despot died. The new exarch is Alexander the Despot.

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY (7.6C/G)

Christine, Queen of the Danes

Trade Partners: Francia, Poland, Russia~ DIPLOMACY: Holland(t), Uppland(fa)

Lord Anders took command of the King's Levy in Flanders and started a land grab of the Netherlands. IN 1172, he gained tribute from Brabant by defeating the Flemish resistance inside the city of Liege. This urban battle caused Liege to be reduced by one gold point value. Holland, tired of war, simply pledged their taxes when Anders arrived. An army consisting of Uppland and Norwegian allies exacted tribute from Saxony and Friesland. Harald Magnus died in 1175 and was succeeded by his daughter, Christine. They call Christine the "Ice Queen".

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCIA (3.6C/VB)

Wolfgang von Hinstaat, König den Östfrankreich

Trade Partners: Liguria, Thaery, Poland, Hungary, Byzantion*

DIPLOMACY: Nordgau(f), Meissen(ea), Slovenia(nt), Carinthia(ea), Austria(t)

Prince Timon realized there was no chance the Hessians would give up their friendly status with Flanders without a fight. So the Frankenprinz bloodied their noses and exacted some spending cash from them. Then on Christmas Day 1175, a Polack army crossed the Bohmewald Mountains and wintered on the fringes of Nordgau. Timon's army arrived there to prevent these bullies from doing anything injurious to the Frankenreich. Alsace was tributized too.

THE POLACK KINGDOM (3.5B/N)

Boleslav III, King of Poland, Still The Cleanest King in Town

DIPLOMACY: Bochnia(a), Bialoweza(n)

It took five years (because of the #\$!!\$\(\partial\) a slowness of the heavy infantry) for the Poles to gather all their armies and cross the Polack-Franken boundary just in time for the @#%@!! Pope's deadline. Kassubia was abandoniid. The Bialowezans went home when their leader died. G\(\partial\) distand and Saareria were cast adrift because they are purry, pitiful \$\(\epsilon\) ##!&* islands, not worth the expense of keeping.

Zsolt, King of Ungarn

Gregor abdicated in favor of Zsolt of the Morpal thulai. Zsolt reorganized Alfold, Banat and Carpathia into a genuine horde block. 58,000 Magyar knights gathered around Zsolt in Alfold. He also gained the support of the Bakon tribe with their 7000 and the Bulgars of the Danube with their 10,000 men in Temesvar and Wallachia. He seemed to think Pannovia is a cul-de-sac and wants to return to the great steppes of the east.

THE KIEVAN RUS (5.6B/B)

David, Grand Prince of Kiev

DIPLOMACY: Cherven(c), Lithuania(nt), Daugava(c), Galacia(c), Moldavia(aw)

David Draoviydo, Toivo Boyar and Prince Samsun of Pruss rode through forest, bog and prairie to increase the political power of Kiev. Toivo Boyar discovered that the Pechneg nomads of Moldavia are obnoxious and cruel. They killed the poor man and now want to attack Kiev.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS (2.4B/N)

Omar, Emir of Great Bolgar Trade Partners: none DIPLOMACY: Suvar(ea)

Bolgar the region has switched to cultivated. The Bulgars have been ignoring all trade offers even though it would help them out.

THE KINGDOM OF GEORGIA (0.7B/VG)

Cnatorad, Iconic King of Georgia,

DIPLOMACY: Pontus(a), Crimea(t), Paphlagonia(ea)

Cnatorad's too sexy for his throne, too sexy for his crown, too sexy for his queen. He does his little dance on the catwalk. Yeah, the catwalk. He shakes his little tush on the catwalk.

Nicephorus III, Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople

DIPLOMACY: Cyprus(ea), Rhodes(fa), Thessaly(a)

The Empire held the Turks at bay. Ilyria degraded to non-paying tributary.

THE SELJUK SULTANATE OF IZMID (0.6N/G)

Mahmud, Sultan of the Seliuks of Izmid

Trade Partners: none DIPLOMACY: none

The Turks held themselves at bay.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - The Ortugid Regency (14.0C/N)

Kasim ash Shari, Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful

Hamad al Ortuq, Vizier of the Court

Trade Partnere: Ethiopia*, Israel, Mahidia*, Byzantion~, Parthia, Kaunaj~, Chalukya~

DIPLOMACY: Palmyra(c), Edessa(fa), Arbiliq(fa), Khuzestan(a), Kuwait(ea)

Early in 532 A.H. (Al Hijra, the migration from Mecca to Medina, the marking of Muslim time), Hamad al Ortuq a prominent general staged a coup and with the help of his co-conspirators (the Emirs of Hahmar, Basra and Lurs, the Turkish palace guard, and at least one of the Caliph's harem girls) captured and jailed the Caliph in a lush, luxurious palace. Hamad with his own secretariat established the Ortuqid Regency. The entire umma seemed not to care at all over the sudden power shift except the Commander Harun al Rashid. But only Jibal was receptive to his cause, thus al Rashid was only able to take Hamadan and the land around it.

THE HARUNID EMIRATE OF HAMADAN (2.4C/B)
