The Campaign 10 Rules Supplement v 1.2: This turn I have published the Campaign Ten Rules Supplement v 1.2. These wrap all the rules that are in Lords 10 that cannot be found in Tom Harlan's Rulebooks into one document. Among the new rules found therein are free ferry points, which means that nations need not worry about the maintenance and composition of ferry arrows.

RS Drop: In accordance to the religion strength rule, this turn I have dropped all national Religion Strength stats by one.

Stik Route Closed: Because the silk industry has been prohibited from exporting their goods to Persia by Di Zhong, there is no silk income for anyone this turn.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning many ramparts, towers, & walls. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's meanest, most guarly warriors.

After a few years of being a pestering element on the barren frontier, the Bahawi roared out of the Al Nefud in march 1199. 137,500 screaming Arabs twirling their collective sabers, riding on fast camels attacked the fortified position of Petra. Yogi Baer and Dino Boi commanded 13,500 lancers, 12,000 horse archers, 16,500 shieldman protecting 16,500 archers, 550 catapults and 50 fixed battle towers. This defense came very close to driving the attackers back into the desert. The Benu had wiped out the shield wall and were hacking all the marksmen to bits. One Arab got so far in that he reached Prince Itchy's pavilion and killed the heir (Okay, Okay I lied, Itchy was put in a blender and was pureed to a bloody, drinkable pulp). In the swirl of confusion, Yogi made Dino his heir against the wishes of his own family. The Benu regrouped and attacked again.
