New World Success: The New World has had a successful start. Virtually every area there is in play and is volatile. Thank you.

Isolated Cities: The "I" in the city trade type means the city is isolated and therefore was not counted for inter-city trade or international trade.

Thin Government: The computer will knock down your tax rate if you have *Thin Government*. A Thin Government occurs when your Infrastructure and the King's Admin rating are insufficient to control all the territories you have. In addition to your tax collections being hamstrung, there is a greater chance your nation will suffer dynastic failure and civil wars. How to solve Thin Government? More Infrastructure.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. THE AKA MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Kazm, *Emir of the Fulani*

Trade Value: 8.4 **Partners:** Bug, Kongo**, Mahidia, Almoravid~

DIPLOMACY: Gambia(a)

The Fulan came very close to completing a city in Kurfei, but the final touches on Sokoto will have to be done next season. The oases Tahoua, Agades and Bilma were conquered by the Sunni Fulani tribes. A bunch of warlike heathens from Garou have raided Segu.

EMPIRE OF WAN

Bug, *Darklord, Bringer of the Ancestral Light*

Trade Value: 6.1 **Partners:** Fulani, Congo

DIPLOMACY: Benue(c), Zaria(ea), Gwari(f), Gurma(f)

Because both Ife and Kwararafa are wilderness regions only one city was built in Kwararafa. It was named Man.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Toboshaka, *King of Ba-Congo*

Trade Value: 4.0 **Partners:** Fulani~, Bug

DIPLOMACY: Loangar(a), Cuango(a)

In the grand tradition of city building, the Kongo built an urban area too. A port called Luanda in Mbundu. The king got real land greedy and went on a wild rampage making Omote, Likasi and Mitumba pay tribute by the force of sheer numbers. Word came that the coastal provinces are getting antsy because Toboshaka went a rhino safari into the deep jungles.

East Africa

THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, *Zimbabwe King*

Trade Value: 3.5 **Partners:** Sakalava

DIPLOMACY: none

The Zimbobs broke the chain. They didn't build a new city; they expanded an existing one. For some unknown reason, the Judaic presence in the court of Great Zimbabwe had an impact on Five Twin Jackal.

"Holy Moses, I think I'm a son of David too!"

So the Zimbabwe became Jewish. Banhine, Kafue, Phalaborwa, Rozwi, Transkei and Vaal all collectively joined their king and removed their foreskins. Karanga, Matopos and Sofala liked their peeps *au naturel* and rebelled. Row Kraal Head descended especially upon Sofala and crushed their pitiful demonstration. So the Torah was rammed down their throat. There wasn't the time to deal with the others.

THE SAKALAVANS

Niro Noga, *Little Caesar of Madagascar*

Trade Value: 4.8 **Partners:** Zimbabwe, Lungwebungu

DIPLOMACY: Mozambi(f), Brava(fa), Burundi(fa), Kikuyu(t), Kimbu(fa), Luba(nt)

A new city was built in Mozambi facing the Mozambique Channel connecting Mogadishu to the rest. It was named Mopizza after a legendary hero of yore. Niko Noga found a wife for Noname in Mozambi. Noname's successor was born a year before Niko died. In the meantime, Noname went on a mission of revenge against Kinsasha. Noname had 3500 men but the Kinsasha had 4000. After several months of skirmishes, Noname realized just how much those 500 men made a difference. Eventually, Noname's entire army was killed and Noname was captured. Pushing Noname as an example the Kinsasha entered Tongaa to show how 'weak' the Sakalava are. Tongaa degraded to non-paying tributary. Both Nyeh Nyeh, who assumed the role of superintendent in Mahapizza, and Lord Wawa Nogapunda, the first duke, got knots in their guts from the failure of the attack. Nyeh Nyeh considered paying off the Kinsasha so that they'll leave Sakalava alone. If Noname is not brought back to freedom, bad things may happen.

KINSASHA

Grubor

DIPLOMACY: Kabwe(nt), Tongaa(nt) to Sakalava

The capture of the Sakalava king has put Kinsasha on the map. So long as Grubor lives, he will actively prosecute the war on Sakalava unless the ransom is paid. He is asking for 28 GP.

THE KINGDOM OF LUNGWEBUNGU

Kumdatola, *King of the Drummers*

Trade Value: 2.5 **Partners:** Sakalava, Ethiopia

DIPLOMACY: none

Someone tried to kill Lungwebungu's king. Kumdatola was alarmed and prepared for hostility.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Gobbu III, *King of Aethiopia*

Trade Value: 8.8 **Partners:** Lungwebungu, Bahawi, Mahidia, Islam~, Kaunaj~, Chalukya~

DIPLOMACY: none

Again, more oases were captured by the Dune Patrol. Yanaka Dhinga and Bilma were taken over and colonized by Copts. Word of this activity had spread to other cultures such as Fulani who later attacked Bilma and killed all the recently settled Coptics and planted some Sunni Muslims in their stead. Prince Gobbu and Lord Mengu ferried an army of 15,000 men up the Nile into the Med. From that angle they beached on the endless beach of Ad Diffah, pacified it and

converted it to Coptic Christian using cross shaped swords for the sake of argument. King Umbawa died in 1210 so now Gobbu III has to get back home.

North Africa

THE COPTOS Y ISRAEL KINGDOM

Dino don Boi was imprisoned by the Benu Bahawi in his own palace's dungeon. The Lion who had roared out of Nubia has been speared by the many lances of the Muslim backlash.

THE SULTANATE OF CAIRO

Toma ibn Jheru

Trade Value: 3.0 **Partners:** Mahidia~
DIPLOMACY: none

Tom ben Jheri revealed he was really Muslim and set up a Sultanate in Cairo. As the successor ruler to the fallen Lion of Y'Israel. He gained friendly control of Egypt and tribute from Faiyum. He claims Petra and Jordan but those two regions are neutral now. In 1207, a Mahidian armada arrived to steal the two Cairo merchant fleets and went home. Two Mahidian diplomats tried to smooth over relations but Sultan Toma's feelings had been seriously hurt.

THE BENU AL BAHAWI

Dauod, *Sharif al Bahawi*

Trade Value: 3.1 **Partners:** Aethiopia, Islam
DIPLOMACY: Hijaz(fa)

In the middle part of 1206, Jerusalem finally surrendered having been so staved out that Jerusalem reduced a Gold Point Level. The fall of this city spelled doom for Y'Israel. Only Tom ben Jheri survived the fall. The great leader Abd Allah passed on in 1210 allowing for the succession of Dauod.

THE EMIRATE OF MAHIDIA

Husayn, *Emir of al Mahgrab*

Trade Value: 14.9 **Partners:** Fulani, Ethiopia, Cairo, Guyenne*, Andalus, Liguria, Islam~
DIPLOMACY: no effect

Moon Roach and Loboach scurried over to Egypt to maybe incorporate the Sultanate of Cairo. The effort would have worked if Husayn didn't take the two merchant fleets by force. Uthman retired rather than be a feeble old king. He had ruled for 45 years.

EUROPE

Western Europe

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Neville the Marker, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans*

Trade Value: 9.1 **Partners:** Andalus, Polska~
DIPLOMACY: none

Neville asked his armies defend their current holdings and see just how much damage the Guyenne could do.

THE KINGDOM OF GUYENNE

Lothair I, *Count of Perigord, Dux Aquitanium, Roy de Guyenne*

Trade Value: 8.8 **Partners:** Mahidia~, Andalusia, Milano, Liguria, Spoleto*~, Islam~
DIPLOMACY: Ile de France(t)

Lothair built up the armies of his compatriots in France, Vermandois and Asturias using leverage finances from the Christian bankers who had been sheltered from the Church by the late Saxon king Robert the Great. He harrowed his merchant boats for armed soldiers. These were placed in the army of his son Clovis. Clovis marched through Orleans, Lyonnais and Languedoc and took Catalonia and Barcelona. Clovis holed up in this southern location defending it with his 25,000 men and 55 contraption army. Lothair himself took Armagnac. Louis of Ile de France was assassinated by Thaerian and Frankon agents do he was unable to use his sizable army for an attack. Ile de France degraded to tributary. The Markgraf of Asturias himself was wounded by an unknown attacker. The only ally able to move was that of Vermandois who attacked Flanders with his army of 13,500 archers, 7500 shieldmen, 7500 page cavalry and 2500 armored knights. Bruges was sacked and the region was left to the crows. Soon after in 1208, a Francian army of around 34,500 men jumped out of Burgundy, bypassed Lyonnais and parked in Languedoc. This last region was pacified ostensibly in Saxonia's name. When no Saxons arrived to control it, they held it in their own name. Late in 1200, a Thaerian army of 8000 cavalry, 13,000 infantry challenged Vermandois for Lorraine. Numbers and the home field advantage were on Guyenne's side and the Thaerians withdrew battle. Vermandois lost 10,000 men. Thaery had 17,000 casualties.

THE ALMORAVOID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Istafa II, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: Bojador(nt), Malta(ea)

The Moors were a garden of tranquillity as again those crazy Northern Christians broke out into war yet again.

THE DUCHY OF MILANO

Gottfried II, *Duke of Milano*

Trade Value: 2.6 **Partners:** Guyenne, Liguria, Francia
DIPLOMACY: none

The Milanese took their time to turn on the machine.

THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Columbo, *King of Liguria*

Trade Value: 14.1 **Partners:** Mahidia, Guyenne, Andalus*, Milano, Pope Spoleto, Taranto, Francia, Byzantine

DIPLOMACY: Pistoia(a), Eufemia(ea), Langhe(a), Diano(t)

King Mario died in 1210. So did Antonio who reigned six months. Antonio's youthful son Columbo took over the Ligur Kingdom late in the year.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Leo IX, *Pope of Rome, Vicar of Christ, God's Chancellor Upon This Earth*

Trade Value: 4.2 **Partners:** Almoravid infidels*, Liguria, Spoleto

DIPLOMACY: Lepini(fa), Amiata(f)

The Papacy was oddly quiet as the prohibition on warfare was flagrantly violated in Europe.

THE LOGBARD DUCHY OF SPOLETO

Leon Decaile, *Logobard Doge of Spoleto*

Trade Value: 4.1 **Partners:** Guyenne~, Liguria, Pope, Tarantum

DIPLOMACY: none

Some birds flew overhead. The trees breezed in the wind. The deer grazed in the wild woods.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Tyrus Drymitinos, *Despot of Taranto*

Trade Value: 3.1 **Partners:** Liguria, Spoleto, Byzantion

DIPLOMACY: Calabria(ea)

San Fernando grew into a greater city to the amazement of all around.

Eastern Europe

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Romer, *King of the Danes*

Trade Value: 10.4 **Partners:** Francia, Poland, Russia~

DIPLOMACY: Gautland(a), Saxony(fa), Norway(f), Westphalia(nt), Friesland(f), Uppland(ea), Brabant(f)

The Danes helped out their Saxon friends in their internal troubles. Their efforts to recover Lorraine failed. The Danish intel network claims that they were the ones responsible for the death of Louis of Paris. The Francian Futurian Society disputes this. The City in Holland nominally called Leibach is now called The Hague.

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCIA

Tyran, *Panarch of Francia*

Trade Value: 9.2 **Partners:** Saxon, Milano, Liguria, Thaery, Poland, Bakonai, Byzantion*, Islam*

DIPLOMACY: Meissen(a), Slovenia(fa), Carinthia(a)

Under the command of Nikto Blum the main Franken army waited for Polish contingents. The Poles didn't show up at the right place and were left behind. Nikto Blum was the one who raged through Lyonnais to Languedoc. Tyran's son Estanze, died of the black head disease, another strange Medieval affliction.

THE MARGRAVATE OF POLSKA

Tadeuz Claud-Faustus, *Markgraf of Poland*

Trade Value: 6.1 **Partners:** Saxony*, Thaery, Francia, Bakon, Russia

DIPLOMACY: Bialoweza(f), Obodria(f)

The Polsk army headed over to Champaign but didn't link up with the Bavarians probably because someone lied to them. Without any coordination, the army marched home. Tadeuz's son Kolumdraas was killed by the Festering Bump Sickness. A ten year old that Tadeuz adopted was poisoned by the strongest eldest surviving son, Volazarn.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

Shuab the Knife, *King of the Bakons*

Trade Value: 0.5 **Partners:** Francia, Poland, Byzantion

DIPLOMACY: Carpathia(fa), Podravina(a), Banat(a), Alfold(a), Transylvania(n)

Allies were found in the tall grass.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Rurik, *Chieftain of Novgorod*

Trade Value: 1.9 **Partners:** none

DIPLOMACY: Yaroslav(a)

Rurik snow paddled up to the Volga's mouth looking for fox and mink to trap. He stopped by a few princely castles and arranged for closer ties.

THE GRAND RUS OF KIEV

Semon II, *Grand Prince of Kiev*

Trade Value: 9.3 **Partners:** Thery*, Poland, Bolgar

DIPLOMACY: Crimea(f), Starodub(c), Chernigov(fa), Özu(t), Cherven(h)

Tired of these barbarians, Semon sent Boyar Grigori against Özu and Moldavia. The Özu were not going to argue with 12,500 soldiers. The Moldavians resented having to change their religion and had to be pacified. Hancyev the Honorable was killed by evil Cherven demon worshippers as he was on a diplomatic tour of the Driva basin.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Omar 3rd, *Emir of Great Bolgar*

Trade Value: 2.4 **Partners:** Kiev

DIPLOMACY: Suvar(ea), Mordva(ri), Urkel(aa), Murom(ri)

Rashid led 18,500 cavalry around the pagan countryside and found them willing to pay tribute but not willing to be friendly. Somehow they would have to be submitted to Allah if they were to be absorbed.

ASIA

The Middle East

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus II, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*

Trade Value: 21.7 **Partners:** Israel*, Mahidia-, Almoravid-, Liguria, Taranto,

Francia-, Bakon, Islam

DIPLOMACY: Lydia(ri)

The Great Empire didn't invest for the future. Sinope got built on Optmaton's coast.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - The Ortuqid Regency

Talib al Waqaod, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

Hamad al Ortuq, *Vizier of the Court*

Trade Value: 17.4 **Partners:** Ethiopia*, Mahidia*, Guyenne*, Francia-,

Byzantion, Bahawi, Parthia, Kaunaj-, Chalukya-

DIPLOMACY: Dulaym(t), Lebanon(t), Jordan(c), Kurdistan(n), Charsionon(t)

Another extension of the Caliph's Way was slabbed down upon Raqqaq and Aleppo to the port of Antioch. The Ortuqids sent another shipment of gold dinar to Parthia because they might need it.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Xerxes, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*

Trade Value: 9.1 **Partners:** Islam, Ghur

DIPLOMACY: Kuhistan(f), Shadad(f), Makran(a), Karatou(t)

Again the Shahdom set itself to defend its most important cities from the excessive ravages of the Khirgiz. The Khirgiz under the new leadership of Palung exercised their dominion over the plains. Transoxania Khwarizm, Uzbek, Soghdia and Khokhand were all looted. The last of them Khokhand tried to resist the Khirgiz but were crushed and lost to Parthia. Some refugees were settled in villages of Kuhistan and Shadad enabling these region to be added to the Shah's tax and levy roster. Makran offered their sword in exchange for a port city.

THE KHIRGIZ HORDE

Palung the Gristle

Trade Value: 0.2 **Partners:** none

DIPLOMACY: none

Ruddogur was assassinated early in 1206. Another leadership tourney (they kill each other in this one with real sword not mudballs), allowed for the election of Palung the Gristle. He edged the horde back to the steppe. The emergence of the Oghuz was seen as a revolt by the Khirgiz.

THE OGHUZ HORDE

Bamon

95,000 Oghuz from Siber, Ob and Irlysh repudiated Khirgiz overlordship. The buffer horde block of Kha'uk (Irgiz, Khirgiz and Tara) became neutral.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Fonsil, *Sultan of Afghans*

Trade Value: 3.4 **Partners:** Parthia, Kaunaj

DIPLOMACY: Ushrusana(a), Registan(c)

The Ghorids hid up in their mountain and didn't allow anyone to bother them.

India

THE PRATIHARA EMPIRE OF KAUNAJ

Pratihara Gopala III, *Emperor of Kaunaj*

Trade Value: 11.3 **Partners:** Ethiopia*, Islam*, Ghur, Khola, Chalukya, Tibet, Kambuja-

DIPLOMACY: Vanga(fa)

King Gopala II took his 41,000 assorted cavalry and 1000 siege platforms to Jihjhoti and destroyed the Khola Kingdom without breaking a sweat. Tragically he drowned in the Gangas while on a swim. His able son Gopala III was crowned the latest Emperor of the Etemal Pratharas. The over taxation led to the rebellions of Jats, Jhelum, Gujarat, Chitor, Kamarupa, Multan, Sukkur and Vatsa and a depression. The lost regions had to connect with shuttle fleets which meant trade with Chekiang couldn't begin.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Ghandiji Chalukya, *The Great Muta, King of the South*

Trade Value: 14.2 **Partners:** Ethiopia*, Islam*, Kaunaj, Pagan*, Kambuja, Java*, Chekiang

DIPLOMACY: Gangas(ri), Kamata(c)

The Chalukya allowed Kaunaj to take out the Kalanjara homeland so that they can pick up the easy stuff. Ask King Chandragupta and Hindisni Jonsa if it was easy. They had 35,500 cavalry forces not suited for siege situations to conduct sieges upon Tripuri and later Surat. Tripuri did fall and Dahala was repossessed but it had cost some 11,000 who had succumbed to disease and privation. Pawar was brought back into friendly status but Lata wasn't. The walls of Surat caused the deaths of 4000 more and looked unassailable from land. All those men riding horses were easy targets for rampart archers. Under advice of Jonsa, Chandragupta withdrew to Pawar. Both men died there in 1210 for they were both old, cranky codgers. The soon to be king Ghandiji was unable to do all he wanted to do because of how slow the heavy infantry are. All he could do was pacified Orissa and Pundra. A port area was built on the coast of Vanga that lets out to the Andaman Sea.

THE KHOLA OF KALANJARA

Kaunaj took Jihjhoti. Chalukya grabbed Pawar and Dahala. Bihar and Lata became neutral. Khola Pondeji is dead.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Shan Kabu, *2nd Dalai Lama*

Trade Value: 2.2 **Partners:** Kaunaj, Pagan, Vietnam

DIPLOMACY: Salwegn(t), Amdo Tsho(c), Sikkim(f)

The Holy One poured water on Lhasa and it grew one gold point.

South-East Asia

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Monson II, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*

Trade Value: 7.3 **Partners:** Chalukya, Tibet, Kambuja, Java*, Vietnam

DIPLOMACY: Korat(f), Manipur(f), Thaton(n), Sagaing(fa)

In his hidden cave, king Monson practiced his Golden Buzzard Claw and the Five Metallic Layers. Someday he hopes to use his skills against the Red Cult.

THE KAMBUJADESA

Suryavarman IV, *Emperor of Kambujadesa, Monarch of the Emerald Throne*

Trade Value: 11.5 **Partners:** Kaunaj-, Chalukya-, Burma, Java-, Vietnam,

Chekiang-

DIPLOMACY: Atjeh(a)

Five lawlords from Red Cult stopped by the elaborate and ornate palace of the most serene Emperor of Hidden Kambujadesa.

"Do you possess the Ball of Lightning Negation?"

"No. Such things are useless to the Emerald Throne."

"Okay."

They left unhappy. When the God-Emperor was certain they were gone he pulled out a drawer containing lots of priceless stuff.

"So that's what the round thing is."

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Troutimsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*

The whole Aquarium readied for an attack. It was clear to the fisher folk that there are lots of paranoidacudas to catch.

China

THE DAI VIET GUO

Giap Tui, *Wang Dai Viet*

Trade Value: 6.5 **Partners:** Tibet, Pagan, Kambuja, Java-, Chekiang, Zhong, Tumed*

DIPLOMACY: Yunnan(c), Chiennan(a), Lingnan(a)

The entire Vietnamese armed forces were brought home and trained to be the best they could be. No one could ever hope to compare to the warriors of Giap Tui not even Red Cult nor the Schools of Power.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Kao Zhong, *Celestial King of Chekiang*

Trade Value: 14.1 **Partners:** Chalukya, Kambuja*-., Java, Vietnam, Zhong, Tumed, Amago*

DIPLOMACY: none

The great sleeping giant had no need to pick up that monstrous club and knock everyone flat. A port area was built in the opposite side of Kedah facing the Andaman Sea.

THE DI ZHONG GUO

Ping Ra, *Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

Trade Value: 15.2 **Partners:** Vietnam, Chekiang, Tumed

DIPLOMACY: none

The entire Di Zhong hung out and drank beer.

THE SIA OF TUMED

Shak Yanto, *King of the Tumed, Emperor of Sia*

Trade Value: 12.8 **Partners:** Vietnam-, Chekiang, Zhong, Amago-

DIPLOMACY: Shentung(ea)

The Tumed being an old horde sharpened their swords for the coming of the Tai Chud and/or the Jadaran. In days past the Tumed were fellow tribesmen with these now active in the steppe.

THE TAICHUD HORDE

Qujili, *Khan of the Taichud*

DIPLOMACY: Hinggan(nt), Humane(nt), Tuchir(ea)

The Taichud crossed the Khinggan into the Jadaran territory to meet the Jadaran eye ball to eye ball. Maybe they'll be so impressed with the courage they'll join the Taichud.
