## Western Europe

### THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Neville the Marker, King of the Saxons and of the Normans Trade Value: 9.2 Partners: Andalus, Thaery\*, Francia, Polska~ DIPLOMACY: Brittany(ea), Ile de France(n), Vermandois(n)

With international co-operation and support, King Neville began the process of grinding down the Guyenne Rebellion. He had sought to untie all the spies of Europe into one big, close family. He found though that the spies of various nationalities don't get along that well. Thus his ambitious plan to subvert the Vermandois was botched. The vermandois remained loyal, at least for the time being. The slow moving armies of Saxonia began to march. The 20,000 man strong Galacians lumbered into Asturias and pacified the region when Sedgewick landed on the shore with 16,000 more pawn. Leo the Magnificent and Count Renart of Blois took their time going through Vermandois and Lorraine looking for Count Jean of Ardennes. He was discovered in Champagne and he had recently been deteated by Francian forces [See Guyenne entry below]. The 41,500 soldier army spooked the demoralized Vermandois ally who had only 16,500 men left. He agreed to go neutral if they left him and his loyals unmolested. Leo and Renart forced tribute from Orleans and that was all the move they could do up to December 1215. He de France was neutralized by the Anjou, who in the interim, had to chase away a Guyenne garrison from their own territory. The Poitou Earl refused to leave his army behind in order to coordinate naval activities. So the Poitou stayed home and didn't fight at all.

### THE KINGDOM OF GUYENNE

Clovis Seven-Fingers, Count of Perigord, Dux Aquitanium, Roy de Guyenne Trade Value: 4.3 Partners: Mahidia~, Milano, Liguria, Byzantine\* DIPLOMACY: none

Lothair's able son Clovis was the subject of many different assassination attempts, including one from Andalusia. The most successful of these was Saxonian who chopped off two of his fingers and a thumb from his left hand. The Crown Prince henceforth was called Seven-Fingers Clovis. The Septidicit Man tried to dislodge the Francians from Provence with 25,000 infantry and 5500 single workers. The Francians were well prepared with the recent arrival of Tibo auf Carinthian who force marched his cavalry patrol from the Tyrollan Alps to Provence. He quickly organized the defense of 7000 heavy lancers, 17,000 cavalry including 3500 exhausted Carinthians, 8500 fully armored shield men, 10 000 pole men and 2500 logistics and supply specialists. They destroyed Clovis' army. Clovis escaped capture and was next seen in Toulouse, touching bases with the local burgmaster. Count Jean of Vermandois and his army who had kept the northern marches intact was visited by many urging him to quit his alliance with Lothair the Traitor and rejoin Saxonia. He blew them off and didn't take serious consideration of these suggestions until he was defeated by a coalition of Francian allies who skillfully defended Burgundy with 11,000 infantry, 4000 cavairy and 25 castles. Jean's forces once 25,500 men strong was reduced to 16,500 and was subjected to pure intimidation by two Saxonians corps. His withdrawal of support meant that Champagne was restored to Francia as a tribute paying country. This action compounded by the neutralization of tie de France and the failure to control Anjou, grossly isolated Lorraine. It was a good thing for the sake of compactness that Francia conquered it late in 1215. The Asturians who was expected to help relieve the coastal front was caught by the Galacians and were destroyed. All these losses reduced Guyenne territory to Catalonia, Armagnac, Aquitaine, Auvergne and Lyonnais. During this whole time, the Papacy had been strangely quiet.

### THE ALMORAVAID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Istafa II. Emir as Sevilla

DIPLOMACY: Maita(f), Saragoza(t), Bojador(ea)

A scandal broke early in 1211 when the Emir's own interventionist policy in regards to the Christian Wars was shown to be a farce when his own assassins were exposed in Aquitaine. Immediately Istafa responded by jailing those responsible for this policy to allay the complainers. In the following year all the key whiners were murdered. Silently the architects of the Guyenne heir assassination plan were freed because these were then most trusted retainers of

the Emir's governing body. In Malta, Al Kiffa was constructed, a walled port obviously.

## Italy

### THE DUCHY OF MILANO

Gottfried II. Duke of Milano

The Milanese were glad no one attacked them. Gottfried has a special message to the Pope but has yet to find a reliable message to send it.

The supreme potentate of most Italy did not want to involve his august personage into the barbarity of other European kingdoms. What matter most to Colombo was money and trade.

### THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Lucius IV, Pope of Rome, Vicar of Christ, God's Chancellor Upon This Earth Trade Value: 4.2 Partners: Almoravid Infideis\*, Liguria, Spoleto, Arezzo DIPLOMACY: none

Indifferent to the struggles of Europe, Pope Leo the Sixth kept himself occupied with trivial pursuits and bullying his underlings. The Pontiffs died in 1215. His replacement has different ideas about the role of the Church.

### The LOOBARD Duchy of spoleto

Jacapo, Lagobard Doge of Spoleto

Trade Value: 2.5 Partners: Pope, Tarantum

**DIPLOMACY:** none

Leon Dacaile ruled Spoleto in quiet splendor until he died. His chosen successor was Augusto di Salum, his best most trusted general. But his natural son Jacapo never liked his father's decision to strip him of royal succession just because he was only a kid when Leon became Duke. It was fortunate then that Augusto was in Arezzo when Leon died. It gave Jacapo a chance to play his lineage card to gain the loyalty of the palace staff. Jacapo was quick and he gained control of Abruzzo, Tronto, Fucina, Matese, Molise, Aterno and the services of Carlo Lemac. Augusto consolidated his power in Chiana and grabbed Umbria and Marche for his own rival duchy. Sabini selzed its right to be self determined.

### THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Romer, King of the Danes

DIPLOMACY: Cornwall(nt), Saxony(f), Gautland(nt), Westphalia(fa), Uppland(a)
The Thaerekong graciously cooperated with the Saxons in their ongoing civil war. For their support, they were allowed to own Cornwall.

### THE KINGDOM OF FRANCIA

Tyran, Panarch of Francia

Trade Value: 10.5 Partners: Saxon, Milano, Liguria, Thaery, Poland, Bakonai. Byzantion", Islam\*

DIPLOMACY: Champagne(t)

The Guyenne War had gotten so involved it threatened to spill over into Francia itself. It was clear Tyran was got to protect his frontier and the expeditionary army in Languedoc before they be embroiled or ravaged by the forges of conflict. The newly established Carinthian Corp raced to Languedoc to help Nikto Blum defend this isolated outpost from all corners. Crown Prince Ekhart hurried to Meissen so he can command the Polish army. They were later

stationed in Nordgau. Meanwhile a Guyenne army did cross into Francon land forcing tribute from Champagne. They came to a showdown with the Francian allies in Burgundy. After their defeat and final capitulation to Saxonia, the Francian reclaimed Champagne and the Francian led Polish army conquered Lorraine and Köln in the name of Tyran Panaspar.

### THE MARGRAVATE OF POLSKA

Volazarn, Markgraf of Poland

DIPLOMACY: Yayik(f), Shirvan(c), Terek(h), Kuban(h), Kursk(h), Donets(h)

Omar Amir wanted much more esteem in the eyes of the world. He reached out to the people of the Transcaucaus in friendship but some of them were too mean to be hospitable. Then Omar realized that his tongue was like lead and his voice was like a sick bear groaning in indignation.

### THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus II, Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople

### THE PRATIHARA EMPIRE OF KAUNAJ

Pratihara Gopala III, Emperor of Kaunaj

Trade Value: 13.9 Partners: Ethiopia\*, Islam\*, Parthia\*, Ghur, Khola, Chalukya, Tibet, Kambuja~

DIPLOMACY: Vatsa(c), Chitor(t), Kamarupa(t)

Even though Gopala Rajah had a healthy six year old son, he'd rather have his friend Kohngupta to be the Crown Prince of the Empire. Gopala's write got real angry and threatened to poison his muffins if he didn't reinstate little Karka as the Imperial Heir. Kohngupta, however, has accepted his new post and is installing his own toadles into the palace. The Emperor went over to Sukkur with 32,000 knights conquered Sukkur and converted them to Hindu. Jihjhoti was abandoned so that Chalukya could have it.

### THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Pulakesin III, The Great Muta, King of the South

Ghandiji's reign wasn't a long one. He died in 1215 as did his successor Somesvara II. Somesvara's eon Pulakesin III became the Great Muta amidst great controversy. The allies and the Hindiani family were not confident in Pulakesin's ability to hold the Mandalam together. Newly acquired Kosala, Jihjhoti and Gangas revolted. The Karnata claim was forfeit. Hindiani Joindra repudiated his loyalty to Chalukya in Kalanjara but found his power curtailed. It was fortunate that Govinda in Lata, Basadhundra who had to flee Kosala and the entire government supported the new Rajah and wondered what these guys' problem was. Rex of Vengi and Hiryu of Andhra were in open insurrection. Rex was only able to subvert Seylon while Hiryu in his temporary base at Bhagalpur took Kwa, Nadavaria, Orissa, Pundra and Chela along with Andhra to form the Rastrakuta Empire. Eventually Rex of Vengi bowed to Hiryu and combined their forces to combat the wrath of Pulakesin. Pulakesin finally found his army and has plans to use this army to destroy this latest rebellion.

## THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

The Holy Lama came down to the lower elevations and fainted because the air's too rich. A new perspective on the mountains he lives in was made.

### South-East Asia

#### THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Monson II, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

Trade Value: 7.2 Partners: Chalukya, Tibet, Java\*, Vietnam, Chekiang\*

DIPLOMACY: Thaton(ea)

The King ordered his best general U Latkyi to get ready for a possible invasion. For awhile nothing happened (as usual) until late in 1215, the Khmer army invaded Kayah. 73.000 combined heavy and light infantry totally murderized the pitifully small 16,000 man reaction army of U Latkyi. So Kayah was lost. A good will gesture of fresh food to Tibet could not be delivered because fresh food rots without preserving agents.

### THE KAMBUJADESA

Suryavarman IV, Emperor of Kambujadesa, Monarch of the Emerald Throne

Trade Value: 11.9 Partners: Kaunaj~, Rastrakuta, Java~, Vietnam, Chekiang~"

DIPLOMACY: Medan(c), Atjeh(f)

Lord Giroutpa gathered troops by sea to help assemble Noroang Dhun's invasion army. At the end of 1212, they were ready and slowly they marched from Mon by way of Dvaravati, Lampang and Kayah.

### THE AOUARIUM OF JAVA

Guppimsutra, King of the Spice Islands

Yet another world leader died. Giap Tui at the age of 74 and after a long reign. The Dai Viet built a new town, Hoian in Annam, a port.
