THE AKA MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI - 495

Sugou, Emir of the Fulani

The Garou raids did not settle well the lunch of Chlef Sugou. He had personally promised the camel drivers of Segu that he would keep peace in their land. He lost face there when Ret Garo and his boys snuck in and stole huge piles of sea shells. THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA - 648

When all the dust settled, the Saxons were the clear victor of the Rebellion of the Four Duchies. The Ponthieu allied army, already a powerful force, was expanded to 37,000 men. They promptly trampled upon the Guyenne homeland of Aquitaine and toppled their corrupted government. Sedgewick and the Galacians pacified Catalonia. The Poitou with 2000 men attempted to force tribute from Lyonnais but were annihilated. Poitou rebelled. It wasn't necessary though because a fiscal crisis imploded what was left of Guyenne. King Clovis had allowed a rather sizable loan to default, so large it was, that it depressed all of Western Europe and bankrupted the profane banking system that Neville still sheltered from the Church.

Neville shouted real nasty oaths at Clovis and his ilk. The Saxon King can now image the Pope stopping by for a visit to sneer, "I told you so!" New ducal allies were enrolled when they heard how generous Saxonia is when dishing out its own troops to become integral parts of allied armies. Prince Sidana even married into the newly allied House of France. The only major diplomatic setback was in Flanders, who didn't want to have anything to do with Saxonia even with promises of public works improvements. Francia gave Languedoc and Lorraine back to Saxonia and added a little extra just be nice.

THE KINGDOM OF GUYENNE

The legacy of war yields bitter grain. In order to fight the Saxons, the Guyenne royalty took out a large loan. Now that they are busted, they've really busted. With what little leverage the bankers had left, they ousted Clovis from his throne and Guyenne was then dissolved. A regional depression sunk many Western European economies down with it and priests in their churches used this banking flasco to preach the evils of usury.

As Clovis left for exile in Constantinople, he had the last laugh. The same default that chased him out of power shall irritate the Saxons for years to come.

In Genoa, a bunch of bank robbers were caught red handed trying to break into the royal vault. Lord Ricardo forced some confessions out of these men. They were in the pay of Gottfried II, Duke of Milan and Flanders. Colombo was genuinely surprised, he thought the troublemakers were Apulian.

The Khirgiz and the Oghuz joined forces to... jam the joint, pack up and leave, go that away, move in another direction, vacate the premises, get out of town, make like trees and scramming, knock down the tents and pull up the stakes, remove the pink flamingos from the front lawn, put up the 'for sale' sign in front of the property, boogie on down, become scarce, and slam the door on the way out. But now the hordes are Ghur's problem. C'est la vie.

THE KHIRGIZ HORDE

Palunhg

DIPLOMACY: none

Palunhg called for the Oghuz to join him and they did. Together, the Khirgiz and the Oghuz went into Yarkhand then Kashmir to attack Pathan, head waters of the Indus Valley. Aral'sk revolted. The Karluk left the Khirgiz camp to settle the western part of the Tarim Basin (Tarim, Yarkhand, and Khotan) as a horde block.

THE OGHUZ HORDE

Barnon

DIPLOMACY: Karluk Horde(nt), Rambone Horde(f), Saryai Horde(a), Kashmir(nt) Barnon went on one last tour of the Turkish Steppe. His mighty horde gained a new ally, the Saryai or Yellow Horde. The 158,000 Ghuzz joined forces with 96,000 Khirgiz in Ferghana and both abandoned the Black Basin to take the Kashgar-Kashmir Passage into India. Ghor controlled Pathan was attacked but that was all the new horde alliance could do before the artificially imposed deadline called the 'end of the turn' passed. Because Oghuz was bigger, they got to own Pathan. The city, now under effective passive siege, is Peshawar. It

All the steppe territory that the Oghuz held sway over quietly went neutral.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

has good defenses built by the Ghorids to protect it from the Hindus.

The Pratihara expanded three of their most important cities, just in time for some hordes to arrive. The most astute of Gopala's advisors claim that Ghur's too impoverished for them. They must be envious of the riches of India.

Not far from Pathan, Multan was attacked by King Gopala III, not a brilliant battle commander, with 32,000 mixed cavalry and 1000 catapults. The land battle was a rout. The Multan Emir was forced to take command of his own city's defenses. The fifty feet tall walls and their guards competently held off Gopala's ineffectual bombardments. Indeed Gopala was killed when they dropped an iron cauldron on him (they ran out of boiling tar). The surviving cavalry withdrew to Sukkur as Kohngupta was acclaimed the new Maharajah of the Land. Kohngupta was unhappy. If he had led the attack on Multan, he would have reduced the city. After all, Kohn's combat rating is twice as good as his dead dunderhead brother.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM - 605

DIPLOMACY: Kachin(t)

The Panchen with 22,000 men impressed Kachin, a Burmese ally, to pay tribute to Most Holy.

South-East Asia

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN - 315

Monson III. King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

Trada Value: 7 Partners: Chalukya, Tibet, Java(8)*, Vietnam, Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: none

The vicious Cambodian attack on Kayah and the subsequent defeat of U Latkyi flung Monson II into panic. He sent desperate envoys to Linan and Thanglong for help. Hurried scaffolds strengthened the defenses of Pagan and Bassein and a new army was recruited. Spies were sent out to disrupt the Kambujan advance while King Monson II held tightly on to the railings expecting a rough ride. [Go on to the Kambujan results]

THE KAMBUJADESA - 144

Norcang Dhun, Emperor of Kambujadesa, Monarch of the Emerald Throne Trude Value: 4 Partners: Kaunaj-, Rastrakuta, Java-

DIPLOMACY: none

Kambuja stepped up the war effort to finish the job of destroying Pagan before it was too late. All of Suryavarman's merchant marine was mothballed and the sailors were pressed into military service. Even young teenaged boys were mustered and were heavily equipped. All told, the king led an army of 3500 mounted knights, 40,000 archers and 20,000 sword men. From Mangfu and Pendash, they marched on Thaton and caught 25,500 Burmese trying to cross the mountains into Dvaravati. U Latkyi led this force and the God-Emperor laughed because that Paganese general had lost before to his son. But U Latkyi never did get a fair battle in Kayah, at least here the odds were halfway decent, outnumbered only two to one. U Latkyi got his tactical victory and forced the Khmer back to Mon. 17,500 men died in the battle and subsequent pursuit. U Latkyi then crossed into Dvaravati, master of the field.

Meanwhile, the God-Emperor's son, Noraong Dhun, listened to the suggestions of a little bird, a Burmese bird. Soon he and his 68,500 infantry army evacuated Kayah and returned via Lampang to Dvaravati where he overthrew his father's government and installed his own. He asked for peace but was ignored by the Dai Viet and the Chekiang who had attacked into Phan Rang, Khemer and Siam. General U Latkyi heeded his call and even showed up in person to hammer out a deal. They had a common objective to defeat the war mongering Suryavarman and his army in their encampment at Mon. The combined Latkyi-Noroang force of 79,000 surrounded the 48,000 man Suryavid force, drew their swords and cut them ail down to a man. Suryavarman escaped the melee by boat and became a royal exile in the court of Pulakesin III.

The new God-Emperor thanked the old Burmese general for his help and promised peace between the two kingdoms. But then there are still the Viets and Cheks who seemed to have used this occasion for an excuse for a land grab.

In Burma, Monson II, Aniruddha II and U Latkyi all fell victim to the Saigon Flu. Aniruddha's son, Monson III, became the new King of Pagan.

"A crisis of destiny is brought upon us by the second dastardly attack of Kambujadesa against our allies in Pagan. In order to assure that the fate of our Dai Viet Empire rests in the best possible hands, I am appointing the altied ruler of Chiennan as heir to the Giap throne under the name of Giap Chien. He has his choice of the princesses of the house of Giap for a wife, and he will lead our armies into battle in the south."

In the face of Giap Shen, Quai's eldest son who would have come of age to be crown prince in 1218, Pang Chien of Chiennan brought his mob of Tais to the palace of Thanglong and assumed his place as the Successor. 'Giap' Pang Chien gained full command of the Viet army in Tonkin and gathered more troops in Champa and Cochin. He, along with the South Court Duke, Jon Nguyen, crossed the delta of the Mekong along with a massive detachment of Chekiang troops in Phan Rang to teach the Hidden Khmer a lesson. Phan Rang and the city of Saigon easily fell to the invaders. The large force of 75,000 men and a coast guard of 760 vessels then occupied Khemer, Angkor and Siam. They threatened Mangfu itself, but with a new peace between Kambuja and Burma, this adventure's purposa seemed to be rendered moot.

The Lingnan Prince, Rei Ling, was installed as the new North Court Duke.

After regrouping they then launched a foray against Jornada and Tiwa which was successful (but 2500 more died). These lands had to pay tribute in the form of corn.

At home, the Chumash began a migration along with their new Salinin allies, White Paint stopped by Yuma to get them to come too but didn't get them to a high enough status by the time he died. With Fog Teeth's son only six years old, he'll have to cross the deadly Papago Desert pick up the stranded settlers, cross the deadly desert again to get them to the new Chumash home. Of those left behind, Serrano revolted.
