Turbo: This turn processed so fast that it is now possible to speed up the turnover time. The next due date after this one shall be three weeks.

The Rapier Commentaire: I am including with this turn the Official Newsletter of Lords of the Earth, returned from the dead. If you have any articles you wish to submit to this tome send it typed with your orders and I pass it along to the Editor.

Diplomacy and Pacified Regions: Let's get this straight. Pacified region cannot be diplomacized. If you try to diplomacize a pacified region nothing will happen. You can convert a Pacified to tributary in order to diplomacize it, but the region will go through a revolt check and may have to be pacified again. If the region was militarily converted it will revert to the old religion. Also any region that you have recently attacked, no matter what status it may be, will have *resentment* towards you. It makes diplomacy tough.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning many ramparts, towers, & walls. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

Sugou ruled the Emirate in peace.

EMPIRE OF DAN
Bug III, Darklord, Bringer of the Ancestral Light
Trade Value: 7 **Partners:** Fulani, Congo
DIPLOMACY: Gagnoa(f), Togo(nt), Benue(t)
In Igbo, the port city of Idah was founded. Akan's regional GPv was restored to its pre-invasion (2/3). The main army moved back to Kwararafa so that the Darklord can look at them.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO
Toboshaka, King of Ba-Congo
Trade Value: 4 **Partners:** Fulani---, Man, Zimbabwe, Sakalava
DIPLOMACY: Chokwe(fa)
Toboshaka sent his worst general Mandela to bring the Kinsasha tribes under heel. Kinsasha and Kabwe were both forced to pay tribute because they were simply outnumbered. The Kasai forces (4000 men) attacked the Kivu but were beaten.

DIPLOMACY: Surashtra(ea), Malawi(f)
Ug Nogapunda took a dug out boat and visited Surashtra offering riches untold and a port city to the skeptical Hindu rulers there. It would be unseemly to surrender their autonomy to a nation of uncouth barbarians. But the Surashtrians finally gave in since war torn India would not offer them much protection. The city which faced the Malabar Sea was called Gobliguk. A shuttle fleet connected Gobliguk to Pundaport but to do this trade was halted with Ethiopia.
The Africa Bowl was impoverished by the loss of the Corsairs and the Aelite. And now the first Sub-Saharan team has won the crown by default.

The Aethiopians worked hard to gain new lands for their king. Some preparations were made to deal with possible spill over of the conflicts in the north. In Thebes across the river from Luxor, Amada was built. Aksum's GPv was colonized to (2/3).

THE BENU AL SAHAWI
The Bahawi scored a diplomatic victory with the help of the Byzantine Emperor but did not capitalize on it. And so the Benu's conquests unraveled. Akhi Fadl declared himself Emir of Jerusalem and with his command of almost 45,000 cavalry, no one disputed his claim. He rejected the diplomatic overtures of Lord Julius of Mahidia and threw him out.
In Mecca, the Emir of Medina killed Marun Akhmed for his weakness and became independent. Soon all of Arabia became neutral land for none would countenance rule from Jerusalem no more.

Mahidia wants trade. The Exodus Inward will not affect mercantile activity.

Ligurian diplomats canvassed the old Milanese territories and gained some of their support. The road from Ravenna to Bologna was extended to Parma in Emeiano.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCHLeo X, *Pope of Rome, Vicar of Christ, God's Chancellor Upon This Earth***Trade Value:** 5 **Partners:** Liguria, Spoleto, Arezzo
DIPLOMACY: Pisa(f), Cecina(f)

For being good Christians, the Bak Kingdom was given a treasure of Papal securities. The pontiff continued to rule like a king.

THE LOGBARD DUCHY OF SPOLETOJacapo, *Lagobard Doge of Spoleto***Trade Value:** 4 **Partners:** Pope, Tarantum
DIPLOMACY: none

The Spoleti did nothing to counter a new vigorous Arezzo.

THE LOGBARD DUCHY OF AREZZOAugusto di Salum, *Lagobard Doge of Arezzo***Trade Value:** 2 **Partners:** Liguria, Pope
DIPLOMACY: Sabini(c), Duchy of Spoleto(hs)

The Arezzi King got over his sickness and expanded his army by 5000 men. He did not have the credit needed to equip his new army with horses so he did without them. Tronto was friendly to Spoleto and had to be forced to pay tribute. Augusto's son Angelo was tossed out of Pescara soon after.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUMSeptim Drymitinos, *Despot of Taranto***Trade Value:** 3 **Partners:** Liguria, Spoleto, Byzantion
DIPLOMACY: none

The Despot's stamp fell off and so no orders could be issued. Christopher passed on and was followed by Septim, a son of his.

Eastern Europe**Mercs:** 20mc, 10mi**THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY** 672Magnus, *King of the Danes, Fighter of Robots***Trade Value:** 14 **Partners:** Saxonia, Francia, Poland, Kiev~
DIPLOMACY: Gautland(a, later rebels), Svealand(fa), Westphalia(f)

A new city, Helston, was built as a port on the tip of Cornwall facing the Celtic Sea. King Alek gathered up the main army but did not suffer invasion. The Hague grew in size. To finance this a new loan was arranged with Jewry.

The death of Alek II angered some court officials because he made no article of inheritance. Gautland took this as a sign of imminent civil war and revolted but ended up being the only territory to do so, due to the loyalty of Generals Haakon and Terrek. The Earl of Cornwall kept things cool in Westphalia, but he still wonders what his new city looks like. The new Thaerian Royal Personage, Magnus was grateful. Engineers had built the royal outhouse nine miles from the palace.

"That's a good safe distance", said the new king.

Most of Volazarn's advisors, guards and general staff were missing. The eldest son of the King, Iithrok Ben Faustus came of age in 1229.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAISnoak, *King of the Bakons***Trade Value:** 1 **Partners:** Francia, Poland, Kiev, Byzantion
DIPLOMACY: Bakony(a), Temesvar(a), Wallachia(a)

King Snoak got real paranoid over the existence of the Octopus. The Land thus was scoured for hideouts and salt water pools. None were found but the Bakonites found lots of snakes, moles and a buried cache of nuts. In Galacia, a land of pagans, Snoak found a wife, a woman who practices witchcraft and speaks with demons. She bore his heir, a boy, in 1227. Despite all this the Pope sent a treasure to Klutz.

The Novgorod army washed their long johns in the Dvina.

THE GRAND RUS OF KIEV 516Konstantin, *Grand Prince of Kiev***Trade Value:** 10 **Partners:** Saxonia(4)**, Thaery*, Poland, Bakonai, Bolgar, Byzantine
DIPLOMACY: Chernigov(f), Starodub(t)

The non-Orthodox Christian barbarians of the hostile steppe territories were again approached by the Russ leaders. The Russians asked that they should bow low to the Grand Prince. These barbarians did not agree. Fortunately, the Christians of Chernigov and Starodub were only to happy to throw their lot with Prince Konstantin.

Trade Value: 20 **Partners:** Aethiopia*, Mahidia-, Saxon*, Almoravid-, Liguria, Taranto, Francia-, Bakon, Kiev

DIPLOMACY: none

The Empire's couriers got waylaid outside Constantinople by bandits and was unable to properly deal with the Muslim counter attack. Out on the Gulf of Cyprus, Nike was wounded by an assassin. He and the fleet he led withdrew to Constantinople. The crazy Arabs attacked as far in as Bithnia and had also conquered Phrygia and Cilicia. Nicephorus IV died after years of illness. Young Nike has become the Fifth Emperor of the name Nicephorus.

THE PRIMATE OF CHRISTIAN ORTHODOXY

Hadrianicos, *Patriarch of Constantinopolis, Lord of the Apes*

DIPLOMACY: none

Orthodox priests threw wooden blocks at the Muslim invaders.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - THE ORTUQID REGENCY 1,155

Al Mustaziz, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

Timur al Ortuq, *Vizier of the Court*

Trade Value: 21 **Partners:** Sakalava*, Ethiopia*, Francia-, Jerusalem, Parthia, Chalukya-

DIPLOMACY: Azerbaijan(f), Aleppo(nt), Psidia(nt), Jordan(fa), Paphlagonia(nt), Cappadocia(fa)

Vizier Timur ordered the war be taken to Byzantion soil for they must pay in spoils for their destruction of Antioch and the despoilment of Aleppo. Lord Sal with 50,000 cavalry mustered in Hasakah passed through Aleppo to pacify Cilicia. He then climbed into Psidia, the old homeland of the Seljuks, in order to conquer Phrygia and the countryside of Bithnia. No opposition stood in Sal's way. In Bithnia, walled Troy remains unopened to Islam's enlightened rule.

The Azerbaijan forces crossed into Urmia and converted it by force to Sunni Islam. The Vaspurian Kingdom did nothing to stop the invasion of this mountain territory.

At the end of this turn, the Al Waqaod Caliph died. The new Caliph was named Al Mustaziz.

THE EMIRATE OF JERUSALEM

Trade Value: 1 **Partners:** Mahidia, Islam

DIPLOMACY: none

Akhi Fadl as he threw Lord Julius out of the palace promised trade would start and it did.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA 407

Dan XI, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*

Trade Value: 11 **Partners:** Ethiopia*, Islam, Ghur

DIPLOMACY: Dasht Lute(fa), Uzbek(nt)

Sacked Bukhara was rebuilt back to 1 GPv. A new fleet was built in Chah Bander to be sent to trade with Abyssinia. Although it is half a world away, the Parthians supported Francia's claim to Milano. They also think the Tiwanaku should be restored and the war between Taichud and Tumed should end.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Tughril, *Sultan of Afghans*

Trade Value: 4 **Partners:** Parthia, Kaunaj

DIPLOMACY: Kashmir(nt)

Masud Shah went to Kashmir and died when a snow leopard killed him. His son Mahmud who was the sultan far but a couple of months and he died too of the snow leopard sickness. Ten year old Tughril was too young so a regency was formed.

India

THE KHIRGIZ HORDE

Bisapala

DIPLOMACY: Tabargati(neutral)

Palungh and his boys tagged along with the Oghuz. The Tabargati kinsmen broke ranks to transform Jats into a horde block. Jats is now Asia-Pagan. At 1230, Palungh died and was succeeded after a power struggle by Bisapala.

THE OGHUZ HORDE

Gotoshama

DIPLOMACY: none

Toshama was killed but was painlessly succeeded by the more effective Gotoshama. He led the combined cavalcade of 233,000 nomads to Jaunpur to Kuru where the land locked capital could be sieged. Kotta was well defended of course and had much rice in reserve.

While waiting for the food to run out Gotoshama received a visitor. His name (in order to protect the guilty) was Fish Head. Fish Head spoke, "So you're the guys we've heard about. You might need this."

Gotoshama was offered a gift of 30 baskets of pearls.

The aquatic one jumped back into the river and swam away. The offer was needed because Kotta has shown no signs of surrender.

THE PRATHARA EMPIRE OF KAUNAJ 451

Prathara Kohngupta, *Emperor of Kaunaj*

Trade Value: 11 **Partners:** Sakalava, Ghur, Chalukya, Rastrakuta, Tibet, Pagan

DIPLOMACY: Bihar(t)

In order to be better prepared against the Great Unwashed, all the merchant abroad were recalled. He also hiked taxes as high as possible to pay for the new heavy infantry muster. The hordes moved cautiously and deliberately. They decided to try and crack open Kotta because it can't be relieved by sea.

After occupying Kuru they surrounded the city and waited. By the end of 1230, a messenger bird from the defending general reports morale is beginning to fall after four long years of isolation.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM 1,395

Pulakesin III, *The Great Muta, King of the South*

Trade Value: 15 **Partners:** Ethiopia*, Islam*, Kaunaj, Rastrakuta, Pagan*, Java, Chekiang

DIPLOMACY: Seylan(f), Chela(f), Kwa(f)

Massive wall points were built throughout the realm in preparation of a possible horde attack. Gift were sent to Kaunaj and Java. Orissa was given back to Rastrakuta, and Pulakesin, the Rajah Rabbit, with his troops withdrew back to Kollam.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Rastrakuta Hiryu, *Emperor of Manyakheta*

Trade Value: 3 **Partners:** Kaunaj, Rastrakuta

DIPLOMACY: Sri Lanka(t), Vengi(n)

The Rastrakuta withdrew most of the garrison from Pundra. The Pundrans rose in revolt and killed the remainder. Rex of Vengi died and his successor claims not to have any part of Rastrakuta. At least Chalukya returned Orissa to Hiryu. A peace of convenience had occurred because of the hordes out there.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Shan Kabu, *2nd Dalai Lama*

Trade Value: 2 **Partners:** Kaunaj, Pagan, Vietnam, Di Zhong

DIPLOMACY: none

The Tibet was mildly concerned that their soft pro-Kambujan stance will bring retribution from the Pagan Empire. Not so - they were scared of the hordes as was every kingdom in India and Indo-China the Old Panchen died and a new Holy Lama rose to the near top in Lhasa.

South-East Asia

Merces: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 5mg

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN 825

Monson III, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*

Trade Value: 11 **Partners:** Kaunaj, Chalukya, Tibet, Java-, Vietnam, Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: Kachin(hs)

For their part in the Kambuja war in to remedy the grievances the Paganese populace felt towards Vietnam for keeping all the land of the Cambodians who had so savagely attacked them, Siam, Dvaravati and Mon were given to Pagan. But the ultimate destiny of 3500 elite infantry in the area must return to the Chekiang Dragon. They were thus given to the their Kedah commander when Chekiang boats arrived to pick them up. Marshal Mahaw toured the new possessions. He made the astute observation that diplomacy in pacified regions is futile. Monson marched north to deal with the Kachin problem and prepare the western garrisons for a possible horde attack. A weak monsoon weather pattern has brought on a mild drought in the Irrawady Valley.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA 990Guppimsutra, *King of the Spice Islands***Trade Value:** 18 **Partners:** Chalukya, Pagan*, Vietnam*, Chekiang**DIPLOMACY:** Atjeh(c), Sarawak(f), Medan(t)

Three cities were expanded as the Javanese seemed immune of this horde hysteria affecting the whole area.

China**Merca:** 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 5meg**THE DAI VIET GUO** 864Giap Quai, *Wang Dai Viet***Trade Value:** 12 **Partners:** Tibet, Pagan, Java-, Chekiang, Zhong, Amago***DIPLOMACY:** Surin(t), Nan Pung(t)

The Viet gave Siam, Dvaravati and Mon to Pagan and claimed Nan Pung and Surin as their own. Pang Chien whose supporters now consolidated power at the palace in Thanglong (His victories in Kambuja did much to increase his standing in the Kingdom) alienated those supporters by naming the missing Giap Shen as his heir (so his own wife Giap Lhoi). He all but sent his own son Pang Xihou to political oblivion. Eventually Giap Quai, whose feet was to the fire by the Pang house, received an immediate blow up by appointing Pang Xihou to the North Court with the understanding he'll take over as the King someday.

Giap Quai knew he had made a mistake when he appointed his elder Chien heir but it was too late, the Pang control the palace now. Pang Chien marched the troops into Surin, threatened them a little bit (but was nice about it), went to Nan Pung got them totally cowed. He arrived into the Thanglong court and was hurrahed, admired and adored. Chien was regaled greatly.

A ransom was sent to Chekiang to return Giap Shen but the Prince was not returned which started rumors that he'd been killed. The Pang house cared not his fate and considered the ransom as payment for the Chekiang help in the Kambuja war.

In Taiwan, the port of Taipei was built to face the Bashi Channel. Trade with Amago was established. The famine that affected Burma struck Vietnam worse. The Mekong River level flowed much less than normal all year long. Like Pagan, the rice reserves were not enough to feed all the hungry mouths.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG 1496Quan Chiu, *Celestial King of Chekiang***Trade Value:** 17 **Partners:** Chalukya, Pagan-, Java, Vietnam, Zhong, Taichud, Amago***DIPLOMACY:** Kanchou(fa), Hong Kong(t), Luzon(c), Leyte(f)

As the instability of the Hopei sector continued, the Kambuja expedition returned home to be reunited with Chekiang forces. A mutual defense treaty was announced to exist with Di Zhong. Moneys poured in from the Taichud and Vietnam. The Chekiang was brutalized by the Great Famine. The Yangtze River virtually dried up starving thousands. The cities of Chienkang, Zuzhou, Tani, Jao and Zhaoti all were reduced one GPv.

THE DI ZHONG GUO 656Ping Ra, *Emperor of the Middle Kingdom***Trade Value:** 16 **Partners:** Tibet, Vietnam, Chekiang, Tumed, Taichud**DIPLOMACY:** none

Emperor Ping Ra stood down his forces. He thought the threats to his borders not to be serious. The tremendous agro reserves kept the Di Zhong well fed during the Great Famine.

THE SIA OF TUMEDSia Miong, *Emperor of Sia Tumed***Trade Value:** 2 **Partners:** Zhong**DIPLOMACY:** none

The Implied Threat was enough. Liaotung was lost. The Huang Ho flowed normally.
