Announcements

Two Extra Weeks: Because of some extracurricular activity I'm engaged in, the turn will be two weeks later than I would normally set.

Phantom Armies: The most common error found on the stat sheet are missing armies. If an army that should be on the stat sheet does not show up, chances are you still have that army. One clue is that you are still paying troop support for your lost army. If you think you have a 'phantom army', let me know.

ITV: I have moved the ITV to the ISI list, replacing ESI Rank. If it seems inconvenient, I know. In two turns, the computer will calculate your International Trade income.

Fax Letter Announcements: If you want an announcement printed in the fax, either make it very short (50 words or less) or lend me a Mac disk with the announcement stored therein. I cannot slow the campaign just to retype long messages. I will peraphrase them if I encounter these.

Colonization: Just to be clear on this. Colonizing a region costs 15 GP and 15 NFP per GPv level. If a region had already been settled in the past, the cost is reduced to 10 GP and 10 NFP per GPv level. To colonize an empty region: (/), you must colonize it to 0 GPv first (as if it was a GPv), and THEN spend the required costs to settle the region to its maximum amount.

Example: The Roadhogs want to settle depopulated Flatbed to 3 GPv. they need to spend a total 40 NFP and 40 GP to restore the population of that region.

This rule should be explained in the Version II Rules Supplement v2.0 or 2.1.

The Jackal made the pagans nervous when his military descendent Yarn Lid enslaved the formerly tributary but Afro-Pagan territory of Matopos. Jewish settlers replaced them entirely. Mapungubwe disavowed any relation with the Zimbabwe. Zambia also rebelled. Five Twin Jackal lost his matzo balls.

It became a generic title rather than a name) sailed up to Mornbassa Trade Contert to gather fresh berrier for the teddy bear, of what a wondrous stang it was to eath and skip on the garden path troops. These combined with the forces in Kikuyu to count 6500 heavy infantry. 11,500 light infantry. In 1240, the ettack on Buganda occurred. His father Gobbu III, had died, perished, gone six feet under, ceased to be, tapped by the Grim Reaper, kicked the bucket, croaked...

DIPLOMACY: Umbria(nt), Cecina(f), Chiana(t), Pontino(t)

The Papacy continued to build up a land empire and then tell kings what to do. The influence of the Papacy in Europe thus waned when the new Pope John V was crowned. Low rainfall has resulted in a famine. Mass starvation occurred in the cities. Livorno, Slena, Plsa and Arezzo all lost their gold point value.

While not doing anything especially important, a real papel gold shipment arrived at the palace in København. The departure of Cornwall disrupted international trade.

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCIA

Trade Partners: Mahidia~, Saxon, Liguria, Thaery, Poland, Bakonai, Byzantion*, letern*

DIPLOMACY: Carinthia(a), Champagne(f)

While receiving a repayment from the Saxons, the Frankon sent aid to Poland and Bakonai. Diplomats sent to Old Milano were countered by the embassies of Liguria. The war of words and promises became a draw.

THE MARGRAVATE OF POLSKA

Volazam II, Markgraf of Poland

DIPLOMACY: Kassubia(f)

King Volazam expected an attack by Caldreigum Pauli. Pauli disappointed Volazam once again.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

DIPLOMACY: Goryn(ea), Croatia(fa)

To prevent the ire of the scared superstitious folk and the Church. Snoak's horned son, Evillo, was put in a seminary to be taught good Christian ethics.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Ivano the Unwashed, Chieftain of Novgorod

Trade Partners: Polska, Bolgar DIPLOMACY: Yaroslav(a)

The Novgorod army moved to Polotsk and awaited a possible counter attack. Rurik died to enable Ivano to become a very important guy.

THE GRAND RUS OF KIEV

Konstantin, Grand Prince of Kiev
Trade Partners: Byzantine
DIPLOMACY: none

Konstantin felt isolated in the world and fell into a blue funk. Caldreigurn Pauli got real angry at him and attacked. Konstantin and Rodya Melvin with their 39,000 soldiers repulsed Pauli's 21,000 man coup attempt. Pauli was wounded and Konstantin counter attacked. The survivors were all killed and Caldreigurn Pauli was executed. Strangely enough, no one attacked and the three isolated territories: Lithuania, Masuria and Prussia did not rebel.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Melvin did not cherish the idea of Muslims converting Euro-Pagans so he sent his bishop to Russia to deal with them. Most Holy went to Palestine and watch Islam's brutal armies destroy the Emirate of Jerusalem.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - THE ORTUQID REGENCY

And as Islam's armies started throwing tear gas into the compound, fire broke out. THE CHORID SULTANATE OF AFCHANISTAN

Tughril, Sultan of Afghans

DIPLOMACY: no effect

Tughril sent a leader to Ghebel Gharib but he revolted.

Bisanala

DIPLOMACY: none

The Khirgiz and Oghuz hordes broke from their home of over eight years to loot and plunder. Kuru, Sursuti, Chitor, Vatsa, Jihjhoti and Jaunpur weire looted and Tirhut was conquered. The city of Kalanjara in Jihjhoti which had no walls, was not sacked.

THE OGHUZ HORDE

Gotoshama

DIPLOMACY: none

The Oghuz screened the Khirgiz and stomped on any who got in the way. In Chitor an army of 18,000 was flattened.

THE PRATIHARA EMPIRE OF KAUNAI

Pratihara Wanagupta, Emperor of Kaunaj

Trade Partners: Islam~, Ghur, Rastrakuta, Tibet, Pagan

DIPLOMACY: Jats(c)

Wanagupta, not a good king, declared a major bureaucrat to be the Imperial Heir rather his own son! Why Nagavijaha is not even a Pratihara. But most the attention was focused on the hordes who rampage the territory. Their adventure had caused the rebellions of Bihar, Chitor, Jihjhoti and Vatsa. The Kamarupa ally lost his entire army. Kuru and Jaunpur are no longer intensely cultivated. Sind was restored to 3 GPv and Antizani was made the new capital.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Pulakesin III, The Great Muta, King of the South

Trade Partners: Sakalava, Ethiopia*, Islam*, Rastrakuta, Pagan, Java, Chekiang

DIPLOMACY: Vengi(a), Gujarat(a)

The Chalukya sent gold treasure to the beleaguered Kaunaji. In exchange Kaunaj sent some of their preserved harvest surplus. The new royal prince was married to the daughter of Nils of Vengi which helped restore Vengi to the Mandalam.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Rastrakuta Kunara, Emperor of Manyakheta

Trade Partners: Kaunaj, Chalukya, Pagan~

DIPLOMACY: Pundra(nt)

The soon to be new Raj, Kunara, stopped by Pundra. Pundra was no fan of Rastrakuta having recently been attacked and degraded in front of him.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Shan Kabu, 2nd Dalai Lama

Trade Partners: Kaunaj, Pagan, Vietnam

DIPLOMACY: none

The Lamas kept themselves secluded in their isolation. No bizarre thoughts of taking over other Buddhist sects ever entered their minds. Not in meditation at least.

South-East Asia

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Monson III, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

Trade Partners: Kaunaj, Chalukya, Rastrakuta*, Tibet, Java~, Vietnam, Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: none

Aid was sent to the Kaunaj and Rastrakuta who are on the frontline against the horse barbarians. Land patrols along the frontler reported no trouble.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Eelimsutra, King of the Spice Islands

Trade Partners: Chalukya, Pagan*, Vietnam*, Chekiang

DIPLOMACY: Sabah(f), Medan(a)

The Javanese were protective of their strategic passages. So there was Eelimsutra in the Malacca Strait posting 'no fishing' signs when a courier told him his father's gills had turned green. From Medan, the suddenly new king could not reach every thing. But only Bali revolted.

China, land of Death!

THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Chien, Wang Dai Viet

Trade Partners: Tibet, Pagan, Java-, Chekiang, Taichud-, Amago*

DIPLOMACY: Hainan(ea), Chiennan(a), Surin(f)

As predicted when Giap Quai died, a dynastic failure occurred. This was precipitated as Pang Chien finally got to become the King of the Viets. Only Preituk and Yunnan rebelled and the claim on Hmong lost. The light catastrophe soured the heart of Giap Shen, long a fixture of the Chekiang Dragon's Court. The circle is now complete as Uncle Darth would oft say: The Pangs are the undisputed rulers of the Southern Kingdom.

In Mison, there was a new port city called Hué.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Chiu, Celestial King of Chekiang

Trade Partners: Chalukya, Pagan-, Java, Vietnam, Taichud, Amago*

DIPLOMACY: Lichou(nt), Szechwan(ea)

The Emperor took his mighty army out for more military exercises. They want north-west to Hupei, but they did not stop. The training was over, it was time for war. It was decreed by the Dragon that the excesses of Di Zhong's rule can no longer be ignored; they must be brought low before their oppressive armies overran the tranquil south.

Lichou was cowed by the in transit Chekiang forces. Their numbers exceeded 120,000 men and they were all elite. Quan Chiu immediately moved to secure the passes between Chingling and Shensi before actually taking Chingling itself. This ensured that any reaction would meet in the mountains, a terrain the Dragon himself chose. About 70,000 men, mostly cavalry regiments responded to the invasion. Another 1500 infantry attacked the Chekiang in the mar; they were pests. The Di Zhong were missing the First Cavalry Regiment as Ping Ra had been wounded by a killer. Still they almost dislodged the Chekiang from the mountain passes and chased them out of Chekiang from the mountain passes and chased them out of Chingling but Quan Chiu prevailed. The reaction was entirely mauled and their leaders fied the scene. It was thereafter an easy allair to reduce Karatur afterwards.

THE DI ZHONG GUO

Ping Furnanra, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom

The Di Zhong had expected a gold shipment from the Cheklang not an invasion. Because Ping Ra was too sick, only Di Mei and Lau Chi combined their forces to wedge the Hidden Dragon out of their hiding spots in the Qinling Range. It was too tall a job. It was hopeless. The Capital Karatur fell on the 24th day of September 1237. 17 days later, the Oriot Horde, all 112,500 of them attacked the Pei-Huang/Ordos Great Wall section. Ping Ra and his men on the Great Wall section. Ping Ra and his men on the Great Wall repulsed them but the lost the entire Cavalry Regiment to do so. They attacked again the Spring of the following year and this time overflowed over the Great Wall. Ping Ra died of the rare Hoof Storny disease.

His son Furnanra was in Chinghu. All was precarious when the government had collapsed, but now a Emperor died. Only long isolated Koguryo rebelled. The Oriot panned into Shensi and forced Di Mei and Lau Chi into Kansu. The two generals at the new redoubt of Sum formed an independent Kingdom of Hei and took for themselves Kansu, Tsingfeng and Wu Hai. Everything else remained in Furnanra's hands (That is Kwelchou, Tungchuan, Chengdu, Chinghu, Tangchou and Honan) though the empire is scattered and non-contiguous. The Di Zhong Emperor dreads the future.

THE TARGET KINGDOM OF HSI

Lau Chi, Buckshot Bait

Trade Partners: Turned, Taichud

DIPLOMACY: none

Lau Chi gained the loyalty of the old general DI Mei. This new kingdom is at the mercy of hordes.

THE KWON OF TUMED

Kwon Ji, Emperor of Sia Turned

Trade Partners: Hsi DIPLOMACY: almost

Sia Feng went to Yen and picked a fight with the Taichud army there. He had 58,500 cavalry against 32,000. But he died in battle. So in his place arose the next dynasty of Turned, the Kwon. The attempt to ensiave Ordos failed. A very bad harvest has starved a few farmers in the Turned realm.

THE TAICHUD KHANATE
