THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Mustapha the Mean, *Emir of the Fulani*

DIPLOMACY: Nupe(nt), Ghana(c), Khalem(c)

With over 50,000 foot soldiers in tow, the Mean Emir marched into Nupe proved to be a more central locale to rule the entire land, including the distant and isolated Takrur and Gambia. Hammad, The official Keeper of the Royal Fan, went further overseas to Kazmedina and found the Free City hopelessly too distant to control.

The merchant ships in Dakar restored trade with Andalusia. En route, a somewhat precarious land route was secured between Dakar and Gao. Kurfei got to enjoy the bounties of being cultivated.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Hiboe

DIPLOMACY: none

Unlike their new Fulani trade partners, the Togo were wholly oblivious to the Basoko threat. Hiboe replaced Ktaur as the king by rite of succession by natural death. This nation is open for a player.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Baco, *King of Ba-Congo*

DIPLOMACY: Omote(nt), Likasi(nt), Kinsasha(c), Mitumba(t)

Baco felt totally threatened by the Basoko now and did nothing to allay his fears. Mbundu became cultivated.

THE BASOKO

Dobbs

DIPLOMACY: none

Melvin died but from sickness in 1260. He spent five years counting toes and would not move from the safety of Mankim. Little Dobbs took over. He's a pygmy.

East Africa

Merce: 10mi, 5mg

THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, *Zimbabwe King*

DIPLOMACY: Shona(nt), Karanga(c)

Rustling once more through the dense leafy undergrowth, the Zimbabwe were alive. Great and Lower Zimbabwe are bigger cities now.

THE SAKALAVANS

Zonk Nogapunda, *Little Caesar of Madagascar, The Great Slobbering Taz*

DIPLOMACY: Kilwa(c), Mombassa(c), Surashtra(c), Loangar(a), Malawi(c), Kimbu(nt), Lamu(c), Burundi(nt)

"Are we going to die?"

"Not unless some huge smelly horde attacks us."

The Sakalavans did not die. Mozambi turned cultivated. Buganda and Kikuyu are no longer isolated.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Wobbu, *King of Aethiopia*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

The Ethiopians thought that maybe they were the next target of Basoko. They had believed the stories of this barbarian nation that had destroyed entire kingdoms in one move. King Wobbu camped with his army just in case.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Merce: 10mhc, 10mhi, 10mi

THE BLACK TOWER EMIRATE OF MAHIDIA

Suentius Po III, *Prince of the West, Captain of the Corsairs*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Mahidians saw the Ortuqid as a threat to the political stability of Estarcion. The Darkwing Roach and Sergeant Preston (of the Yukon) attacked

Palestine and Lebanon and turned over control of these pacified provinces to the Baghdad Caliphate. Jerusalem was left an open city so that pilgrims could drop by anytime. The Punisher Roach made a trip to give 100,000 dinars to the Araik World. This made it only as far as Zaporozhie and then courier had to go home.

A new trade route was started with Tarantum. Alexandria and Syracuse expanded.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Robert II the Giant, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: Gwynned(c), Strathclyde(ea)

The army of Southern Saxonia was marched by Earl Leofric of Northampton to Bavaria where a multi-national force gathered expecting a barbarian eruption. Otherwise, the Saxonian Empire was at peace and prospering. A substantial gift was carted to the Moorish Andalusians.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Abd ar Rahman, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: Leon(f)

The Moors increased their contact with Catholic powers opening trade routes with Spoletto and Francia (and one to Orthodox Tarantum). Leon was bestowed with gifts as it turned spontaneously to Sunni Muslim.

Italy

Merca: 10mhi, 10mi, 5mg

THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Nero, *King of Liguria*

DIPLOMACY: Polesine(t), Langhe(ea), Lepontine(ea)

Lombardy was resettled to its original (2/2) status by excess Catholic populations. Nero handed the keys to the cavalry force to generals Bruno and Marco who went up the Alps and into the Bavarian hills. The infantry stayed home safe in Genoa, arresting would-be terrorists.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Urban IV, *Pope of Rome, Vicar of Christ*

DIPLOMACY: Pontino(a)

"The Papal See canonizes Robert the Great (died 1200 AD) as Saint Robert of Saxonia, in recognition of the Saxon monarch's deeds and accomplishments."

The Pope sent Cardinal Michael to the Black Sea coast and gave the Araik a ransom of 200,000 and a few bibles. This investment was well spent for the Araik left the region and headed back East. The Alanni were unreceptive to any diplomatic conversions and killed the envoys. Pope John V died too and a priest from Verona became Urban IV.

THE LOMBARD DUCHY OF SPOLETO

Ottone, *Lagobard Duke of Spoletto*

DIPLOMACY: Sabini(nt)

The Spoleti sent an army to Bavaria. Not a large one mind you, but one with an excellent captain, Niccolo Galeazzano, attached. Jacapo's long reign was cut short when a ceratosaurus came by and ate him. His son Ottone is now Prince.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Septim Drymittinos, *Despot of Taranto*

DIPLOMACY: Squillacia(ea)

Tarantum opened trade with Mahidia, Almoravid, Saxonia and Francia by way of the big puddle.

Eastern Europe

Merca: 20mc, 10mi

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Romer II, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: Halland(a)

A fleet of 160 longboats sailed over to the Dnepr River and along with Romanoi and Bakonite boats patrolled that river hoping to deny the Araik passage. The Araik dared them not. Maimo in Skáne expanded. The elite force, the Hammer of Tor, went to England on a secret mission...

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCIA

Casimir, *Panarch of Francia*

DIPLOMACY: none

In Bavaria, the armies of many nations and a dozen alamosaurs grouped. People who dared to count them all came to a figure around 170,000. The soldiers waited for their chance of battle and valor and were sorely disappointed. Casimir named his daughter the Dame Fuwinna to be the Royal Heir. Switzerland rebelled.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Volazam III, *Markgraf of Poland*

DIPLOMACY: Goryn(nt), Prussia(t), Pr. of Kiev(f)

Even as crowds cheered the troops headed to another wet, soggy, distant war to get shamelessly slaughtered on a foreign soil, those who stayed behind built a new settlement. The new port city in Kassubia named Danzig was it.

Wulharrik's force of 15,000 cavalry and 15,000 infantry joined some 13,000 Bakonites in Ózu and until the end of 1258, remained on horde watch. Hearing the news that the Araik have left Europe encouraged the combined Polsk-Bak force to take on Kiev (they were on the skids). The Region of Kiev was overrun easily as the defenders withdrew inside their capital. Led by the Bakon general Dracba, the armies besieged Kiev city. The Kievans were badly led and left many blind spots on their barricades with which the attackers pursued. Eventually Dracba and Wulharrik's men burned down the city towers and got the hadrosaur to tear down the wooded pickets. In all this hubbub, Dracba died of influenza. King Konstantin eluded capture but later died in the forest of an infection when he was bitten by a giant squirrel in Chernigov.

In 1260, King Ilthrok fell into a mine shaft and was smashed flat by a 12 ton boulder. His successor Volazam III was well respected as a compassionate and caring guy who will not get his hands dirty even to dig for gold. The defeated Kiev state felt confident that the new Polish Markgraf was their friend. Thus in a surprise move, Olem Michurin, the last surviving boyar of Kiev, declared the realms still held by Kiev: Chernigov, Atelkuzo and Lyubbech be given to Volazam III of Warsaw. Kiev thus became friendly, instead of pacified. Volazam also got a promotion. He's now a Great Prince.

Crimea has nothing to do with this new order and became neutral (later a Byzantine protectorate). The Popes inherited a Kiev trade route to Byzantion.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

Snoak, *King of the Bakons*

DIPLOMACY: Galicia(nt), Moldavia(n)

Without Papal support, The Bakonites were unable to raise the planned new armies that would be sent to the Kiev frontier to fight the Araik. The plan was adjusted and marched into Ózu anyway, forcing tribute from the Russian colony. Dracba and Snoak joined forces with the Poles to reduce the fortifications of Kiev and capture the proud Russian capital. But Snoak was asked to leave when the Russians merged with the Polish Margravate. In the Dnepr River, Prince Evillo was bored so he did some fishing. A 25 foot mosasaur caught his line and pulled him in the river. The hitherto unknown Tatarian piranha devoured him underwater. The Horned Prince left no will. For an entire month afterwards, farm animals wore only black.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Ivano the Unwashed, *Chieftain of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: none

Novgorod's capital city expanded to 3 GPv.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Jiku, *Emir of Great Bolgar*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

Rashid knew he'd been beat. He gave all his spare gold to the Araik. That did not stop them from looting Khazar. Rashid died when a dead sparrow fell from the sky and hit him in the back of the neck. The new emir Jiku wore an extra thick neck brace at the funeral. A lone fortress was built in Suzdal to guard the Volga river from the menace of the brain bats.

ASIA

The Middle East

Merca: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms, 5mg

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus VII, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*

DIPLOMACY: Crimea(nt)

While the Araik barbarians may have extorted gold from the Frankish Kingdoms and their Pope, the Emperor of New Rome will not buckle under an unshod hoof. The Sixth Nicephorus Emperor expanded the great navy and raised up walls for the Dacian cities. In Georgia a fortress was made to protect the Eastern outpost. The Araik did not ford the Dnepr and left the Empire unmoled. Nicephorus VI died in 1260 of total relief. New trade routes were opened with the Poles and the Pope in Rome.

THE ORTUQID SULTANATE OF ANTAKYA

After being defeated in Aleppo and Antioch, the Ortuqid cause was no longer in vogue. Those who still resisted the Arbiliq Vizier were rounded up and killed. Pontus, Edessa and Charsionon have become independent.

THE EMIRATE OF DIMASHQ

Jabar, *Emir of Damascus*

DIPLOMACY: none

Kerak was killed by Baghdad agents so Jabar was quickly installed as Emir. He could not support his fortification nor his government and so dismissed them. All the money we had went to feed and equip his army.

These was attacked by the Erbel regents in 1258 and after several rounds of battle won a costly victory. The army of Hamoud returned to Antioch intent on returning.

This nation could use a player.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ REGENCY

Al Mustaziz, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

Mazin el Erbel, *Vizier of the Court*

DIPLOMACY: Psidia(t), Cappadocia(nt)

Mazin Erbel's control of Baghdad allowed him the privilege of activating the Caliph's reserves troops, 40,000 cavalry. Combined with the Iraq garrison, the Arbilq Viziers were able to field three armies. The first and third of these joined forces to amount to 136,000 cavalry and attacked in turn, Palmyra and Aleppo. In Aleppo were 36,500 cavalry and 2000 infantry, the forces of Arj al Ortuq. Arj was a good commander but he was outnumbered big time. His entire force was wiped out, Arj had to flee into Antioch.

Six months later, the second army had arrived. They were 34,000 infantry and 1650 ballista. They had reclaimed Raqqah (and Hasakeh) and were ready to assault Antioch. So after 14 more days, Antioch fell. Arj was captured and executed on the spot. The commanding general Jurji captured an empty treasury and some scribes and clerics whom were sent back to Baghdad.

The third army led by Hamoud ibn Jurji had by then split from the main forces to attack Syria the home of the Damascus rebellion. Prince Jabar was on hand with 44,500 cavalry. Hamoud had the speed and the leadership but Jabar had the slight numbers and the home ground. In time, Hamoud was unable to beat the Syrians and had to conduct a strategic withdrawal. Only 9000 cavalry were left.

Jurji after capturing Aleppo went on to regain control of Cilicia, its city, Psidia, Galatia and finally, Cappadocia. Mazin was happy to report to his Caliph that the Dar-al-Islam has pretty much been restored to its old pre-bombshell borders. In the midst of all this civil strife, the Ortuqid famine continued. This led to the reduction in the city populations of Antioch, Acre, Jerusalem and Tabriz by 1 GPv each.

THE GOLDEN HORDE OF THE ARAIK KHAN

Barada, *Khan of Khans, Arbiter of Destiny*

DIPLOMACY: Qiagor allies(f), Ratturk allies(f), Featol allies(f), Honvar Nomads(f), Alanni Horde(f), Vabol Folk(nt), Scorpion People(nt), Kipchak Horde(nt), Warghut Tribes(nt), Cotturk Tribes(nt), Saiyum Tribes(nt), Argu(nt), Kuldja(nt)

Tuashtri received a lot of gold from the scared Europeans. It was enough, thought the mighty Khakhan and the Araiik rode eastward and rested at the end of 1260 at a Frunze watering hole. Ni of Qiagor, Tanchid of Ratturk and Barada of the Featols were made princes with the marriages to Tuashtri's lovely daughters. Of these, Tanchid died in 1260 and so did Tuashtri of fecal germ poisoning from the water hole. Tuashtri's son Markbel and Lavax fought to succeed him. Lavax was a better fighter but Markbel cheated to win. Barada took exception to this and slew Markbel. Ni rose to oppose Barada and was killed in another duel. Having won the World Araiik Federation (WAF) championship belt, Barada put to death the child prince Gukmoor and married all the surviving daughters of the late Mansor (eldest son of Tuashtri) even though they weren't of age yet. In the far reaches of the realm, Pereaslavi, Seversk, Murom and Kursk quietly asserted their independence. Kuldja and Beshbalik are now cultivated.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*

DIPLOMACY: Arran(a), Khovar(fa)

The Parthians rebuilt Samarkhand and Tashkent just in time for the Araiik's return to the steppes north of them. Arsoces replaced an ailing Platopus as the Shahanshah.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Tughril, *Sultan of Afghans*

DIPLOMACY: none

Sultan Tughril noticed that Sind was populated with Hindus and decided to do something about it. With his army of 13,500 cavalry and 11,000 infantry he set about a military conversion of the region and the city too. This act took over two years to accomplish and requiring the defeating of the Sind Raj's army and the armed insurrection of the people and the assault of Antizani. Tughril and his well trained cavalry beat them into a pacified form of submission.

Buri the general went to the coast of Ghebel Gherib and built Akata as an outpost along the Red Sea. Unfortunately, inland and so had to hole up in his

enclave city for the time being. A tribe of settlers thus had to wait in Akata for five more years.

India

Merce: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE CACAS KINGDOM OF KAUNAJ

Guptagupta II, *King of Kotla*

DIPLOMACY: Multan(nt), Vatsa(n)

The Kaunaj took advantage of the respite to reclaim lost regions and expand overseas trade. King Nagavijaha died in 1260 of whooping cough.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Pulakesin III, *The Great Muta, King of the South*

DIPLOMACY: Jats(hs)

Pulakesin prepared for a rough ride as the hordes once more recombined to play bad cop - ugly cop to the North Deccan countryside. The Oghuz attacked and made tributary all of Pawar, Dahala, Kakatiya, Chela and Rastrakutan Orissa. Without Chalukya leaders, the garrisons were left to fend for themselves and each city encountered by the hordes capitulated to them without having to be entered. In Kalinga, Kitcar with 50 castles, 900 siege engines, 15,000 infantry and 8000 home troops got nuked by the hordes. Kitcar fled inside Gunter's ramparts and held the city against them.

Pulakesin was disappointed a this mounting losses and regretted not recalling Kitcar's army from Kalinga and all the regional garrisons from certain death. On the plus side, Lata and Gujarat were restored to the Mandalam. Kosala revolted to join the Oghuz. Jats is holding lord Suey Shidar for 10 GP ransom.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Chanda, *Emperor of Manyakheta*

DIPLOMACY: Bihar(fa)

Lord Chanda improved Konorak only to see it destroyed when Konorak was sacked by the hordes in May of 1260. Orissa itself was forced to pay tribute to them. Overland trade with Chalukya was thus cut. Prince Chinaja, younger brother to Chanda, married the princess of Pagan, Koissa. His sister Chinaji was married off to the young prince in the Pagan house, Candonmara.

THE OGHUZ HORDE

Raitobisa

DIPLOMACY: Malwa(nt), Kosala(nt), Satava(nt)

A small part of the tribes of Oghuz ran away as Gotbshama was assassinated by the Kaunaj. After the obligatory year of turmoil, a new khan, Raitobisa, took command. Raitobisa's men joined with the Khirgiz and the 120,000 or so cavalry battalion conquered for Oghuz Pawar, Dahala, Chela, Kakatiya, Orissa and most of Kalinga. The Khirgiz ensured the Oghuz tax rate be 0% by looting all the conquered territory. A little less gold than was expected was found in the khan's saddle bags. Chitor is a neutral, politically.

THE KHIRGIZ HORDE

Roptikapala

DIPLOMACY: none

Khirgiz numbers slowly whittled down as each region was tributized, especially in Kalinga. But the survivors got to do the fun stuff, rape and pillage, trample and sack. Roptikapala was protected from two assassination plots by his assistant Tahagh.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Opihou, *3rd Dalai Lama*

DIPLOMACY: Tungchuan(t), Ormchu(c)

The Panchen found a third Buddha in a village in Kachin riding the back of a stegosaurus. The young brat with the name Opihou was decked in chifon yellow and began his intensive training befitting the holy spirit of the Living Buddha.

South-East Asia

Merce: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 5mg

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Monson III, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*

DIPLOMACY: none

Cawrang returned home in celebration and fanfare but soon died of malaria in Assam. There were some unrest in neutral Lampang. Fido expanded a bit.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA*Eelimsutra, King of the Spice Islands*

DIPLOMACY: Medan(f), Bali(f), Perak(f)

For their efforts in keeping the salt content of the Pacific Ocean low, the Chinese and Vietnamese allowed for the Javanese merchants to return to mainland ports.

THE BULIBAJAH

Ulimat

DIPLOMACY: none

Ulimat stayed put in Medan.

China

Merces: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mai, 5mag

THE DAI VIET GUO*Ping Xihou, Wang Dai Viet*

DIPLOMACY: Preikuk(t)

To facilitate trade and make communications easier, port fortresses were built in strategic junctures. Hui Ca Mau was plopped on the map facing the Penunjak in Phan Rang. Kaoslung appeared facing the Dongsha in Taiwan. The new port city of Leizhou was established in Lingnan facing the Gulf of Tonkin. The King went to Hmong to purview the status of the five frond monkey blossom fields. Because of Xihou's lack of administrative skill, Hainan called it quits and became neutral.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG*Quan Tsanda, Celestial King of Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: Chinghu(f), Kwangte(nt), Tangchou(t), Chengdu(fa)

The Emperor was disgusted with the ineffective regime of the Turned and their delays in rebuilding their section of the wall. So in early 1257, the Great Emperor met with Oriot forces and attacked them. The Chekiang had 80,000 elite cavalry and 30,500 elite infantry, all of varying equipment. The Oriot forces were estimated to be 55,000 cavalry. All these were handy in stomping on the 45,000 Turned defenders. That was the main reaction force. Thus the rest of Turned was easily eaten up. The regions were unevenly divided up, afterwards. Chekiang only got Tsainan and Kiangsau.

THE KWON OF TUMED

After rebuilding the wall segments in Yun facing Ordos and Chahar and in Shansi facing the Ordos, the Turned got invaded by its neighbors and was removed from play.

Chilhi and Yen are uncontrolled.

THE ORLOT KHANATE*Chinke, Khan of the Oriot*

DIPLOMACY: Kansu(f), Tsingfeng(a)

The Oriot forced into paying tribute: Houma, Honan, Shentung, Shansi, Yun and Hopei. Bao Ding was pacified.

The Pacific Rim

Merces: 10mhi, 10mi, 10mg

THE AMAGO SHOGUNATE*Tenno Ittonaga, 79th Emperor of Nihon, Child of Amaterasu**Amago Michigiku, Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan*

DIPLOMACY: Koguryo(f)

There were some new faces ruling Japan.

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM*Gleam of the Sun, Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

DIPLOMACY: Bora Bora(ea)

The phantom navy of the Storm reappeared.

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM*Rangora, Sorcerer-King of the Aketta*

DIPLOMACY: none

The long reign of Keti II ended in 1260. His successor, Rangora is a great grandson.

The NEW WORLD**The Grand Massif**

Merces: 10mi

MERCAIN

Ian

DIPLOMACY: Iroquois(f), Caranook(ea)

Algonkin, Iroquois and Malecite turned cultivated.
