Announcements

The 5th Edition Rulebook: In a short white, the 5th Edition Rulebook will be published and I will switch to the rules contained therein. As of now virtually all the rules in effect in Lords 10 will be left intact with some important changes:

- 1) The Return of the Old Ship Units. All merchant units (m) will be phased out of this game by turn 40 and be replaced with 2 transports (t). Each transport costs exactly 1/2 GP & 1/2 NFP of a merchant to build and carries 2 CARGO or MSP. Warships (w) will replace galleys (g) at a rate of 2 warships for each galley. Each warship can carry 1 CARGO or 1 MSP. Tairidas (t) will become your choice of either 3 transports or 3 warships. All Dromonds (d) shall become 6 warships. This is mostly a cosmetic change.
- 2) Restrictions on the Elevation of Princes. Effective turn 40, you can only elevate non-heir royal children, allies or lieutenants to become princes (p) ONLY if you have 2 BL. Indeed, for each 2 BL you have, you can elevate and maintain 1 Prince. The total number of Princes you have is, therefore, equal to your Homeland Build Zone (HBZ). Princes specifically designated to be the direct successor to the king, heirs (h), are exempt from this rule. Like before, once the heir comes of age he will become a leader. As an issue related to this, there will be no more Leader Limit.
- 3) Intel AR and Religion AR Limit. 5 levels is the limit as to how high your Intel AR and Religion AR can go up to.
- 4) c2 Megaliths. Intense Cultivation will be restricted to a narrow group of already intensely cultivated regions.
- 5) Public Works Support. Nations will a high amount of public works bonus will require upkeep on these at roughly 1 GP per 20 PWB. Most nations will have a negligible support cost. This will be added to your project support.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavairy and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning many ramparts, towers, & walls. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

AFRICA

Africa Bowi: lest Earth-Pigs Born 28, Aethiopian Aelite 24.

West Africa Mercs: 10mc, 10mi

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Numga Omar, Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: Nupe(hs), Khalem(nt), Boure(c)

The regent, Khash, traveled to Nupe and picked up the army that was encamped there. Khash gave Nupe to Visashti as a feudal fief and then took all 59,000 men and attacked and militarily converted Gwari. Visashti had no troops with which to enforce his will and was killed in a heathen insurrection. Nupe reverted wholly back to Afro-Pagan. The debacle in Nupe prevented a trade road from opening with Congo. Trade with Andalusia was reopened with a trade fleet going to Dokhla.

The suprecoacy of Togo

Fork

DIPLOMACY: Oyo(ea)

Togo remained at peace for the past five years. The Death of Hibbe at the end of the turn wasn't good for Togo. There was little respect for Fork, the new Lord of the Many Trees. Asante and Burkina revolted. Ribbe was murdered in Borogou by loyalists. Prince Guva remained true. The Oyo Lord died but his land remained under Togo's care. For some reason the Togo are stronger from this bad experience.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Baco King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: none

Isolated by sea and from sea, the jungle region of Salonga revolted.

East Africa Merca: 10mi, 5mg

THE GREAT ZICOBABLUE

Five Twin Jackal, Zimbabwe King

DIPLOMACY: none

Five Twin elevated tow of his descendants to Princely status and set them off to explore the shoreline of the sea. The Immortal also formed a bodyguard unit, out of the most kosher cooks of all Zimbabwe. An army enslaved all of Matabele. Zambia was colonized by Jewish to (1/5).

THE SAKALAVANS

Shumway Nogapunda, Little Caesar of Madagascar, The Great Slobbering Taz DIPLOMACY. Melela(c), Tongaa(c)

The Sakalava dug in and prepared to withstand the Basoko in their newly fortified cities of Mopizza and Pundaport. By September of 1278, 16,500 Basoko and mercenary infantry showed up and proceeded to assault Mopizza. Shumway with 8500 infantry and 500 rampart sentries stood their ground showering the enemy with arrows and spears. Nearly all of the attackers were killed. Shumway lost 3500 men but saved the capital from imminent danger.

Up at Pundaport, Burrp was unable to get any condottieri, having been outbid by the Basoko. Some deserters from the Basoko army joined him. These were lost to an Ethiopian raid from the sea which captured Pundaport and drove Burrp underground. The Ethiopians left no garrison in the city probably expecting Basoko troops to show up as they departed further south. Burrp snuck back in and reclaimed Pundaport for the Great Slobbering Taz.

That irksome Ethiopian fleet the following year sacked and burned Mahapizza and captured a merchant fleet before going to their ant intested home. Refugees from the sacked cities gathered about the Nogapunda in Mopizza demanding vengeance against this foreign aggression. Shurnway frowned, the Ethiopians are sticking their nose in the fray just as the Elasciko had been rendered impotent.

The BASOKO

Jobuti

DIPLOMACY: none

Zamoku who had conquered so much was killed early in 1276 by Sakalava crazy bread rollers. The Basoko grieved for one full year and then elected a minor captain, Jobuti, to lead them. In the meantime, 4000 of the 15,500 Basoko warriors deserted to join the Sakalava in Mogadishu (They would get theirs later at the hands of the Ethiopians). The new chief marched the Basoko south, picking up 5000 mercenaries from Mombassa. He had plans to topple the crusted capital of the Sakalava Imperium, Mopizza.

Jobuti was nowhere the great general Zamoku was and failed to conquer Mozambi for the enemy had hidden in a fortified position. In the vain attempt to assault Mopizza, all 11,500 Basoko perished and only 4000 mercenaries and Jobuti survived. This disaster did much to unravel Zamoku's patchwork grip on East Africa. Lamu, Luba, Brava, Kilwa and Mombassa revolted. Jobuti returned to Ruvama and sacked and burned the captured city of Makdadd, more out of spite than for any advantage. The merchant fleets stationed there fled the burning port and rejoined Sakalava in Mopizza. Jobuti finds himself king of mostly unarmed settlers and three pacified regions: Ankolye, Nyasa and Ruvama. If it wasn't for his Coptic friends from the north, the Basoko cause would have been dashed.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Memol, King of Aethiopia

DIPLOMACY: Aden(f)

"The King of Ethiopia performed the solemn rites of Obligation fulfilled at the sending of Lord Maglor against the Sakalavans. We will maintain, in this instance, our pre-eminence over the lands of Lungwebungu. They are ours to dispose and we favor the valiant Basoko!"

Mernol sent armies into Galla and Ilubabor, conquered these and converted by torce to Coptic Christian. A new city in Makurra along the Nile's banks near Soba was built. The name of this settlement is Omdurman.

To enforce the Lungwebungu policy, Lord Maglor with 150 galleys, 5000 mercenary infantry and 100 siege destroyed the defenders of Pundaport. After waiting a few months, they left a detachment of mercenaries behind to go off to sack Sakalava's historic capital, Mahapizza. Maglor returned home, laden with booty, though he thought he had sent Sakalava spiraling into the abyss.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Morce: 10mhc, 10mhi, 10mi

The black tower equivate of lest

Asioria, Leader of the Black Tower

DIPLOMACY: none

Astoria stripped Suentius Po IV of his inheritance for no good reason. He was given feudal control of Sinai, small consolation for losing an empire. The elevation of "Cerebus" (who looks like Chico Marx), Po's younger brother, in his stead caused much murmuring and disbelief, especially amongst the Anarcho-Romantics. Trade by ocean was started with the Chalukya Mandalam.

The norman kingdom of saxonia

Leonard, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois DIPLOMACY: Lienster(nt)

In a triumph of kings over priests, The Saxon crown participated in the overthrown of the Urbanian Papacy. The monasteries in Maine were systematically destroyed. The eastern Mediterranean outpost, New South Wales, revolted due to its great distance. Trade was interrupted with Islam.

The almoravid emirate of andalusia

Abd ar Rahman, Emir as Sevilla

DIPLOMACY: none

The Almoravid search for traces of the 'FFF' in Valencia and Malta. In Malta, Al Qadir found a suspicious lodge and closed it up. A black Jew laden with gold showed up in Abd's palace. He brought gifts and novelties from a distant land called As Simbal.

Italy

Mercs: 10mhi, 10mi, 5mg

the kingdow of Liguria

Nero, King of Liguria DIPLOMACY: not at all

Nero cleared his court of the shiftless children underfoot by committing the lot of them in monasteries and nunneries. He then commissioned Bruno and Leo

to scour the countryside for 'FFF' lodges. 20,000 cavalry and 10,000 infantry journeyed to Provence, Lyonnais, Switzerland and stormed all suspected installations. Local authorities resented their presence but were unable to stop this intrusion. The Lepontine rulers degraded to non-paying tribute after the army got in a tangle with the local militia.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Harmony I, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God. Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church DIPLOMACY: none

The Papacy of Urban IV was reviled all throughout Europe. The pontiff had not spent much time in Rome and preferred to hold court in Prague. He was held in suspicion by the Saxon king, the Bakonites and virtually every crown in Europe. It was common knowledge that the Urbanian Pontiff had subverted the Saxon military and kept this compromise to blackmail King Leonard. It was suspected that the Urbanian Church was behind this 'FFF Octopus' thing too. In separate announcements, King Leonard of Saxonia, Alek III of Thaery, Queen Fuwinna of Francia, Satanos of Bakon, Ivano of Belarus and even Eisen III of Warsaw denounced Urban III and did their best to withhold the tithe.

Soon the Pope's intel was under assault from many nations including the Moorish lestians. Several Guard Units (The Aardvark Legion, the Knights of Pendragon, the Rabat Defenders, the Legion of Dynamic Diskord and the Hammer of Tor) converged upon Rome to wipe out the Legion of Dooin. For centuries onward this event would be known to a certain segment of the population as Guardcon I. What a party it was. The elite units demolished three back alleys in Rome's Greek Quarter as they searched for the Doom Legion. Finally, the Knights of Pendragon were ambushed and completely slaughtered in a pot factory. The other elite units chased the Doomers into an abandoned mill which was set aflame. The Legion of Doom had given the others the stip but had suffered heavy losses. The Legion of Dynamic Diskord discovered the ruse and tracked the quarry in the sewers below. The Aardvark Legion immersed themselves with water and entered the underground; the putrid stench permeated every nook of the subterranean city and forced every creature to the surface, even the rats. The Legion of Doom ascended into the Senate Hall building where the Hammer of Tor caught them. The surviving Doom Legionnaires were wiped out by the other elite units and their banner was shipped to London as a consolation for the loss of the Knights. The multinational Guard Units clubbed each other with wands in self-congratulatory festivity and then went home, leaving Rome an utter mess.

Rome was so shaken up that when the Spoleti showed up to assault, the defense was listless and stiff. The 17,000 cavalry, 27,500 infantry and 55 siege led by Captain Niccolo Galeazzano. Rome fell in a day. The College of Cardinals were rustled to the Vatican and were told to elect a new Pope of Ottone the Fair's liking. This was done the following day when a bishop of Pescara was elevated to become Pope Harmony I. The new Holy See quickly consolidated what little Papal government was left.

Any possibility for schism was eliminated when Urban IV and his army were defeated in the streets of Prague by a thankless Warsaw army. Urban was convicted by the Polish rabble for 'demon worship' and was burned before the jeering crowd.

During all this chaos, many monasteries disappeared, were looted or dismantled. These included the ones in Asturias, Poitou, Lorraine, Carinthia, Bavaria, Maine, Vermandois, Anglia, Meissen, Norway, Burgundy, Bohemia, Nordgau and lie de France. Others (like in Bakony) were nationalized or held in escrow.

The principality of spoleto

Ottone, Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith

DIPLOMACY: Sabini(a), Pisa(a)

Ottone played a key role in the fall of the Urbanian Papacy. But he had a different agenda. From most kings who sought the Papacy's destruction. He wanted to save the Papacy and the only way to do this was to take Rome itself and install a Pope consistent with the desires of the Spoleto crown.

So Captain Galeazzano marched to Latium, wiped out the pro-Urbanian forces, reduced Rome's walls and elevated Harmony I. With this done, the army retired to Sabini.

In Late 1280, Captain Galeazzano died of apoplexy. he was honored with a gala state funeral which all of Pescara had to attend.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Dominic II, Despot of Taranto

DIPLOMACY: none

Dominic I died this turn. That's why there's a Dominic II.

Eastern Europe

Mercs: 20mc, 10mi

the nordik kingdom of thatery

Alek III, King of the Danes DIPLOMACY: Halland(t)

A Theery navy landed some marines on the Orkneys and converted the ignorant savages there to Christianity. Roll was wounded doing this and had to stay on these miserable islands to recuperate.

THE KINGOOD OF FRANCIA

Horace, Panarch of Francia

DIPLOMACY: none

Queen Fuwinna died in 1280 allowing for Prince Horace a son of Casimir to become the King of the Franks. A Francian navy blockaded Latium until the Spoleti installed a new Pope.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Eisen II, Grand Prince of Warsaw

DIPLOMACY: none

For the control of Bohemia, 400,000 marks were sent by Pope Urban IV to the Grand Prince. But Eisen II had found evidence that Urban IV had engaged in dealings with the Devil. Therefore Eisen declared the land transfer void and then marched General Hergrom to Prague to make sure of it.

"This man in the midst of our nation", spoke the Grand Prince of Warsaw, "beyond its protective shell, deep within the soft heart, cannot be His representative on Earth. It is our mission to find the true Pope. The false Pope must answer for his infiltration and underhandedness.

Hergrom led 15,000 infantry and 15,000 cavalry. The Pope had 16,500 infantry with him. Urban IV was outnumbered and lost. Il Papa was caught and was tried for 'devil deals'. Bishop John was arrested in Warsaw and was thrown in the dungeon. The monasteries were left untouched and fell under the jurisdiction of the new Papacy that has risen in Rome.

Old Michurin was given Masuria as a feudal fief for his good service. The region of Kiev was transferred to Bakony.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

Satanos, King of the Bakons

DIPLOMACY: Özu(hs)

The Bakonai seized control the Papal monasteries found in Illyria, Croatia, Banat, Alfold, Carpathia and Slovakia. Satanos called on other European leaders to do something about the Pope. And they did. Kiev was gift-wrapped by Warsaw and was given to Satanos.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Ivano the Washed, Prince of Novgorod DIPLOMACY: Polotsk(f), Starodub(ea)

The Novgorod King who recently converted to Catholicism, joined the other kings in tossing out Pope Urban IV. Riga was expanded to 2 GPv.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Hari, Emir of Great Bolgar DIPLOMACY: Suzdal(t)

The Bolgar stayed in their places and looked at the clouds.

ASIA

The Middle East

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms, 5mg

The nakephorian empire of byzantion

Nicephorus VIII, Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople DIPLOMACY: Kyklades(a)

The Empire built a fortress in Phrygia and port citadels in Bosnia and Crete. The Crete facility faces the Ionian Sea. The Bosnia citadel was surrounded by a city Belgrad populated by refugees from Georgia which was invaded by the Parthians in 1277. The Parthians must have realized the error of their ways incurring the wrath of the Empire and all. They shipped 140,000 bezants and hoped the Empire would not counter-attack.

Nicephorus VIII was busy ruling. He guessed right that an 'FFF' lodge was in Epirus and this was sacked by a force of 22,000 infantry. Nicepolis expanded to 5 GPv.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

Jurji al Adid, Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful

DIPLOMACY: Karbala(nt), Edessa(f), Pontus(c)

The Baghdad Caliphate expanded Tabriz and rebuilt Sarid. Trade was expanded with Francia and Liguria to make up for the lost trade with Saxonia.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces, Shah of Parthia, Emil of Meril, Archon of Bactria

DIPLOMACY: Zagros(fa)

In Khokhand, construction began for a great wall that would protect the dominion from horde invasions. The first link was built atop the mountain range that separated Frunze from Khokhand. Minister Krawdon with 3000 heavy infantry, 6500 light troops and some colonists walted at the Georgians border to give the Byzantines just enough time to evacuate. The inhabitants of Timova were impressed by the danger and left, boarding Byzantine ships that were on hand. The stubborn Georgians swore to stay and fight for their homes and beliefs. Krawdon ignored all this until after the Sunni Muslims settlers built a new Timova on the ruins of the old. Realizing that he did not have the manpower to sufficiently garrison Georgia and thus endanger the new city, he militarily converted Georgia and thus was able to pacify the countryside.

Overseas trade was revived with Chalukya.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Roland, Sultan of Afghans

DIPLOMACY: Yarkhand(c)

Baluchistan was the site of Ghor's newest city. Astoria. As Roland came of age, the regency of Reisha came to an end.

India

Mercs: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE GOLDEN HORDE OF THE ARAIK KHAN

Ashkiel, Khan of Khans, Arbiter of Destiny

DIPLOMACY: Kamarupa(ea to Rastrakuta), Maghada(ea)

The Golden Khan got in a little bit of diplomacy contest with the Ragrakuta for the Buddhist regions of the Bengal East.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Pulakesin III The Victorious, The Great Muta, King of the South DIPLOMACY: Andhra(fa), Malabar(a), Surashtra(c), Kakatiya(a), Chela(ea)

Pulakesin basked in the glory of his reign and wrote a book of memoirs for future kings to read. He was visited by a Zimbabwe envoy named Lion Loan who was on a quest to explore the entire world.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Chanda, Emperor of Manyakheta

DIPLOMACY: no effect

The sacked city of Tamralipti was rebuilt to 1 GPv. King Chanda and his procession visited the Araik Khan in Jaunpur giving gifts of tiger pets and perfume

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Opihou, 3rd Dalai Lama DIPLOMACY: Omchu(ea)

Opihou opened an eye and then another. Then all at once seven Lamaist monasteries were built. They are in Bhutan, Gtsang, Sikkim and Tungchuan. The Panchen Lama quit his job to become a consultant in China. Tungchuan rebelled along with him.

South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 5mg

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Monson III, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

DIPLOMACY: Lampang(aw)

The intrigues of Pagan in Lampang backfired. The Lampang have declared

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Codimsutra, King of the Spice Islands

DIPLOMACY: Atjeh(nt)

Eelimsutra died in 1280 and Codimsutra was stuck in Atjeh. There were summons sent to get him back home before any trouble erupted.

China

Mercs: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 5meg

THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Gongse, Wang Dai Viet

DIPLOMACY: none

The road along the coast was extended from Vijaya to Phi-Tho in Cochin. The final stages of the road at Hue was completed. Taiwan turned cultivated.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKLANG

Quan Ciwou, Celestial King of Chekiang DIPLOMACY: Kiangsu(t), Mindanao(hs)

Ever suspicious, Quan Tsanda, had his agents murder Difong of Szechwan. The Szechwan Duke's retainers were shocked. Difong was publicly and privately the most pro-Chekiang leader the Emperor ever had. Embittered by this treachery, Szechwan revolted outright and would not listen to any of the Emperor's apologies. The magistrate Quai Chung was embarrassed; he could not find anyone in Szechwan's court who disliked Difong nor anyone credible to support the idea that Difong had planned to overthrow the empire. Somebody in the secret service had screwed up big.

A miasma of suspicion and paranoia existed in the court of the Dragon King when Quan Tsanda died. It marred Ciwou's enthronement but not to a great degree. None of Chekiang's important lords rebelled. And although there were some regional riots, only Kwangte actually disavowed their alliance with Chekiang.

In other news, an Imperial Road was built from Linan to Yixing in Liangche.

THE ORIOT KHANATE

Han To, Khan of the Oriot

DIPLOMACY: Chilhi(ea), Shensi(f)

In Chilhi, Choulu was built with a harbor towards the Bo Hai. This somewhat helped the diplomacy there.

THE BULIBAJAH

Patramii

DIPLOMACY: none

Staying put and not moving. Subsidized by Amago.

The Pacific Rim

Merce: 10mhi, 10mi, 10mg

THE AMAGO SHOGUNATE

Tenno Ittonaga, 79th Emperor of Nihon, Child of Amaterasu Amago Michigiku, Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan DIPLOMACY: Silla(f)

Suo in Yamaguchi grew to size 4 GPv.

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM

Singing Cove, Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom

DIPLOMACY: none

The Sand Tosser and all his ships and men attacked and wiped out the disloyal Boralanders. Bora Bora and Tekutea were enslaved and Tahiti was evacuated. The Tahitians were resettled in Tellika A Maul restoring the region to (2/6) like it was during the Maori days.

BORALAND

This turn's obligatory scratched out, dead country.

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Rangora, Sorcerer-King of the Aketta

DIPLOMACY: Yaraka(c)

Rangora's servants Tasus toured all the regions but was ineffective because he did not focus on one particular region.

The NEW WORLD

The Grand Massif

Mercs: 10mi

MERCAIN

Angus

DIPLOMACY: Poctumtuc(nt), Wyandot(f)

Angus made his brother Malcolm the heir over his own son Donalbain. Donalbain wonders why he has been robbed of his rightful heritage. Chief Wyandot married a daughter of Angus, Elizabeth. Mercain is now covered in two miles of sheet ice. The villagers are complaining that the sun is out too often.

THE CHOWAN CONFEDERACY

Massapagua, Chief of Chowan DIPLOMACY: Chowan(ea) Chowan is open for a player.

THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Blackcat

DIPLOMACY: none

The Hopewell skipped a turn.

WYOMING

Wet Leaf

DIPLOMACY: Chippewa(f), Illinois(fa)

Wet Leaf personally oversaw the incorporation of Chippewa into the growing nation

ATAKAPA

Singatora

DIPLOMACY: Chatot(a)
