#### THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Numga Omar, *Emir of the Fulani*

DIPLOMACY: Nupe(nt), Segu(nt)

The regent returned the 55,000 infantry home, passing by Nupe who bowed low before them promising not to revolt again. In 1284, Numga Omar came of age and he shoved the regent off the throne. The regent was a good humored old man anyway and dusted himself off, smiled and became a consultant for merchant clans who are trying to circumvent the foreign vendor fee and other tariffs. Overland trade was revived with Ba Congo.

#### THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Fork, *The Great Twinkie of Togo*

DIPLOMACY: Asante(1a), Oyo(a), Burkina(nt), Borogou(ea), Senufu(nt)

The Great Twinkie (as the Fork man likes to style himself) got himself a plump, delicious wife with a creamy center (Nutty Hoho) in Asante much to the pleasure of the Lion Chief of the Ashanti. Fork made contacts with other outlying interior tribes who had previous relationships with the Supremacy. Nutty Hoho turned out to be a very fertile wife and bore the Great Twinkie many little cupcakes.

#### THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Mbala, *King of Ba-Congo*

DIPLOMACY: Igbo(f), Teke(f), Omote(f)

Those wild and crazy cities, Luanda and Boma, each grew to 3 GPV. And a new addition to the east of urbanosity, Bight City in Benin, was built to offer safe portage for ships in the Bight of Benin. The princesses Nyati and Nyati were offered in marriage to the most eligible bachelors of Igbo and Teke in exchange for service in the name of the Mwani.

### East Africa

#### THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, *Zimbabwe King*

DIPLOMACY: none

Matabele was colonized to 1 GPV by a bunch of Jews. Lesser Zimbabwe expanded to 5 GPV. The army of Zimbabwe, 43,000 men strong, enslaved the gentile populace of Mapungubwe. Five Twin Jackal (who is still not dead) wondered if his neighbors will ever stop fighting.

#### THE SAKALAVANS

Gordon Nogapunda, *Little Caesar of Madagascar, The Great Slobbering Taz*

DIPLOMACY: none

Shumway and his miniature army liberated Ruvama and Nyasa from Basoko garrisons. He returned home to find that 5500 taco-loving Ethiopian marines had arrived, captured and sacked Mopizza and were attempting to enslave the refugees from said ex-city. Shumway's 7000 man force attacked if only to save his people and scored a victory at the loss of his life. The Ethiopians retreated but had stolen all the merchant ships. These vile slime globs struck once more up at Pundaport, where Burrp was stationed. Pundaport's walls were not great enough to inspire songs of praise, much less withstand the sea invader's assault. Burrp made good another escape to Zanzibar.

There was much confusion when Shumway died. He had left no children, at least, none that can be properly verified. A brother, Gordon, quickly grabbed the Scepter of Pizza Dough and waved it about demanding respect. Not everyone did. Luangua, Melela and Tongaa rebelled. Gordon found that with the sack of the capital, Sakalava is no longer able to effectively govern all of its far-flung regions.

#### THE BASOKO

Jobuti

DIPLOMACY: Kilwa(nt), Brava(nt), Mogadishu(f)

With Ethiopian navies out defanging Sakalava resistance, the Basoko Kingdom was able to get some stuff done. Jobuti got a new lease on life when an assassination attempt failed. With 5000 mercenaries and some tribe points, the Basoko occupied Mogadishu and nung out making sniper shots at UN soldiers. The Ethiopians took Pundaport and gave this city plus all the booty from the sack of Mopizza to Jobuti and his rag-tag team. A tribe point was settled in Mogadishu to ensure Basoko's occupation of the area. Sadly, the new masters of Pundaport could not feed their city, a famine reduced Pundaport's population.

#### THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Mernol, *King of Aethiopia*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

In pacified Ilubabor, Umgawa was founded. It has a port on the White Nile. Both Luxor and Massawa expanded to greater street congestion. A new fleet using ships captured from the southern raids opened a trade route with the Arak Khanate.

Maglor returned to the Sakalava Theater to sack Mopizza, capture its merchant fleet, take and give away Pundaport, take more merchant fleets and generally be a war hero. He returned home to cheering crowds and offerings of fresh fruit and wine.

## EUROPE

### Western Europe

#### THE BLACK TOWER EMIRATE OF IEST

Astoria, *Leader of the Black Tower*

DIPLOMACY: Al Hauts(fa)

"We the Rulers of Saxonia and Iest, will not countenance any war in the Mediterranean basin and the surrounding areas, and will act with all our might to stop any war."

Along Lybia's coast was formed Tripoli (faces the Sea of Lybia, pronounced Tree-POLE-Lee). In Siracusa (pronounced SARE-eh-Bus), a merchant fleet was assembled to start overseas trade with Warsaw. The forces left in Platana were returned home in a series of ship shuttles. There were reports of flying pigs in Iest and all believed the Mahdi had come to save them all from the excesses of the Pumpkin King.

#### THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Leonard, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: Ulster(c), Connaught(nt)

The Saxons built up their economy by expanding their city public works in Cherbourg, Sete and new found Helston. The fleet of trading ships were grown corresponding directly with the lack of trees in Mercia. In giving up Galacia and the city of Vigo to the Thaery guys, the Saxons gained Cornwall and Helston. The Emerald Island continued to be brought into the Saxon order via local diplomacy. A secret FFF hideout was busted and condemned in Ile de France.

A stranger from Arab lands showed up in London. He asked to see the king but was kicked out of the town because he went barefoot.

#### THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Abd ar Rahman, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: Kazmedina(ea)

Sagunto expanded to 7 GPv.

### Italy

**Mercs:** 10mhi, 10mi, 5mg

#### THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Nero, *King of Liguria*

DIPLOMACY: none

With Spoleti help, the lodges in Orcia and Sabini were expunged. The Papacy allowed for Liguria's crackdown of the FFF hive near Rome itself. It was a level-15 fortress that had been kept a secret even from the farmers that plowed in its shadow. This proved to be a tough nut to crack for the 5000 heavies, 10,000 archers and 200 catapults of Marshall Silvani Baldarosa and Duke Antonio. More hardware and men have been requested for this operation.

#### THE F. F. F.

Ditter

DIPLOMACY: none

The storm of the Latium secret fortress thrust the mysterious three-of club into the headlines. Interrogations of captured lodge members reveal their leader's name is Ditter.

#### THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Harmony I, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*

DIPLOMACY: none

"The restriction on usury is harmful to struggling Christians everywhere. It is hereby struck down. It is the solemn duty of the Church to help educate the Christian populace. Therefore, the Church will soon announce the details of an Educational Fund-Matching programme."

Pope Harmony I adjusted the anti-usury stance to allow for some banking in the cities and towns. There was a flush of embarrassment in Rome when a hidden fortress was discovered to be within sight of Rome's northwest ramparts.

The Zealand monasteries were lost control of.

#### THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Angelo, *Prince of Spoieto, Defender of the Faith*

DIPLOMACY: Maremma(nt), Chiana(fa)

With the help of a Ligurian army (10,000 knights, 10,000 light cav, 10,000 sword-men and 10,000 pole-arms), two FFF lodges were rooted out of the countryside. These caught were publicly tried for treason. Many of these claimed to be a sheepherding guild. It didn't wash.

Aquila expanded 1 GPv. Prince Ottone died in 1285.

#### THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Dominic II, *Despot of Taranto*

DIPLOMACY: none

There was little news of note from the Exarchate.

### Eastern Europe

**Mercs:** 20mc, 10mi

#### THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Alek III, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: Halland(ea)

The land transfer with Saxonia pulled off without a hitch. Well, maybe one. The port city of Vigo is too far away to be interrogated into the Tharian trade network and thus was isolated. This has interrupted trade with Almoravid.

In Agder, the Danish built the new port city of Kristiansand bordering the Viking Bank.

#### THE KINGDOM OF FRANCA

Horace, *Panarch of Francia*

DIPLOMACY: Corsica(ea)

As Meissen turned cultivated, Hamelin expanded to 2 GPv. Leander, too expanded. 'Bazemant' was the name of the new burg built along the Rhine in Alsace. In Giulia, the fortress Isedel was christened.

#### THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Eisen II, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: Zaporozhie(nt)

Count Hergrom went to the Muslim nomad land of Zaporozhie and built a city for them. Opol, facing the Western Black Sea. With the sizable bribe given to the Jahid hedge khan, permission was given to use the new city as a trade center between Warsaw and the Mediterranean world.

#### THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

Satanos, *King of the Bakons*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

With this new port city in the Russian River system, new ships were built to expand trade. New routes were opened with Parthia, Novgorod, Thaery and Islam. Existing routes were expanded by sea.

#### THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Boris, *Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: none

Eight-Five year old Ivano abdicated in favor of his grandson, Boris Vaslich. Old Ivano lived on until he was 105 but he never involved himself in politics again. And he refused to give advice.

Both Igor and Sergei died this turn before anything could be done about Seversk. Riga expanded to 3 GPv.

#### THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Hari, *Emir of Great Bolgar*

DIPLOMACY: Urkel(t), Suzdal(fa), Murom(ea)

A port city called Keeper was built in Urkel, another Asia-Pagan controlled land. Urkel was happy to pay tribute to the Sultan for it.

## ASIA

### The Middle East

**Mercs:** 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms, 5mg

#### THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus VIII, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*

DIPLOMACY: Paphlagonia(ea), Kyklades(f)

Trade was started with the Ghor using their new port facility in Gheba! Gherib. In order to do this, merchant fleet were pulled from trade with Italy. Of these, trade was lost with Spoieto. Two regions went and turned cultivated on us, this turn. These are Dobruja and Ludgorie.

#### THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

Hamoud Ad Dahabi, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

DIPLOMACY: Charsionon(nt), Pontus(ea), Edessa(fa), Karbala(t)

The Caliph found trade impossible with Saxonia, Warsaw and Thaery. He died at the end of this turn. His son became known as 'Ad Dahabi', the Golden Caliph.

Sarid and Acre towns expanded to 2 GPv each. A Caliph's Road was slammed down, going from Raqqah to Sarid. This was the first link of the trade road to the Pontus port, which is now already handling commerce with Bakony.

## THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*

DIPLOMACY: Karatou(t), Shirvan(ea), Arran(f), Khokhand(a), Zagros(f), Yezd(fa)

Four cities expanded: Bukhara in Bactria, Khiva in Khwarzmir, Rayy in Kumis and Samarkhand in Soghdia.

## THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Roland, *Sultan of Afghans*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

Roland wanted a woman from Kashgar but due to distance, it revolted. This drove Roland's matchmaker to Kashmir, where the women are bustier. The Sultan settled for a nice local girl instead.

## India

## THE GOLDEN HORDE OF THE ARAIK KHAN

Ashkiel, *Khan of Khans, Arbiter of Destiny*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Golden Khanate continued to enjoy the indolence of the sedentary life.

## THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dantidurga, *The Great Muta*

DIPLOMACY: Pawar(f), Satava(c), Jihjhoti(fa), Andhra(a), Malabar(f), Surashtra(t), Kakatiya(f), Chela(a), Dahala(fa), Karnata(c)

After 88 years of life, 70 years as the Great Muta, becoming the Victorious for saving the Mandalam from the horde threat, Pulakesin III died in his sleeping chamber of influenza. So long did the Victorious rule that a great grandson, Dantidurga, became the new Lord of the Chalukya. So great was the influence of Pulakesin that his spirit wrought fear into would-be mutineers and rebels. It takes time to reincarnate into a slime moss.

## THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Chanda, *Emperor of Manyakheta*

DIPLOMACY: Maghada(t to AraiK), Kamarupa(fa)

Chanda returned out of the tiger's maw into the relative safety of Kamarupa. Konorak expanded to 2 GPv.

## THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Opihou, *3rd Dalai Lama*

DIPLOMACY: none

Opihou counted the beads of his wooden necklace many, many times.

## South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 5mg

## THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Namrangsam, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*

DIPLOMACY: none

From the Howdah of the Subline White Elephant, Monson III declared war right back upon the bad attitude Lampangers. His great-grandson Namrangsam with 3000 armored soldiers and 46,000 non-armored soldiers marched right on Lampang. The Lampang army made a raiding toray into Kayah but had to cut this short to defend themselves. They were squashed like bugs and the region now has to pay a pacified form of tribute to Pagan. Monson III died in 1285 and like his peer Pulakesin of Chalukya ruled a long time - 65 years in total - and lived to be ninety. His great achievement was the conquest of Cambodia.

## THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Codimsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*

DIPLOMACY: Atjeh(f)

On the very tip of Atjeh, facing the Nicobar Sea, Aceh was built. This city plus all the Java leaders, the hand of Gullitantra and some arm wringing and beer brought Atjeh into full Aquarium control. Being at the edge of the realm wasn't good for control. Nothing revolted though.

## China

## THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Gongse, *Wang Dai Viet*

DIPLOMACY: Hmong(fa)

Some gold was shipped to Thanglong from the Chekiang Dragon but it wasn't enough to surrender control of Taiwan to them. Pang Gongse expanded his merchant fleet base.

## THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Ciwou, *Celestial King of Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: Szechwan(ea)

The Dragon tried desperately to cover up their mistake made in Szechwan. Many were killed both in the Kweidu and the Linan palaces. The tireless efforts of Quai Chung brought the troubled region back into the Empire's tax roster. Taiwan, however, remained in Viet's hands. Apparently Pang Gongse wanted more than what the Hidden Dragon was willing to send. The regional minister of Hong Kong therefore held onto the Zhaoti fleet. Tsainan, on the other hand, was gladly sold to the Oriot for less.

From Liangche, the Imperial Road crossed the Yangtze to Hupei's Chiangling. A traveler from a distant land showed up in Linan to pay homage to the Hidden Dragon. He brought gifts of ivory and resin.

## THE ORIOT KHANATE

Han To, *Khan of the Oriot*

DIPLOMACY: Bao Ding(c), Liaotung(c), Chilhi(fa), Shangtung(nt), Ordos(n), Wu-Hai(nt), Yen(t), Tsainan(nt), Houma(fa)

In exchange for the rights to Tsainan, the Oriot promised military assistance if Chekiang is in need of this and sent 20,000 silver taels. Tsainan felt left out of the whole deal and rebelled from both Oriot and Chekiang. It took all the charm of the Khanate's best diplomat, Tsetuo, to get at least some recognition of the new arrangement.

## THE POPOCELOTL KINGDOM

Lecuti II

DIPLOMACY: none

Popocelotl got a new ruler. The old Lecuti died.

## OAXACA

Nauhyotzin who thinks he's all hot now

DIPLOMACY: none

The Oaxacans struck back against the source of the cowardly Tzentel attack. Two armies marched on Maya. 20,000 soldiers led by Nauhyotzin attacked and pacified Quiche and its city Tuluum. Yucatec fell next to the Antiered King and Uxmal too. Meanwhile war minister Thirteen Herb with 12,000 regular and 7500 mercenaries tangoed with Ohet Xan's 23,000 men in Popoluca. The enemies numbers clearly gained an edge on the Herbster and the Oaxacan force was badly mauled. He withdrew from battle with only 2500 merces left.

Nauhyotzin was not bothered by this development and marched into Maya with 14,000 men. The Tzentel crown prince Lo Lax Kan was there with 3000 men. He and all his defenders were killed in battle, Uucil Abnal fell and Maya was conquered. The treasury of 26,600 jade chips were captured and many Tzentel dudes were sacrificed wholesale to the war god. Uucil Abnal was put to the sack as an object lesson to those who would wage war without provocation against a peaceful neighbor who had a big army.

The loot captured this turn went to paying back with interest the overtaxed citizens of Oaxaca who had to pay extra jade chips to subsidize the war cause.

Gasco

DIPLOMACY: none

Kepour II found a princess for his son Kepour III but then an epidemic swept through Tiwanaku and both king and prince died from it. Kepour III did sire a son, Gasco, who was crowned Emperor despite the babe not understanding what's going on. Fortunately the Imperial house staff is keeping things in order.

## MAPUCHE
