Jungle Regions: This is another rule I have noticed in the new rulebook. Jungle regions cannot turn cultivated until the Industrial era. Any jungle region that is slated to turn cultivated in a future turn will continue to do so but any future efforts to tame the wild forests will be in vain.

To make up for this and because of the economic potential of the rain forests, you can build 10 PWB per GPV of a jungle region.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning many ramparts, towers, & walls. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Numga Omar, *Emir of the Fulani*

DIPLOMACY: Senegal(nt)

The Fulani were spooked by the recent famine but they had the wheat reserves to cover the shortfall and prevent food riots.

Numga Omar with his 55,000 infantry pounded into submission Niani and attacked Boure and militarily converted them. In the meantime, an insufficient garrison was left in Niani. It revolted. Numga didn't want to be isolated in Boure so he attacked Niani once more. After the a successful operation, the Fulani Emir posted the right amount of men to guard the worthless infidels.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Fork, *The Great Twinkie of Togo*

DIPLOMACY: Zerma(c), Niete(nt), Senufu(ea), Borogou(a), Burkina(t), Asante(a) Leopards in Yoruba increased its gold value to three.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

M'bala, *King of Ba-Congo*

DIPLOMACY: Douala(fa), N'gao(a)

Negotiations with the N'gao and Douala were successful. King M'bala, lacking a son, named his older sister, Toba, as a heir despite the fact that no one likes the fact that a woman has achieved such high office in the kingdom. Some regional nobles have speculated that marriage to Lady Toba would include the dowry of an entire kingdom.

DIPLOMACY: none

Empty Mapungubwe was colonized back to 1 GPV by the Jewish Shona speakers of Zimbabwe. Hummer returned from Europe to report just how barbaric people are over there.

THE SAKALAVANS

Gordon Nogapunda, *Little Caesar of Madagascar, The Great Slobbering Taz*

DIPLOMACY: Malawi(nt)

Gordon and 10,000 infantry marched all the way north to Mogadishu where the locals revolted in their favor. They found Pundaport to be walled so Gordon chose to guard it until he can find a way to break in. This is turning out to be a good tactic because the Basoko are starving in masses. Prak wandered inland and found the Basoko were active around the Lake too.

THE BASOKO

Jobuti

DIPLOMACY: Lamu(nt), Burundi(nt), Kimbu(c), Mombassa(c)

Jobuti faced the entire region of Mogadishu in uprising. 6000 locals drove him into Pundaport. Two years later, the Sakalava army showed up but they didn't have the nerve to storm the mighty sand walls of Pundaport. The famine that had beset Basoko got worse. Pundaport was reduced to 1 GPV and thousands died.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Gunar, *King of Aethiopia*

DIPLOMACY: it rebelled

The Ethiopians renewed their construction activities in their area. Kassala's regional population was increased to 2 GPV. Maesawa, Akala and Soba increased in size. A new city Jima was built to grace the pacified Galla.

Maglor and Marinat patrolled the Bab al Mandab but there wasn't any Sakalavans to catch there. At the end of 1290, Mernol passed away. This was the end of the life of an Ethiopian king. He perished, faded, flat-scanned and became a cadaver. Once full of vitality, Mernol is now worm food. His eyes have closed forever and his heart has stopped beating. A passage has been bought for the ex-king's trip to the other world. His body cells, no longer warm, are decomposing. He's dead, dead, dead, no more, no way back, outta there. Prince Gunar was invested as the new Lion but other didn't like the idea that Mernol has breathed his last and kicked the bucket. General Mabor attempted to overthrow Gunar, but his crackpot plan to revive the deceased Ethiopian king was futile. Guards loyal to Gunar caught this traitor and he was executed and joined old man Mernol in mortal oblivion.

In Najran, Minister Donowa saw his chance to become a Muslim and elevated Uthan an Najr to become Lord of the Felix. The Muslim rebels took away Najran and Aden.

THE BLACK TOWER EMPIRE OF SINAI

Suentius Po V's new Empire consists of Sinai, Misr, Petra, Egypt and Faiyum. He doesn't stand a chance against the Cirinids.

THE CIRINID MATRIARCHY OF IEST

Cirin, *Veiled Matriarch of Iest*

DIPLOMACY: Lybia(a)

Astoria's hunch that an FFF lodge was in Lybia proved to be wrong when the Punisher Roach and the Aardvarkians checked the place over. The Lybians were nervous but were assured that nothing was wrong. The Big Hooters Roach visited Yemen but was unable to get any concessions there especially after the unstable political situation reared its ugly head in Iest's upper city.

Astoria and Chico Cerebus died in 1290 and the only one competent to rule was Chico's sister Cirin. Cirin is a committed matriarchist and does not like the Roaches ('Ticks' as she calls them). The Roach lackeys were (as usual) very self effacing to the point of flagellation and wanted very much to please their new mistress

The previous dynastic policies of Astoria had left Suentius Po IV spurned. he had always thought the Po dynasty should rule the Black Tower forever and to be banished to Sinai was a kick in the face. So with his supporters he gained the Nie Delta and Aqaba. Cirin still has her legions and swears she'll tear Po apart.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Valens, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: Corfu(t)

The Saxons greatly beautified many of their cities and reestablished contact in New South Wales. Trade with the Levant is now possible.

The new king Valens (Leonard died this turn) got a gift of the heads of three FFF generals wrapped in cloth. They were identified as 'Justin', the 'X-Man' and 'Reed Richards'. Action figures will soon be available.

THE ALORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Walid, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: Kazmedina(a)

The long reign of Abd ar Rahman ended with his death. His first grandson, Walid was just old enough to assume the Emir's responsibilities. Al Kiffa, Saguntc and Kazmedina gained more people. A strong port-fortress "Black Falcon" was erected near Al Kiffa in Malta.

Italy

Merca: 10mhi, 10mi, 5mg

THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Nero, *King of Liguria*

DIPLOMACY: none

With the Pope's absent blessing (The Papal See was in vacillation, actually). Three Ligurian corps converged at the mysterious fortress just outside Latium. All combined these were 20,000 cavalry and 26,000 infantry. With the superior leadership of Bruno and better siege tactics of the Ligurians, the fortress was destroyed after over a year of heavy pounding and the loss of life of 5000 heavy infantry. Two ringleaders were found inside. These were beheaded and their bodies were burned. The remnants of an elite guard garbed in blue with an 'IV' insignia on their chests were also found.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Pius III, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*

DIPLOMACY: none

Pope Harmony died in 1287 of a coughing sickness. The Papacy fell into an uncertain status. When the College had difficulty electing a new Pontiff. For a few months and anti-Pope called Matthew II rode around Rome claiming he was the Pope but this fraud was finally chased out of Rome after a year of listening to his ramblings. The College was embarrassed by the course of this indecision and elected another Spoleti, Uzello Di Saloti, to become Pope Pius III in 1289. Pius toured the ruins of the FFF fortress called by the locals as 'the Bread Tower' and was pleased by the Ligurian efforts to dispel this Gnostic heresy.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Angelo, *Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith*

DIPLOMACY: none

Angelo took the day off.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Dominic II, *Despot of Taranto*

DIPLOMACY: none

Dominic shot a few hoops in Atlanta.

Eastern Europe

Merca: 20mc, 10mi

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Alek III, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: Halland(a), Pereaslav(nt)

Opening up trade routes with both Andalusia and Mahidia, a port area was constructed next to the Bay of Biscay in Galacia. Vigo which faces the Sea of Portugal expanded to 2 GPV. Prince Gerhard returned to Orkney and discovered (like so many other before him) that diplomacy in a pacified area is futile. Fortunately, fate was kind to the young noble for his efforts.

Landgraf Rolf wasn't so lucky, he went into baneful Hordaland, a land of spirit worship and divinations. He was very nearly killed by the craven witchmen Rolf stumbled, wounded, through the mountains into Kristiansand where he languished. The 'Old Maid' Beatrix traveled to Pereaslav and was able to secure this proposed trade outpost for future development.

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCA

Horace, *Panarch of Francia*

DIPLOMACY: none

There was some word of a military maneuver in Switzerland but Horace denied it all. In fact Horace wanted every to see his wonderful nut collection. Nuts picked fresh from trees all over Europe and a couple from Araby too.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Eisen II, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: Zaporozhie(t)

From the trade outpost of Opol, new maritime routes were opened with Liguria, Islam, Parthia and Ethiopia. The crown lands of Lithuania and Pomerania were granted to loyal followers of the king. A significant heather population were found in these areas but much less than was expected.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

Emil, *King of the Bakons*

DIPLOMACY: Transylvania(n), Özu(w)

Satanos with 3000 armored knights, 3500 horse archers, 2500 pikemen and 3500 light swordsmen marched to Özu with the hopes of conquering the region in order to ensure safety and stability for the trade artery from Klutz to Kiev. A native army of 8000 nomads was there to resist the Bakon force. It was an ill-prepared mission. Satanos was a bad combat leader and his troops were using outdated swords and bows. Only able to drop 2000 Özu from their horses, the Bakonites lost 4000 men. In the mad scramble to escape to Moldavia, the Bakon horses screened a successful escape as Satanos essayed an escape to Moldavia. Smarting from all this, Satanos tried his luck in Goryn. This operation fared better. His 6500 horses broke the 5000 Goryn woodsmen and exacted tribute. Satanos was then bitten by a fox and died from festering sores. Emil is happy to be the king.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Boris, *Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: none

Prince Mikhail botched a military conversion effort in Kaluga. His men, frightened by what seemed to be ghosts in the frozen woods, retreated. Kaluga who were of a tolerant Christian faith was disgusted by this religious bigotry and revolted with hostility.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Hari, *Emir of Great Bolgar*

DIPLOMACY: Donets(nt), Suzdal(f)

The Bolgars continue to pitch unification plans in the wildlands of the Volga banks. The departure of the Kipchak from the borderland turned Urkel and Suvar Sunni Muslim. The Kipchaks have been co-opted it seems into the maw of an even greater horde. In other news, the mink population has skyrocketed and are beginning to swarm the city of Great Bolgar and Keeper. They don't smell that good and their hide is slick to the touch. Many are advocating their slaughter so that their pelts can be turned into hats.

ASIA

The Middle East

THE NICEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus VIII, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*
DIPLOMACY: none

"We the rulers of Dar al Islam and Byzantion will not countenance interference by any nation in the natural inter-action of sovereign nations. To wit, we will, in complete co-operation, destroy, level, obliterate, smash et al those parties who violate this decree.

"Nicephorus the Eighth, Eastern Roman Emperor
"Ad Dahabi, Kalifat Rasul Allah."

So it was. The armies of Byzantion were placed on high alert expecting violations of this new decree. Two cities in the Balkans were expanded and the fortress in Crete and the Peloponnese got stronger. Nicephorus talked about the eventual reunification of the East and West Churches but with Orthodox supremacy. Trade was recontracted with Spoletio

THE DARAL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

Ad Dahabi, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*
DIPLOMACY: Edessa(f), Karbala(afa), Pontus(a)

The Caliph began construction of the road link from Sarid to a watering hole in Charsionon. This was a most expensive project going over treacherous mountain passes and thick wilderness areas. The engineers have meekly returned to the palace requesting for more men and money. Trade with the Araik Khanate was formalized at the port of Bandar. The Ad Dahabi Caliph has given no indication whether he was actually a party to the Byzantine 'anti-interference' decree or not.

THE EMIRATE OF NAJRAN

Uthan an Najr
DIPLOMACY: none

Najran and Aden. Aden and Najran. That what Uthan has in his bag, Najran and Aden. Aden and Najran. This is the source of all the spice.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces II, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*
DIPLOMACY: Khokhand(f)

Arsoces I began to fret and fury over the latest horde threat as the grassy prairies had been so peaceful for so long. He sent spies to keep them in check. Relih of Khokhand was sent to the vicinity of Lake Balkesh to perform some devilry on the Ümlot. On the way lesser hordes, with avarice in their hearts waylaid the allied chief and took his purse of valuables, his provisions and all the horses. The nomad warriors made sport hunting the Khokhandi. Only a lucky few who did not die of cruelty or exposure arrived back home.

In the March of 1290, Arsoces died. His son Croton ruled for two weeks until he was poisoned. There was some civil fighting in the acropolis of Merv. General Buriln gained an upper hand and had Croton's son Arsoces II crowned Shah in September. There were some rebellions afield. Shirvan and Karatou took their leave of Parthia. In the city of Istahan, Krawdon proclaimed himself the Shah. It was from this modest city that the Sala Dynasty that rules Parthia had hailed. Krawdonites fought Salai along the Silk Road eventually one loyalist group gained the trade road to Timova the rebel had, however, gone south to capture the Indian Ocean port of Chah Bahar. In the horde frontier, Jnosis proclaimed his support for Arsoces II. The Parthian Empire still owns Arran, Bactria, Daylam, Georgia (now cultivated), Gurgan, Jowzjanan, Khokhand, Khurasan, Khuttal, Khwarzim, Kuhistan, Soghdia, Tabaristan, Transoxania, Tukharistan and Uzbek.

THE SULTANATE OF ISFAHAN

Krawdon, *Shah of Istahan*
DIPLOMACY: none

The Isfahani have the support of Dasht Kavir, Dasht Lute, El Burz, Fars, Khvor, Kirman, Kumis, Laristan, Makran, Shadad, Yezd and Zagros (the home). The trade routes to Ethiopia, Sinai and Chalukya are controlled by Krawdon's party. A famine in the area reduced the populations of Rayy and Masshad and turned Shiraz into a ghost town.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Roland, *Sultan of Afghans*
DIPLOMACY: none

The Afghan guarded Sind and did little else.

India

Merces: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE GOLDEN HORDE OF THE ARAIK KHAN

Sumak, *Khan of Khans, Arbiter of Destiny*
DIPLOMACY: not a chance

Three cities along the Ganges grew larger. Kaunaj to 10 GPv, Patna to 5 GPv and Delhi to 9. Bayan discovered that pacified Multan was undiplomacisable, it already belongs to Ashkiel, and is under military-religious law. Ashkiel's son Sumak has replaced the deceased Golden Khan.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dantidurga, *The Great Muta*
DIPLOMACY: Andhra(f), Konkan(f), Karnata(nt), Surashtra(afa), Dahala(a), Kutch(nt)

For the price of 10,000 rupees, 5 war elephants were sold to the Mahidians who showed up with the cash in Gobliguk. To honor the dead, the sacked city of Manyakheta was renamed Pulaj Mahal and was rebuilt to 1 GPv. A state run temple was erected there in reverence to Pulakesin III. With the ascent of the Kutch inhabitants, trade with Ghor was finally allowed.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Chanda, *Emperor of Manyakheta*
DIPLOMACY: none

Chanda didn't want to be in Jaunpur and went back home.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Opihou, *3rd Dalai Lama*
DIPLOMACY: none

Much meditation time was made up.

South-East Asia

Merces: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 5mg

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Namrangsam, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*
DIPLOMACY: Lampang(a)

Because Namrangsam had difficulty siring a male child, he named his younger brother to be the heir, perhaps sowing the seeds of future dynastic conflict. Most unexpected was the sudden appearance of the chief of Lampang in the Pagan King's court. He wanted to be an ally to one whose armies are mighty; Namrangsam allowed this.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Codimsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*
DIPLOMACY: Utara(nt), Bengkulu(t), Nias(nt)

More warships headed towards the coasts of Vietnam and Pagan and brought lots of spice and trade for gemstones and silk. The leaders Frainskilt, Thicky, Loar and Big Boss roughed up the naked savages of the mountainous side of Sumatra for tribute money. After noticing that Siberut owes its allegiance to Pagan, they ended up in Nias, famous for its yarn.

China

Merces: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 5meg

THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Gongse, *Wang Dai Viet*
DIPLOMACY: no effect

The royal road that ran along the Vietnam coastline got a new link that draws inland from Phitho in Cochinchina across the Mekong to the historic capital of Angkor. The Dragon of Chekiang did not send any gold nor a merchant fleet, so Taiwan remains Vietnamese.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Ciwou, *Celestial King of Chekiang*
DIPLOMACY: none

The forbidden city in Chekiang was embroiled in internal scandal involving corrupt government officials and their families. The illustrious Quai Chung died this turn.

THE ORIOU KHANATE

Quangxung, *Khan of the Oriou*
DIPLOMACY: Liaotung(nt), Wu Hai(t), Yen(afa), Bao Ding(t), Chihhi(a), Yun(f), Shangtung(t), Tsainan(t), Shentung(ea), Houma(f)

The Oriou got into the royal road racket by building one from Sarchou in Hopei through Loyang across the Huang Ho to Changan in Shensi. Prince

Lintuo traveled up into the steppes of Jehol and insulted the chieftain's mother's turtle. He and all his men were beaten bloody and their horses were stolen.

THE ÜMLÖT HORDE

Mukhali

DIPLOMACY: Kulsary(nt), Doltok Tribe(a), Cotturk Nation(a), Scorpion Folk(a), Whargut Tribe(a), Kipchak Horde(a)

The Ümlöt ran around the western steppeland looking for fresh recruits. They made it as far as Cim when an assassins blade wounded the Great Mukhali. The killer that was caught was a Parthian hireling. Ümlöt numbers have swelled to 273,000 men and they are pretty close to the Bolgar border.

THE UIGUR HORDE

The Zoroastrianist Uigur had an understanding with the Ümlöts; the Uigur would head east. Looting as they, Jerme led his war party. First to Tangut and ran afoul the Lamaist Ongorut led by the mighty Krabmet. The Ongoruts had long been a thorn on Uigurs side and the resulting bloody battle proved it. 108,000 Ongoruts whittled the 100,000 Uigurs down to a mere 7500 (Krabmet's horde is now 36,000 men). Krabmet would have pursued the fleeing survivors but was spooked by the sudden appearance of Barney of Dinosaur.

When Patiramji heard that she would be given Shikoku, she exulted. The Bulibajah left their perennial port home of Yonago for the last time, landed on Shikoku's coast, looted the region and then left, leaving the island in ruins. The Shikoku people were so enraged by this they rebelled.

The Bulibajah pirates stormed the Shuri fortress and impressed into service all of the inhabitants of Okinawa. This island was made into the Bulibajah's base.

Amago Michigiku, *Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan*

DIPLOMACY: Toyama(n), Nigata(c), Mutsu(nt)

"The Shogunate gives to the Bulibajah a feudal kingdom in Shikoku in recognition of the sea pirates loyalty which has been proven to the Emperor."

Indeed, the Bulibajah have become Shinto and worship at the shrines. But they're still uncouth bandits of the South Seas. After some gold was given to them for their support, Patiramji no longer commented about what a 'nice' city Yonago was. They sailed off into the Great Ocean with their own agenda.

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM

Singing Cove, *Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

DIPLOMACY: none

Calm Waters was awarded Kwakjalien to be his allied territory by the Emperor. The Invisible Fleet stayed invisible.

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Rangora, *Sorcerer-King of the Aketta*

DIPLOMACY: Paramata(ea), Toowomba(c)

A stable horse population has finally been developed. As a result the remainder of Australia has been populated by tribes of the Akettu faith.

The NEW WORLD

The Grand Massif

Merces: 10mi

MERCAIN

Angus

DIPLOMACY: Mohawk(nt)

Inland of Sokoki, protected from marauding canoes, was built Grimsby, Mercain's newest city. Mohawk's garrison was removed and Mohawk reverted to Chowan's control. This did not set well with Malcolm so this region was forced to pay tribute after a brief scuffle.

THE CHOWAN CONFEDERACY

Massapagua, *Chief of Chowan*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Chowan could have prevented this Mohawk thing but their leaders are too much like women.

THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Blackcat

DIPLOMACY: none
