Announcements

5th Edition Rulebook Update: There are some more new rules discovered to be in the upcoming 5th Edition Rulebook.

- 1. Merchant Fleets: There will be no bonuses for building Merchant Fleets any more. Indeed, Merchant Fleets are no longer listed in the Unit Construction Chart. If you want to build trading ships, you have to build transports individually. Merchant Fleets can still be built in this game until the new Rulebook has been published.
- 2. Regional GPv Boost: The new rules will no longer allow a boost of Regional GPv after a region has turned cultivated. If a cultivated region starts at 1, it will remain I until doomsday. If any wilderness region turns cultivated, then its GPv cannot be colonized from 1 to 2. Regional GPv boosting will be allowed until the new Rulebook comes to town and lays down the law.
- 3. Secret and Religious Empires: New rules concerning Secret & Religious Empire and how they collect their income has been implemented now. In a future turn, I will list the sectarian possessions (abbeys, monasteries, cathedrals and the Holy City) of ali active Religious Empires.
- 4. Social, Economic and Government: Specific rules on how to transform you nation are going to be detailed in the new rules. These are too lengthy to discuss in

I eat my hat! That darn rulebook is now projected to be out in mid-April.

New Old Naval Units: For the first time since the early days of Lords 10. Warships have returned along with Transports. Each one of your Galleys (g) have been converted into 2 warship (w) units. Tairidas (t) have been traded in for 3 warship (w) units. Erromonds (d) have been exchanged for 6 warship (w) units. Each one of your merchants (m) have been transformed into 2 transports (t).

The Cargo capacity of Warships is (1). This is double the capacity that it used to be. The increase in MSP (merchant shipping points) has been noted in your trade route section. Let me know if I forgot.

None of your ships have 'landing parties' any more.

Transports and warships can travel any coastal sea zone, river and explored inter-island arrows. There are no restrictions based on hull design.

Lords 10 Unit Conversion: Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning many ramparts, towers, & walls. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

West Africa

Mercs: 10mc, 10mi

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Numga Omar, Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: Zaria(nt)

The Fulanti made life better for the camel herder and the laborer opening up new farm fields connected with new roads and new irrigation canals. But the demand was for more urban spaces as dwellings became more and more expensive.

Numga Omar traversed to Senegal and was unable to change the diplomatic status there. He moved the western army back home. He had expected to get a new wife but there wasn't one waiting for him in his bed chamber. It seems that Nagai has found a fifth wife for himself in Zaria. Maybe Numga should find a wife on his own. Maybe then he'll have heirs.

Shabaz performed a military conversion in Niani, defeating an outraged bandit chief in the process. His 38,000 soldiers checked up on Boure to look at the famed gold fields. The garrison chief reports mosque attendance is up.

Meavis

DIPLOMACY: Borogou(f)

THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, Zimbabwe King

DIPLOMACY: none

The Zimbabwe made their move in the Sakalava situation. Crane Feller and Big Rocks led 7500 bone armored spear men and 25,000 short bowmen against Meiela forcing tribute from the gcys. Then they entered Mozambi itself, chasing Gordon out. A few Mozambis became Jewish but it wasn't good enough for the Crane Feller. A lot of snot got beaten out of the unbelievers as a result. Many spears were broken upon the many displaced Sakalava pizza delivery boys who had chosen to fight and die.

The new fields captured by the military did little to affect food prices which remained high. Five Twin Jackal responded to the public demand and got more dams built in Katue and Sofala. Jewish rabbis were consulted to determine if pizza is kosher or not.

THE SAKALAVANS

Gordon Nogapunda, Little Caesar of Madagascar, The Great Slobbering Taz, the Uniuckiest Guy on Earth

DIPLOMACY: busted

Burrp's protectorate was attacked by the Basoko. Burrp and his gifted son Zing took up the job of defending Entebbe's earthen walls. But some merchant guy had opened up the door (He claimed he wanted more air) and let the Basoko in. All who had defended or were loyal to the Nogcro were skinned and eaten.

Buiet

DIPLOMACY: Buganda(f)

Bujet and Ide-Bassa marched inland and overthrew the Kikuyu protectorate and then took their place. The mercenaries were able to capture Entebbe through treachery. Buganda was then settled by more Basoko tribes. This new land is isolated from Pundaport.

The zagwe kingdom of aethiopia

Gunar, King of Aethiopia DIPLOMACY: none

The Ethiopians took advantage of the harvest bounty by expanding six of their cites. New silos were also built to store all the extra barley. The royal road, Lions Walkway, was extended from Akala to Adulis.

It is whispered that King Gunar has amassed a huge treasure in his palace basements. Most citizens didn't seem to care; they were quite well off.

The black tower empire of sum

Yuliz at Path took his army to Baghdad and surrendered himself to the Catiph. Soon afterwards his tent was found empty. There was a crumpled note torn into 27 pieces which read:

"lest is a bad place to be. The people who live there make it a sport to destroy people's lives and then take all their camel-ball cards.

"The Rampart Road Report"s editorials are not nice to me.

"My live has been a living hell since I became the leader.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mhi, 10mi

The ar roch sultanate of lest

Er Rod Abu'l Hashim, Governor of the Vermin Insects DIPLOMACY: Granada(t)

Cirin returned back to lest but kept the army she led to herself, despite the entreaties of Big Hooters Roach. She ordered public works be built in Cheliff and Oujda to ensure better harvests.

In 1299, the Roaches conspiracy surfaced. They surrounded the palace and demanded Cirin step down and pay for the execution of Suentius Po V. Cirin would not. A destructive urban battle ensued. Cirin produced 2500 cavallers and 40,000 infantry to resist the Roach's faction of 26,000 sword men, 38,500 archers and 5 ceremonial war elephants. Allah was on the insects' side. The Roaches has a slight advantage in numbers even if they had been flanked by Cirin's horsewomen. The elephants went berserk and charged right into Cirin's center and broke her shield wall. The Roaches then surrounded the remainder

of Cirin's forces and butchered them all. Bloodlines Roach died in the Bloodbath Having cleared the capital of Cirinists, the countryside fell under Roach sway easily. Er Rod Abu't Hashim, a son of Chikul Ser el Bis became the new sultan of the restored monarchy.

the norman kingdom of saxonia

Valens, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois DIPLOMACY: Lyonnais(ea), Auvergne(c), Cortu(ta)

To celebrate the great wealth and power of the Saxroy, six new cites were founded on the continent. The following they are: Tours, a port along the Loire in Anjou; Valladolid in Castile; Angers, a port to the Loire in Maine; Rouen with a harbor to the English Channel in Ponthleu; Soissons in Vermandois, and lastly Vienne, a port beside the Rhone in Lyonnais. Bruges, Helston, Hill and Toulouse all grew. Street widening and beautification projects were built all over the kingdom. The massive centralized bureaucracy were kept busy at least this turn.

Valens who was an excellent sportsman, hunting venison when he could stayed in Normandy. His family still missed him in London.

the almoravid emirate of andalusia

Walid, Emir as Sevilla

DIPLOMACY: none

Walid searched his country for traces of the FFF but came up empty. At the Fortress of the Black Falcon, Masshad found some shards of a bizarre megalithic culture. The sisters of Walid remained unmarried and wondered why its taking so long to be betrothed. Bojador, Extremadura and Idjil all became cultivated. A strange black Jew stopped by and offered gold nuggets in exchange for the whereabouts of Rom.

Italy

Mercs: 10mhi, 10mi, 5mg

the kingdow of Liguria

Nero, King of Liguria DIPLOMACY: none

Nero sent Giuseppi to the Aegean to support Byzantine efforts to annihilate the nomadic threat. Old Nero remained in Liguria but often did not leave his bed chamber, ruling the nation by the sound of his voice. In many respects Tomaso had taken over the affairs of the kingdom.

Incidents of crime increased with the amount of restless youth looking for work.

the roman catholic church

Pius III, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God. Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church DIPLOMACY: none

To support future co-operation between the churches, 150.000 bezants were transferred to the Eastern Empire. They did need this to fight the infidel. Pius kept the Educational policy alive which benefited beleaguered Warsaw the most

the principality of spoleto

Castro di Sabini. Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith DIPLOMACY: Maremma(t), Tronto(fa), Pisa(nt), Elba(nt)

Castro and his men went to work picking up the pieces that had fallen away with the new regime. The army itched for action and scratched off all the fleas and ticks they caught in the woods of Sabini. Compared to other nations Spoleto's forces are ill-equipped despite the latest scientific advances by the artisans in Pescara. Arizzo's population grew.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Saxonio, Despot of Taranto

DIPLOMACY: none

As the Tarantum Exarchate waited, some thieves broke in the palace and stole a portion of Tarantum's saved gold. The city dwellers are complaining about the price gouging in the food bazaars. General Vegas wants to consolidate the scattered garrisons into one main army. At the end of 1300. Dominic II died after an unspectacular reign. The new ruler of this small country is Dominic's second son.

Eastern Europe

Mercs: 20mc, 10mi

The nordik kingdom of thacky

Gerhard, King of the Danes

DIPLOMACY: Romadai(h)

A vigorous trade network, encouraged by the crowned guys, managed by the Hansa Guild of municipalities, brought forth new ideas and new technologies to the fair shores of Nordic Thaery. As the most open and freest culture in all Europe, these new ideas percolated in the workshops and mills to produce finer consumer and industrial good.

Politically Gerhard had underestimated the Craven Hordel. The Hordelanders wanted to make the Nordic realm pay for all the insults heaped upon them by snotty diplomats. 5000 Thor worshippers descended the Hal Lindel River to Norway, plundered the region, sacked Oslo and captured a merchant fleet. They went back home to brag about how they really stuck it to the big guy. Poor Beatrix ordered to talk some sense into them, was imprisoned, brutalized and ultimately sacrificed to Loki. There was some murmurs of multiny directed against Gerhard for his lack of decisive action but none dare speak out in the open. Rolf was driven out of Romsdal.

Trade began with Parthia by the sea. At the end of 1300, 166,000 Umlots looted Lausatia.

THE CRAVEN HORDEL

Gesovak, Sworn Enemy of the Nordik Kingdom DIPLOMACY: Romsdal(t), Hordeland(hm)

The Craven were not Christian. They had never been converted. A point of honor drives Gesovak against the Thaerians. Romsdal, who had also been slighted by the high handedness of Thaerian talk found common cause with Hordel.

The raid into Norway also tetched into Hordel 100 merchant ships which has now allowed the Craven the ability to raid anywhere along the Scandinavian shoreline.

the kingdom of francia

Ekhart II. Panarch of Francia

DIPLOMACY: none

The Francians braced to deat with the latest horde threat. The army was picked up from the barracks in Giulia and Bavaria and set up a camp in Carinthia and awarted any contingency. Food prices plummeted with the bountiful harvest. Extra people moved to the cities, driving up furniture prices.

in the summer o 1300 the word came that the Umlot have entered Meissen and sacked Hamelin, including all the new buildings. Von Helzing and Varest reacted to the scene but by then the horde had left. A trail of destruction led north

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Boleslav the Cautious, Grand Prince of Warsaw

DIPLOMACY: Masuria(fa), Cherven(ea)

Prince Eisen and Boleslav split their forces and left the Bakonites in Galich. The king went up to Pomerania and couldn't negotiate a better alliance there. Less Prince Boleslav attacked and militarily converted Goryn to Roman Catholic. On his way back home, the Less Prince heard the Ümlots were coming right at him. Boleslav fled to Kuyavia and hid behind the solid pine timber fortifications of

The Ümlot had a free pathway through Poland. They looted Bochnia in the summer of 1298, then sacked Krakow. They rode through Sandomir and left that region unmolested. But Sorbia got the royal treatment in 1299. Lodz was sacked and every village in the area was harrowed of coin and corn. The merchant ships in the harbor were also stolen. The Pomeranians got jittery and rebelled to join the invaders. Pomerania even converted back to Euro-Pagan to pilease the horde master.

Eisen II died in 1300 and bequeathed the not large enough army to his son's command.

THE KINGDOM OF BAKONAI

Emil rested in Galich while his capital, Klutz, fell into the fell hands of Bohorchu's rapacious horde. It was sacked and burned and the fires scorched every farm and village in Slovakia. Thousands were killed and those who fled were caught and thrown back into the borifire. When crippled survivors crawled into Gallich, Emil was gripped in a mournful fit and died, coughing up innards. None of his family survived - they had been slaughtered by the horde. And no one wanted to take his place. The Bakonite realm disintegrated into various feudal estates and semi-nomadic bands.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Sergey the Severski, Prince of Novgorod

DIPLOMACY: none

With about 60,000 soldiers, Prince Boris pacified Kaluga and converted the land by force the Roman Catholic. Mikhail tired to install his brother Vassily as the feudal lord of Courland, but the Courlanders objected. The region had to be repacified. At the end of 1300, both Boris and Mikhail clied. The surviving eldes son Sergey who was placed in Seversk to guard the friendly outpost became the newest Prince of Christendom's frontier. He really needs to get to a more central location before regions revolt.

THE VOLGA BOLGARS

Hasti, Emir of Great Bolgar

DIPLOMACY: none

Hari announced that his Muslim nation be Roman Catholic now. He sent his son to Rome to become a priest. Hari took the name of Andrew. The Bolgars did not take this sudden change sitting down. The army backed by the merchant stood against Andrew. Buba, Yuqub and Prince Hasfi the new heir, sided with the populace and the army. In a bloodless coup, they threw Andrew out. They made Hasfi the new Sultan. Hasfi has promised all that he will champion Islam and smite the infidel.

There were pogroms against Christians and Euro-Pagans in Ryazan and Suzdai. Rezh was totally enslaved by the Ryazan pasha.

THE ÖZU RUSS RAIDERS

Sniva Kor, Prince of the Özu Russ

DIPLOMACY: none

While the Eastern Empire was distracted, Sniva Kor attacked Optimaton, looted the landscape, but was caught by an alert fleet. He stayed in Optimaton to consider his next move.

ASIA

The Middle East

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms, 5mg

the nikephorian empire of byzantion

Nicephorus VIII, Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople DIPLOMACY: none

The Emperor broke down some of their merchant ships and re-employed the crewmen as cavalry. These were shuttled by sea to Varna to join the Emperor and his son. An impressive army of 150,000 cavalry, half lances, half morning star maces, was assembled in Varna. They sallied forth when they were ready and followed the path of the Ümlots. They had already escaped by way of Ludgorie/Bosnia and crossed the Danube up river of the unnavigable Iron Gates. They might had caught them if the had not been burdened by siege equipment and heavy armor. The 500 warships that were admirated by Leo Tvismai sailed up the Danube in order to prevent a crossing. When it was apparent that they would elude his arrows, Leo returned to the Black Sea. He got an urgent message from Petrach in Sinope. The Özu had just attacked and looted Optimaton. So Leo attacked the Özu ships, capturing some and stranded the raiders of Optimaton.

THE UMLOT HORDE

Bohorchu, Destroyer of Nations, Plunderer of Europe, KhaKhan of the Wild Country, Hoarder of Mox Gems

DIPLOMACY: Pomerania(nt)

Bohorchu and his crowd counted Mukhali as lost. They knew the Byzantines would burn the old khan's eye's out, salted his wounds, castrate him and forment him for days, letting him linger with the barest of sustenance. Though less sophisticated, Bohorchu would have done the some if he caught the Emperor. Still there was no reason to stick around. The Ümlots left Dobruja but left campfires going to get an one day head start. It took awhile for the Byzantines to reinforce Varna anyway so when they were ready to give chase, the Ümlots were long gone.

There was much loot to be had. Klutz was easy. The accumulated treasure of an entire nation was all in one place. Klutz was then destroyed leaving nothing behind. Bochnia was then looted; Krakow sacked. Subsequently, Lodz and Hamelin were plundered. The Umlot romped along both banks of the Oder River in the final year of the 13th Century.

There was a change in leadership in the vassal Whargut horde, when the old Khan was killed.

THE ALANNI HORDE

Murgal the White, Khajan of the Alans

DIPLOMACY: Dangorr Tribe(a), Saiyam Bands(a)

From the Caucasian and Urkel, looting as they will. They attracted some tribes that did not join the Umlots much of Turkestan were lacking of hordes of any type. Many of the horde blocks having gone latent at the time. Shaytuz Khan died in 1300 while the horde wintered in Ishikotrau. The Alanni selected from their body a new leader reputed to be a dangerous man, Murgal. Murgal's hair is long as while as snow and is bound in the back with braids. He also has a long white mustache.

the dar al islam - arbilig caliphate

Ad Dahabi, Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful

The mostly rural Caliphate, stepped up city expansion a little with the growth of three urban places: Sarid in Edessa, Tabriz in Azerbaijan and Niksar of Pontus. Some plans were made to extend the North Highway to Niksar and surveyors were seen scoping out the landscape (mountainous, wilderness) along the way.

For a price, the Caliph bought the entire Black Tower Emirate. The new troops were given Arbiliqi battle gear and were added to the Aleppo standard. Hamoud's son Abbas generally did not get a lot of respect in the Caliph's court. He was still a child and had been pampered and spoiled his entire life. Sea Trade with the Bolgars was started. Some clerics are questioning the Caliph what's going on over there

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces II, Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria DIPLOMACY: Dasht Kavir(c)

Arsoces was content to partake the pleasures of his harem, keeping a home quard close at hand in case something went wrong. Proud Kevah and clever Pxosis prepared a horde trap in Tabaristan which, fortunately, was not needed. A delegation petitioned the Shah to help subsidize the building of new merchant fleets and expand contracts with the outside world.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Roland the Confused, Sultan of Afahans

DIPLOMACY: it will never be known

Last Turn's Ghur news entry, 2nd paragraph is all wrong it should read:

'Roland's best general attacked Kashmir and converted the semi-Hindus to the true faith by military intimidation. During this action, he was abducted by a flying saucer and subjected to horrible experiments. The UFO then emitted mental rays making everyone think that Kirthar, Pamir, Seistan, Turan, Ushrusana and Baluchistan revolted. In the confusion, the Saffarids, came back to power in Seistan and turned their homeland Shi'ite. A trans-dimensional gate appeared in the hills of Kashmir inviting some of Kachnar's soldiers to enter. This they did. Some were teleported to Sind where a badly scarred Kachnar was deposited. He landed next to the cattle carcass in a wheat field which had been transformed into a landing platform. Others found themselves in the world of Lords 9, Turn 59 (1295 AD). Kashmir was under the control of the Ghaznavids of Muktar ar Ramad. Only on this turn did the military converted Hindus turned to Sunni Muslim.

"The changes were so subtle that the soldiers couldn't tell the difference. Although a sign saying, "The Ramadi Caliph is your friend" did look rather odd. But then another portal appeared and they disappeared once more, leaving none the wiser.

And now this turn's entry:

Roland's battered general Kachnar rode up to Kashmir and found the missing soldiers waiting for him. Their influence had somehow turned Kashmir friendly but the Kashmiri insist their king is a Ramadi. A due to their condition could be found on a wall sign which read, "The Ramadi Caliph is your friend". Roland thought the Caliph was Dahabi but dismissed this as vandalism or a secret empire. Roland remained at home with a whole bunch of restless young men looking for something to do.

Trade still exists with Islam, Almoravid, Ethiopia, lest, and Byzantium. There is a shuttle fleet that keeps distant Ghebal Gherib in closer contact with the Suitan. For some strange reason, Kirthar turned Sunni Islam.

India

THE GOLDEN HORDE OF THE ARAIK KHAN

Sumak, Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunai DIPLOMACY: Bihar(c)

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Namrangsam, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

DIPLOMACY: Lampang(f)

Namrangsam married General Rurang to his eldest daughter. This ensured his continued loyalty when he was given the command of the 50,000 man army that was sent to Assam to protect Pagan against the vile Rastrakuta. A bribe was sent to them to keep them from attacking.

In the rough, bumpy terrain of Korat, Monphu was built. In the interior of Toungoo, Fort Fido was raised. The new citadel is five miles inland of Fido. Five cites expanded.
