ANNOUNCEMENTS

5th Edition Rulebook Watch: More developments from the 5th Edition Rulebook gremlins.

1. Merchant Shipping Limits Per Port: Good news everyone. It looks like the 10 MSP rule was a misprint. Here is how this Rule should be read: Each Level of a Port City can only support 20 MSP. Therefore if you have a 4 GPv port city, that port can hold 80 MSP. 80 MSP converts to 40 transport points (40t). If you have a sacked port city, you can base only 10 MSP from it. Each Port Fortress or Port Area can base 20 MSP. This rule will be effect when the rules are published. Upon implementation, excess ships will be dry-docked and have to be supported with Troop Support.

2. Coastal Trade Fleets: On your stat sheet, Internal Fleets are now called as Coastal Trade Fleets. These can only be assembled in groups of 20 MSP. Each 20 MSP will produce 1 GP in City, 1 GP in Inter-City and adds 1 to your ITV.

3. Leader Charisma: This is the third number of a leader's Stat Sheet. For purposes of simplicity in my games, Charisma shall be the average of the Combat Leadership and the Diplomatic Ability, round down.

4. Regional GPv Limits: It looks like there is a subjective Game Master fiat on the maximum GPv of each region. Therefore, effective now, any increase of a region's GPv above 1 must be OK'd with the Game Master. Only Cultivated Regions can be boosted above 1. Some regions that can be boosted are the Ukraine grain belt, the American Midwest, Australian East & South Coasts and the Darling River Drainage, Manchuria and South Africa.

Stat Sheet Changes: As the new Rulebook looms closer, some changes have been effected on the Stat Sheet.

1. Action Radius: The Intel Action Radius (AR) and the Religious Activity Range (RAR) is now a set value based on your Technology Level. This is now reflected on your Stat Sheet. Any Investment in these stats have been tossed into your Saved Gold. You also got extra GP is your old Stat was higher than the new one.

2. Merchant Shipping Functions: All External Fleets are now called Sea Trade Fleets. All Internal Fleets are now called Coastal. These changes are reflected in the Merchant Fleet Section, but not in the 'Fleets' box. The 'Fleets' box on the Stat Sheet may soon be removed.

3. Public Works Support: Support Upkeep for your Public Works are now included in your Project Support. The Formula for figuring out the Public Works Support is $(PWB / (10 \times (2 + \text{Imperial Size})))^2$. This formula has been modified to benefit the little countries out there.

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A merchant or galley point = 10 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 50 catapults each operated by 10 people. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 500 men manning many ramparts, towers, & walls. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

West Africa

Mercs: 10mc, 10mi

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Numga Omar, *Emir of the Fulani*

DIPLOMACY: none

Numga kept all the useless government stuff on the payroll. There was some requests for great, paved roads for better trade between the cities

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Meavis the Irresponsible

DIPLOMACY: Oyo(fa), Asante(nt), Burkina(a)

Meavis didn't have the infrastructure nor the proper administrators to effectively govern all his territories. Only a third of the possible taxes that could be collected actually made it to Accra. But did Meavis care? Of course not!

He was in his roomy abode trying to find a way to catapult fireballs into Numga Omar's orange tree grove. The siege experts and soldiers he hired were all dummies. They were clue less; their training wasn't at all vigorous. The Renegade Twinkee Brigade were left out of Meavis' general mischief. The people are not amused.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Akashua, *King of Ba-Congo*

DIPLOMACY: none

During the fall of 1308, Akashua came of age and wanted to become the king. Ngolti the regent didn't think he was ready but Ekolo did. After some palace fighting Akashua's faction won and Ngolti was ousted. Ekolo for all his help was snubbed. Likasi, Lubefu, Mitumba and Uige revolted. Captain Mandasa was executed.

The demand for city expansion was met with the growth of Boma, Luanda and Nolola. The lower taxes created the growth of a merchant class who invested in ships to trade with Togo by ocean. The chief of Giri was brutally assassinated.

East Africa

Mercs: 10mi, 10mw

THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, *Immortal Zimbabwe King*

DIPLOMACY: Nguni(f)

An embassy, Prince Eye Ache, went to Sakalava to make peace. The Sakalavans had him imprisoned and when the Basoko invaded was executed as

part of a final 'house cleaning'. Five Twin Jackal was astonished. Crane Feller wanted to avenge his brother. The whole gaggle of Zimbabweans attacked Nguni's gentiles and agitated them to become Jewish. They did so by the end of 1309. Many new public works projects were placed to help the farmers in Kafue and Rozwi.

THE SAKALAVANS

Gordon did the best he could with the meager resources of his country. The people want trade but Gordon pursued isolation.

THE BASOKO

Bujet

DIPLOMACY: Brava(ea), Lama(t), Kikuyu(t)

The Basoko nation remained split in two until Bujet talked to the various villages in Lamu and Kikuyu. His negotiations went better because of his ability to hire mercenaries. These were hired to destroy the Sakalava state. Led by General Ide-Bassa, they finished the job.

Ide-Bassa returned with much loot. The Basoko people wish that they could have an army of their own instead of having to hire mercenaries all the time.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Gunar, Ras Belga, King of Aethiopia

DIPLOMACY: none

In the mountainous kingdom of Ethiopia, five cities expanded: Gondar, Asmara, Kerma, Omdurman and Djibouti. The Lion's Walkway got a fork, the Lion's Climbyway. It went up from Akala in Kassala to Gondar in Adowa, up in the plateau. Adowa's regional GPv was cranked up to 2 GPv. The new people were provided with wells, canals, embankments. The economy of Ethiopia continued to be robust, increasing the well being of all people.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Merces: 10mhc, 20mc, 10mhi, 10mi

THE AR ROCH SULTANATE OF LEST

Er Rod Abu'l Hashim, Governor of the Vermin Insects

DIPLOMACY: Al Hauts(c), Granada(f)

Having had three boys from the union, Ar Rod, no longer slept with his wife. Ar Rod spent his time practicing field exercises with his troops. He had intended to use them someday but that day hasn't yet come. Realizing just how dirty each city was, the Lestian Sultan ordered some of them cleaned up so that the 1944 Olympics can lure here. The soil, grime, cockroaches and rates were banished from Tunis. The Roch leaders were concerned - They like dirty cities.

The Great Coastal Road got a stretch to the east built from Iest in Africa to Tripoli in Lybia. In Iest itself, the Great Library of Iest, was constructed to house the university system and all known books of knowledge. This grand, splendid marble complex covered a whole acre. Facing the outside was a rectangular building in Persian style architecture. At each corner was a minaret. Inside the enclosure were gardens and fountains. At the very center, a mosque. This place proved to be a magnet for the best scholars in the Mediterranean World. It was far more beautiful than the rude buildings in Genoa or Nicopolis.

Captain Cockroach investigated Vigo and died there. Apparently he was crushed by a huge moon-shaped rock.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Edward II, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois

DIPLOMACY: Corfu(f), Lyonnaise(f)

A part of the great army of Saxonia were demobilized and were given new houses in Tours, Toulouse, Bruges, Vienne, Angers, Lyon and Soissons. Most of these cities got wider streets, plumbing, fountains, police stations and firehouses. A few priests requested that something must be done about the raiders who have captured Rome. Valens told them that the Church will right itself up without Saxon help. The Saxroy died in 1310. His son, Edward II, quickly took command of the troops. He was crowned in an outdoor ceremony. Some coins were shipped to Thaeary. Trade with Ethiopia was restored.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Walid, Emir as Sevilla

DIPLOMACY: Bojador(a), Idjik(f)

This mysterious event in Galacia mystified the Andalusians to a great degree. A secret agent sent there returned home with a pomegranate. The Emir studied the pomegranate and spoke, "This pomegranate has got to be some sort of calling card."

Extremadura was colonized to 2 GPv. Al Kiffa grew to crowd out the island it is on (Malta). The northern frontier was enriched. Sevilla got a few more

fountains. This helped the internal economy which has been dwarfed by the export trade.

Italy

Merces: 10mhi, 10mi, 5mw

THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Bakonnio, King of Liguria

DIPLOMACY: none

The university complex became so vast that it took up an entire quarter of the city. The restless youths were used to expand Pavia, Amalfi and Napoli to 3 GPv and improve living conditions in the cities. The clamoring for a crusade against Tarantum was present. Bakonnio didn't see any need for it for Francia and Spoleto and even the Byzantine Empire were moving against them. So it was okay when the Tarantum Pope Breakers invaded Commachio. When Ravenna was captured, much of the Byzantine trade was lost. There was a desire to trade with Ethiopia. No lanteens were allowed to go there, though.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Pius IV, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church

DIPLOMACY: none

Pius' exile papacy moved to Spoleto in Umbria to await the results of the rescue. Tarantum was placed under interdict. It was honored by Saxonia, Liguria, Spoleto and Francia. The Thaearians were anxious to actually fight them.

A Spoleti army liberated Latium and restored the Holy City. Some assassins decked in blue with IV insignias failed to rub out the good Pope.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Castro di Sabini, Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith

DIPLOMACY: Pisa(f), Maremma(f), Tronto(a)

The main Spoleti army was in the wrong place when the Tarantum anti-Papal treachery occurred. They were Bavaria to stop hordes. It seems the horde was right here at home. They attacked Sabini and defeated the earl of Maremma in battle with over 60,000 infantry. The entire Sabini garrison of 11,000 infantry, 1000 heavy knights and 550 siege units were wiped out. Sabini was then looted. The devil-spawn went right on to Commachio by way of Marche and Rimini by the time Lorenzo and the heroes landed in Acona.

Lorenzo met the earl of Maremma met in Sabini and examined the site of the disaster there. After some rest, the army went on to Latium and attacked the Tarantum garrison that guarded the false Pope John VI by way of Cimini. John VI escaped Lorenzo's avengers and never again claimed his office as Bishop of Rome. The anti-priest eventually lost himself in the dense streets of Iest.

THE EXARCHATE OF TARANTUM

Vegas the Patriarch Breaker, Despot of Taranto

DIPLOMACY: none

The Despot's horde-like force of 5000 heavy knights, 4000 light riders and 53,000 regulars crossed the Apennines using the Tiber and Nera Valleys. In Sabini, on the way, they destroyed an important Spoleti army. In Sabini, they could not find the Spoleto capital. Perhaps they are looking in the wrong region (indeed, Spoleto is in Umbria atop a high ridge that overlooks the Nera River). By the end of 1307, Vegas made it to Ravenna and laid passive siege to the city - with a blockade conducted by Gorgas and 60 warships. The city surrendered after a year of aggravation. It turned out that Pope Pius IV had given the slip. Vegas wanted to install another puppet here but no one wanted the job. Under threat of death, Bishop Franco Sanjonah became the anti-Pope Satanos (named after the pious king of Bakony).

While the army was out, a Byzantine fleet assaulted Tarantum itself and tried to install one of their own as the new Despot. The government collapsed and what was left was retained by the Nikephorans. Further south, Dexall rebelled and took Squillacia with him. Matese also revolted. As that occurred, a pirate fleet raided Salentina, Apulia, Puglia and Bari. The Byzantine withdrew in 1309 leaving the capital pretty much unharmed. The entire Tarantum shipping network had been shut down. Trade was lost with Saxonia, Francia, Spoleto and Byzantion.

Eastern Europe

Merces: 30mc, 10mi

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAEARY

Gerhard, King of the Danes

DIPLOMACY: Pereaia(v)(ea)

The generally zealous Thaearians when they heard of the atrocity in Rome, came out in Kobenhavn, armed and ready to fight the Tarantum in Italy. External trade was expanded to buff up the local economy. Much improvements were built in the cities.

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCA

Ekhart II, *Panarch of Francia*

DIPLOMACY: Bohemia(f), Slovakia(hs)

Hamelin was rebuilt to 1 GPv with a citadel in the center. Gutters and sewers were installed in München and Wyst to prevent the rats from becoming as big as cats. The jittery Spoleto army who have risked their security by sending an army to Bavaria was escorted to Wyst to fight the rampaging Tarantum army. The Franken people clamored that the Pope Killer must be smashed.

Ekhart was too busy with the Polish nag he gained as a bride. She refused to bed with the Franken King and it drove him crazy. Why did he consent to marry this witch who is two years older than he? Because Bohemia came with the dowry. He replaced a piece of land that stabbed into the heart of Frankenreich with a wife that threaten to cut off his ding-dong every night. Van Helzing tried to settle some colonialists in Slovenia and incurred the wrath of the natives. Their 7000 mixed cavalry infantry force conducted hit and run attacks and forced Von Helzing to abandon the colony and escaped with half his 3000 cavalry guard.

In Austria, Herr Galt waited with many soldiers...

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Boleslav the Cautious, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: Lithuania(ea)

Lodz and Krakow were rebuilt to 1 GPv. These were the cities sacked by the Ümlots when the horde made its dash across Europe. The refugees from the original cities were finally resettled in their old house plots. Sorbia got its public works projects rebuilt as good as new. No one felt safe though, for there was no field fort around.

In exchange for 100,000 golden marks and future payments, Bohemia and the feisty princess Billery (youngest sister of Boleslav) were given to King Ekhart the Second of the Franks. The pacified, mostly pagan land of Goryn became the feudal territory of Gistay the Beardless. The Pomeranians who had abandoned Christianity and worshipped to infamous Bohorchu was subjected to a regional genocide.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Sergey the Severski, *Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: none

The cities of Pskov and Reval expanded by 1 GPv. Sergey installed his brother Ilya into the now mostly Catholic Kaluga. Boris Sergeyevich with the Novgorod army attacked the Eastern Orthodox land of Starodub and got them by force to accept Catholic rites. Muscovy who had likewise revolted was forced to pay some new tribute.

Sergey struggled to keep his government effective. Prince Vassily stayed home to help out.

THE KAMA BOLGAR STATE

Hasfi, *Emir of Great Bolgar*

DIPLOMACY: Suvar(f), Murom(a)

Hasfi and his cohorts began a massive effort to solidify his kingdom and make it wealthy. This was met with much applause. Hunzal, his son, found a suitable first wife in Suvar. There is demand for more cities and bigger cities.

ASIA

The Middle East

Merce: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhl, 10ml, 5ms

THE NICEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus IX, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*

DIPLOMACY: Paphlagonia(a)

Emperor Nicephorus VIII was faced with diplomatic embarrassment. He did not support the rowdy Tarantum Despot's hand in Papal politics. He denounced Vegas for his bloodlust and had him excommunicated. The Tarantum totally ignored this effort because Walter Baety dropped the Patriarch position a long time ago. To make up with the other pope, the Catholic Church was given 150,000 bezants and was thanked for his efforts to stem the Ümlot rampage. Then Admiral Conor, General Alcibiades, Prince Leo and Prince Konrad went on campaign against Tarantum. All the merchant ships of the Despotate was captured. Then the city was captured through fire and treachery. The treasury and university were loaded on the ships and returned to Nicepolis.

Varna, Dobruja, Ludgorie, Candia and Constantinople were expanded. The University at Athens remained the largest in the world. Trade was generally expanded. The route to Tarantum was cut off. Dalmatia was allowed to become neutral. Nicephorus VIII died in 1310 at the age of 58. The new Emperor has his father's and grandfather's name.

THE ÜMLOT HORDE

Dawlus, *Evader of Nations, Escaper of Europe, KhaKhan of the Wild Country, Hoarder of Clockwork Animals*

DIPLOMACY: Torliks Land(nt), Blubleg Land(nt), Lenolik Tribes(nt), Vabol Land(nt), Silnorak Land(nt), Tutorks Land(nt)

Dawlus, not the best khan, with a vague sense of leadership, rode east. The hordesmen without much better to do, fattened with their European vacation, followed. The Ümlots had a very bad harvest. But since they are total nomads that have not settled down. It did not affect anything. All the lands east of the Volga revolted.

THE ALANNI HORDE

Murgal the White, *Khajan of the Alans*

DIPLOMACY: The Whole Tarim Basin(nt), Tienshan(nt), Ongorut Zu(a)

Murgal the White headed west along the Silk Road looking for allies. In Tarim, he met the Karluk and got in a fight. 38,000 Karluk attacked 110,000 Alanni, 10,000 Dangorr, 48,000 Saiyam and 9500 Arbabat. They were utterly vanquished. Some 7500 Arbabat got trampled as the price of victory. Murgal and his men abducted all the Karluk women as prizes and looted their homes. Kashgar was passively sieged and then sacked. After plundering the towns south of the Taklamakan, Murgal bested the Ongorut Khan in personal combat, gained the loyalty of another tribe.

At the end of 1310, the Alanni came up the city of Karakocho in Uigur. The Ongorut Khan begged the White Terror not to sack it. So it was spared

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

Ad Mustaras, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

DIPLOMACY: Karbala(f)

The Caliph's Road from Baghdad to Niksar was completed by the end of 1310. The regions of Diyala, Kuwait, Mand and Pontus were pumped up to 2 GPv. The cities of Sarid, Bandar, Acre, Niksar and Hasakeh grew. Samarra in Jazirah, along the road, and Siffia in Karbala, a port to the Euphrates, were founded.

After a successful reign, Al Dahabi, the first of the Erbil Caliphs, passed away. His effeminate son, Abbas, was given the symbol of the office, a ruby scepter. Abbas also got to dress in gold trim silk.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces II, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*

DIPLOMACY: Chah Bahar(ea), Dasht Kavir(ea), Laristan(hs), Kyzl-Kum(n)

An increase in the gold value of Chah Bahar was enough enticement to return Makran to the Parthian sphere. The merchant fleets based there were sent to resume trade will be some real inter-nation income coming in.

Burilin, the most mediocre general, figured he could cross over a mountain chain with 27,000 mixed infantry beat up on 7000 wilderness dwelling Laristani. He had the numbers but he didn't have the nerve. After losing 1500 armored men, the army ran over each other trying to escape. Burilin died in shame and was replaced with a better general.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Arsian ar Ramadi, *Sultan of Afghans*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

In the mountains of Turfan, Kashtan, was founded. Ibol in the Maldives was snubbed. The Chalukya diplomat was a better tongue wag. Luro went to Ferghana, a distant over-mountain land virtually impossible to control, and was laughed at. It was to the court mavens surprise that Turan was not talked to. Turan really really likes Ghur. The economic advisor whispered in Arsian's ear that Ghur is almost as rich as Parthia and is wealthier than the AraiK.

India

Merce: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE GOLDEN HORDE OF THE ARAIK KHAN

Sumak, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*

DIPLOMACY: Maghada(f), Bihar(ea)

The Khan toured his land and found his cities very filthy. More rats had jumped over the tall walls to terrorize the elephants. So they were made taller. And a few lucky cities got a sewer system and clean water fountains.

Sumak's only son Lakshana died. Lakshana's orphaned son was adopted by Sumak to be the next khan. Sumak considers building some ships for trade. Patna expanded to 7 GPv.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dharmapala, *The Great Muta*

DIPLOMACY: Maldives(f)

With the knowledge gained from the Ghuz Hordes the Mandalam cavalry were trained to be deadly on real big horses. Their quality is almost as good as the AraiK. Because the Chalukya cities were so clean. All the new public works

were built in regions. Stones were given to the children so they could practice throwing at the monkeys. Gunter, Gobliguk and Nils expanded to 2 GPv. Polonarva is now 3 GPv. Food prices skyrocketed, except for monkey brain and pomegranate. Trade with Parthia was renegotiated.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Kunara III, *Emperor of Manyakheta*

DIPLOMACY: Orissa(f)

Tamralipti, a very nice city, expanded to 2 GPv. Faraja and the Kamarupa ally found that Kosala is already friendly. And Nadavaria really can't improve from homeland. Factor Two, a leader, found that allied regions can with some help improve to friendly status. The military advisor wants to see the army united under one centralized command instead of being so scattered. Some gold was received from Pagan.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Ingran, MIA, *King of Lhasa*

DIPLOMACY: none

While minister Segpop slept, the Jade King disappeared without a trace. The restless youths looted parts of Lhasa. There was a disturbance in Gtsang as well.

South-East Asia

Merce: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Namrangsam, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*

DIPLOMACY: none

Even though Pagan needs more farms, Monphu and Fido expanded. Namrangsam and the many Burmese leaders traveled all around the area, even into the lands of Vietnam, making the locals very jittery because they brought troops. Some efforts were made to improve the Kingdom's governmental infrastructure.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Marinimsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*

DIPLOMACY: Sarawak(nt)

New trade contacts with Chalukya was expanded so much that the average ship's hold is mostly empty. There is a lot of extra shipping on the Aquarium's fleets. And the government is too fat too. The whiners who wanted more rice paddies got their wish. Let's hope they get to work and get off the Big Fish's back. There was talk about infiltrating the Great Bulibajah Fleet. Somewhere out there in the open seas, some 5000 boats all with hulls made of rock. Their crewmen never tire and can swim underwater for days (You can't keel haul these guys). Their leader is the Master of Storms and can turn the wind at will. And someday they will sweep all the landed people and submerge them under the waves.

Srivijaya expanded to 10 GPv and got some brand new ramparts that conceal its tallest buildings from the outside. With their trade contacts and great cities, Java has become wealthier than the Chekiang Dragon.

China

THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Hiep, *Wang Dai Viet*

DIPLOMACY: Hainan(f)

Seven Cities (Hoi-an, Vijaya, Phi-Tho, Angkor, Shau Tachi, Hue and Saigon) grew to 5 GPv. An eighth metropolis, Thanglong, grew to 8 GPv. The notorious urban dirtiness of Vietnam was paid some heed. Rickshaw-men, honey dippers and street rakers were hired to make life more cheery in the big city. Much rice was saved to keep the food prices low.

Ngoc Triang went on a secret mission to the northwest mountains. It went well. He brought back a craven, bald, black magician. This guy scared all the women of the court by bringing a skewered pig back to life. At the same dinner, Ngoc Triang gagged on an onion and died. This unwelcome visitor was tossed in a cellar, but was not badly mistreated for fear of more jinxes. Too late, King Hiep has taken ill and is bedridden.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Four cities expanded. Tani, Souchou, Yixing and Kwangchou. A new military build-up program proved to be mere lip service designed to scare away the hordes. Some of the northern cities gained some wall points. Szechwan, a land of trouble in the past, finally was incorporated in full as an imperial province. Kanchou also got annexed. A very special gift to the Duke of Lichou radically changed that leader's heart towards the Emperor.

As promised, the merchant shipping increased. A coastal fleet now plies good around the area of Kwangchou.

THE ORLOT KHANATE

Quangxung, *Khan of the Oriot*

DIPLOMACY: none

To deal with the evil Gurvan threat, the Oriot mobilized its forces and made maneuvers next to the Great Wall. Inspectors from the military academy discovered weaknesses in the wall near Pei Huang and Yun. New farms were opened up all over the kingdom and the surplus was saved for a dry day. DIPLOMACY: Stigham Tribe(nt), Merkit Zu(nt), Kerait Zu(a)

Bachia-Jia took the Gurvan out to a jog. Some neighboring tribes even joined him. It was a good warm up exercise.

THE NEW PROTECTORATE OF SILLA

Yixo Fok

DIPLOMACY: Silla(hm), Koguryo(f)

Freed from Japanese suzerainty, the Koreans stuck together. Silla reemerged as the leader even though it has been a wilderness for awhile. The first king since 1143, when Chisun Yui's protectorate was whopped on by Fujiwara samurai, is the ragged Yixo Fok.

THE AMAGO SHOGUNATE

Tenno Fushimi, *81st Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu*

Amago Michitaju, *Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan*

DIPLOMACY: Toyama(fa), Hokkaido(nt), Nigata(a)

"The provinces of Koguryo and Silla are hereby released - in addition, all our trade fleets are called home - the future of Amago shall be a policy of isolation.

"Emperor Tenno Fushimi."

To put the new isolation in effect, Japanese ships withdrew the garrisons from Chosan and cut trade with the outside world. If there was any reason why the Empire would have nothing to do with the rest of the world, the Shogun would not say. A larger navy patrolled the coasts, keeping the evil foreigners out.

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM

Sunlight that shines upon the Moon, *Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

DIPLOMACY: Ho Tikika(f)

The promise of the Maori Islands was good enough for the Stormking to decree a migration there. With no dissent and a common purpose, the Empire picked up their stuff, loaded it on boats and headed south.
