ANNOUNCEMENTS

Stat Sheet Changes: More changes have been effected on the Stat Sheet.

- 1. Regional Spacer Code:** Fortresses that have port areas, that is, Port Fortresses will endow a region with a 'p' in the Regional Spacer Code.
- 2. Coastal Fleet Limit:** Listed under the Number of Coastal Fleets in the FLEETS section of the Main Stat Sheet is the Max. Coastal. This is the Maximum Limit of Coastal Trade Fleets your nation can have.
- 3. MSP Limit:** This is the total of MSP all your port cities and port fortresses can support. Any MSP that exceeds that number will be dry docked.
- 4. Leader Charisma:** This is the 3rd Number of the Leader Stats. It is how sneaky or stealthy a leader is. This number is important to Secret Empires and Primates.
- 5. Troop Supports:** The Troop Support costs have been adjusted to the 5th Edition Rules. You may notice some changes. Nomads may not need pay support if their troops are in steppe regions.

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

AFRICA

West Africa

Mercs: 10mc, 10mi

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Numga Omar, Emir of the Fulani
DIPLOMACY: none

Numga Omar presided over the increase in salt traffic. His son Maleek came of age and was given an unnecessary post in the bloated government.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Meavis the Irresponsible

DIPLOMACY: Mossi(a), Asante(fa), Nieta(f)

Meavis returned home to proclaim himself a god. The idol industry liked the idea. The witch doctors were unhappy. This government intrusion into voodoo-care could only bring self-destruction. Komoe and Tusyam rebelled. The military's reliance on throwing spears was seen as a handicap in times of war.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Akashua, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: none

The Kongo King offered relief to the suffering masses by lowering taxes. The people used the extra resources to find more roots for their dinner plates. There was trouble when a Mass Conscription was called on to make badly needed at home children government work sarfs. Benin, Cuango, Loangar and Mbundu rebelled, chanting, "No Food! No Kids!"

Akashua's force reacted against the riotous Cuango first and crushed them. No public works were left intact when the region's revolt was put down. The Mbundu rebellion was badly led too. They chose to fight inside the city of Luanda. Akashua's 21,500 wood-armored swordsmen and 26,500 spearmen had to deal with 12,500 urban rioters, 5000 local militia and 7000 village spearmen. The Bakongo overwhelmed the burns and pacified Mbundu. Luanda's population was reduced by one gold point value. 6000 heaves were slain in the urban disturbance. Then the hill tribes of Loangar was taken out. They were well led but were only 4000 against 37,500. Only 500 Bakongo died in the subduction. There was not enough time to deal with the Benin. Their departure cut overland trade with the Fulani and made the Togo route purely maritime. Now Akashua will have to think twice before stealing boys from their parents farms.

DIPLOMACY: none

The Zimbabwe Chief Descendent proclaimed there will no longer be commerce with the outside world. All the overseas merchants were let down. But the Chief explained how Five Twin Jackal was beset by a vision of the End of All Things. Many new farms were potted in Kafue enriching the citizens of that infested with slime, grimy city, Lesser Zimbabwe.

THE BASOKO

Bujet

DIPLOMACY: Kimbu(t), Kikuyu(a), Gamo-Gofa(ea), Ankolye(t)

Mombassa revolted when the Basoko didn't raise its own army nor re-hire the mercenaries. The other territories are getting jittery. Mogadishu rebelled because of the distance from the King. There is now a movement afoot to make Buganda the homeland.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Gunar, Ras Beiga, King of Aethiopia

DIPLOMACY: none

A chain was built to span the Nile River between Amada and Luxor. Puteys on both sides allowed the chain to go lax and lie on the bottom of the Nile. A royal road (Lion's Highway) forked from Gondar to Abbis. A commitment to beautify the cities was stressed by King Gunar. Tobruk and Gondar grew fatter.

Gunar is too old to have children.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Mercs: 10mhc, 20mc, 10mhi, 10mi

THE AR ROCH SULTANATE OF IEST

Ar Rod Abu'l Hashim, Governor of the Verrin Insects

DIPLOMACY: Al Hauts(n), Barqa(fa)

Ar Rod spoke to his secret agents of the dreaded secret organization, Big Nasty, and told them to continue their destabilizing work inside Genoa. They saluted him with a nod and vanished into the shadows. Three cities: Oujda, Algiers and Oran expanded to 3 GPV. The Grand Coastal Road got an extension from Algiers to Oran in Cheliff. The Yemen outpost plan finally was revealed. But the planned trade station resisted Iestian stickers until they get rid of their antennas. The infamous Toilet Roach really stuck it to the Al Hauts.

THE NORDAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Edward II, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois

DIPLOMACY: Auvergne(nt)

The mighty manpower of the Saxons began the construction of Roads connecting Sussex to Anglia to Northumbria. Nine cities expanded and so did the sea trade. The Auvergne bandits were investigated and proved to be just

bandits. Grain was purchased from the Andalusians and the Thaeirians at extra-low prices. Fountain saturation was achieved in all Norman cities.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Walid, *Emir as Sevilla*
DIPLOMACY: none

A fit of road building fever gripped the whole of Andalusia. It started in Seville and followed the Guadalquivir river to Cordoba. This road continued on over mountains to Toledo in Talavera. More mountains were crossed as the big project jumped from Talavera through Saragoza to connect Sagunto of Valencia. Many died as the people upon the dusty ground, placing stones and leveling the earth. Sagunto is no longer the most likely city to die in. A small loan was taken out to finance the preserving of good grain that was sent to Saxonia for a tidy profit. A group of missing sailors returned with their ships in Sevilla. Prince Marwan is having trouble making kids. His wife is in tears. Trade was started with the leader of those who would not submit to Islam, the Pope of Rome.

Italy

THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Bakonnio, *King of Liguria*
DIPLOMACY: Commachio(ea)

Sea Trade was revived with Ethiopia after some mishaps. Bakonnio returned home and did much paperwork that had been piling up. Lord L'Suilei tried to coax the crusaders to follow him but they had their own ideas.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Lucius IV, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*
DIPLOMACY: none

The Crusaders were idle and considered their options. Since the apostate Tarantum have been destroyed, there was no reason to do anything. They went back to their dairy farms in Thaeir-land.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Giuliano di Sabini, *Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith*
DIPLOMACY: Matese(fa), Apulia(ea), Bari(t), Tronto(nt)

The lack of farm land continued to rise the food prices. Old Lorenzo was put to pasture as Giuliano wanted to have his old school-mates serving him. Trade with Francia was established.

Eastern Europe

Mercs: 30mc, 10mi

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Gerhard, *King of the Danes*
DIPLOMACY: Pereaslav(ta)

The two outpost cities: Vigo in Galacia and Pottava in Pereaslavi expanded. Bergut the Stupid was ordered to discover the islands of the Faeroes. He came back to Shetland with some ruffers made up. They were illegible. The Princess Hilde and some others investigated the Pomegranates in Galacia. In their searches they found no purple, man-eating monster, just those strange red fruit grown on trees. The Parthians were contacted with an armed merchant fleet.

THE KINGDOM OF FRANCA

Ekhart II, *Panarch of Francia*
DIPLOMACY: Illyria(t)

The old Hamelinden were given better houses in an expanded Munchen. Another payment of gold brick was ported to Warsaw as another installment payment on the Bohemian mortgage.

With attacking Slovakia (sigh), Herr Galt returned back to Bavaria and died most horribly, screaming violently against the sights he saw in his head. The army is now under the king's command. Ekhart's still having trouble telling his twin boys apart.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Volazarn IV, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*
DIPLOMACY: Kiev(t)

Infantry wererowned upon by the military establishment. Thus they were all demobilized to expend two cities: Gornel (of Lyubbech) and Gdansk (up in Obodria). Sacked Kiev was rebuilt to 1 GPV. These port expansions showed the dry docked transports back to the river lanes. Many sailors who had lost their childhood were happy at least one day. Kid King Volazarn showed what a ruler he was parading 70,000 knights to the various villages surrounding Warsaw.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Sergey the Severski, *Prince of Novgorod*
DIPLOMACY: Kaluga(f)

The Great Prince was too busy ruling his mighty power land. Even those distant towns were co-operative and stayed with the realm. There are some who want access to the furline. Rakekin just don't measure up to the softness of beaver and mink.

THE KAMA BOLGAR STATE

Hunzal, *Emir of Great Bolgar*
DIPLOMACY: Donets(ea)

Emir Hasfi died in Bolgar while on field exercises with his camel rangers. The youthful Prince Hunzal is in Donets talking about making money. Rent cost has gone through the thatched ceiling in Bolgar. Lots of hard working people want to live in the capital, but they have to settle for tents outside the town.

ASIA

The Middle East

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus IX, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*
DIPLOMACY: none

The navy and the regular army got more men to play around with, for the Byzantine Empire can never have enough troops. Three cites got pumped up to high gold point value. Constantinople got it to 8. Nicopolis is now a 7 city. Hellas is too a 7 city. The Black Sea is calm but only for a short while.

THE ÜMLOT HORDE

Frank, *KhaKhan of the Wild Country, Hoarder of Ivory Towers*
DIPLOMACY: Lenolik Federation(a)

The Ümlot took a jog around Lake Balkeeh. The Lenolik Federation were impressed into allied service. The Ümlots looted all along the way. The Ümlot are now in trouble for an even bigger horde had just came out of the chule.

THE ALANNI HORDE

Lugahol the Thick, *Khajan of the Alans*
DIPLOMACY: no consequence

Murgal returned to the steppeland and explored the Gobi which is not really steppe but a bone-cold desert. The White Terror's ambition to be the source of civilization went unfulfilled. His death caused a war between his sons for leadership. There were no one suitable for leadership from the loins of Murgal. After Dibgal killed his brother Sibbelei and defeated Garntok and the Artebat, he had to face Lugahol who rose from the main Alan horde. Lugahol's 172,500 rangers stampeded Dibgal's 48,000 ex-Saryami riders. With the defeat of Murgal's blood other would-be khans were chased away. The Dangorr allies left the Alan camp, now in Kthingan.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

As Sa'id, *Kalfat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*
DIPLOMACY: Fers(t), Dulaym(c)

More of Islam's resources disappeared. Some officials suspect underworld corruption. The Caliph was tight lipped about the whole affair and would not listen to those who say that he cavorts with demons. But a pentagram was found on his forehead when the Caliph died.

A trade route could not be inaugurated with the Basoko. Other plans for Basoko had to be set aside due to a lack of communication.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces II, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*
DIPLOMACY: Makran(a), Karatou(c), Kirman(hs)

With the trade routes open to the outside world, the Shahdom finally made the kind of money they used to have. But it is now in jeopardy because an insufficient garrison has been left in Kirman. Old Chah Bahar expended much to the pleasure of the local prince. Ahuramazda whose reputation has yet to be tested on the battlefield is amassing his own fan club. Now Kirman has rebelled and killed off its 'protectors'.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Omar, *Sultan of Afghans*
DIPLOMACY: Ferghana(nt)

The Ghorids was one of many nations trying to send fleets to poor, pitiful Basoko. The latest Ghur envoy to Ferghana did not disappear into the Dreamlands. His guide yanked his sleeve though, waking him up before dawn.

"Listen... it's getting closer."

"What?"

"Listen... it's getting closer."

The poor guy could only hear the sound of frogs and birds. But upon a deeper concentration, an ominous presence could be sensed.

India

Mercs: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE

Beljanapala, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*
DIPLOMACY: Bihar(f)

Prince Yelando of Bihar married into the Harayuk family and took command of the Harayuk forces. He forced the regent to step down and then proceeded to dispossess all the major castes of their institutional power. There were sporadic rebellions but the true trouble was in the capital. Both lieutenants rebelled and were killed by Yelando. As soon as power was fully in his grasp, Yelando also

changed the nomad based slave economy to guild by regulating the slave owners out of business. This new society churned to the surface some strange people hitherto hidden in the undercastes. Many worshipped the Goddess of Death and relished human flesh.

Yelando at the end of 1320 was killed by an ex-Brahmin assassin. There were reprisals against the Brahmins who were driven to exile or to the underground. The new king, Bejanapala, son of Sumak, has ratified his guardian's momentous actions.

Patna is now 9 gold value. Multan has become 4 gold points. Some silver chips were received from the Chalukya.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dantidurga II, *The Great Muta*

DIPLOMACY: none

Dharmapala died at the end of 1320 bequeathing a wealthy prosperous Chalukya Mandalam to the 11 year old Dantidurga II.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Faraja, *Emperor of Manyakheta*

DIPLOMACY: Pundra(a), Kamarupa(f)

Despite the low harvest yield of late (there was enough saved grain to spare everyone) three cities expanded. Konorak to 5, Bhagalpur to 4 and Tamralipti to 3. Prince Chanda was married to the Burmese princess Veluvati. They got to work right away.

THE JADE KINGDOM OF TIBET

Ingran, *King of Lhasa*

DIPLOMACY: none

There were calls for a holy war against Vietnam. So far Ingran has been unable to stoke his population.

South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Surang, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

The mass conscription ordered by Nannrangsam was very unpopular. There was no national emergency. The Burmese crown wanted to expand Fido and place public works all over Burma. Mothers missed their children. There was rioting in the streets. All the public works in Assam was destroyed. Lampang revolted. There was a deep economic depression. Nannrangsam tried to apologize but the people wouldn't listen. The old king died in 1320.

Surang had some 54,000 javelin throwers which he used to crush the Lampang. While there, he was informed of his new job.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Marlinmsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*

DIPLOMACY: Timor(ea), Sarawak(fa), Sulawesi(nt)

The demand for more farms were answered in all the islands, especially the Moluccas. Timor was offered fresh fish for its return to the Aquarium. Marlin's son Mantasutra died of mercury poisoning. Another son of Marlin, Walleymsutra became the heir over the objections of the supporters of Manta's son, Catfishmsutra.

China

Mercs: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 10mew

THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Vandiem, *Wang Dai Viet*

DIPLOMACY: Kweichou(f)

Like their Paganese neighbors, Viet also called on mass conscription at a time of peace. Why? To expand a few cities: Thanglong to 10; Shau Tachi, Hoian, Hue, Vijaya, Phi Tho, Saigon and Angkor to 7; and Tali to 6. But the Vietnamese didn't need city space. Vietnam really needs farms! All the friendly regions erupted in unrest. Lingsi, Yunnan and Lingnan were especially nasty. But only Lingsi rebelled. The expansion of Shau Tachi was lost to the deprivations of angry farmers. Much of the new public works there were destroyed. The rest was canceled. There were agents trying to stop the rebellion in Lingsi but they were overwhelmed. Trade coming out of Shau Tachi ceased to come to Thanglong. The routes to Ciao and Silla were lost. The land lane to Chekiang was diverted south through the rough terrain of Lingnan. Champa is now Mahayana Buddhist.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Ungzhang, *Celestial King of Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: Fuchien(nt), Cheju Do(nt)

Emperor Ungzhang became the father of a boy in 1318, after many years of frustration. Four cities were expanded. These were: Chekiang, Zhuzhou, Yixing and Chunking. Fortunately this and the new public works were built without having to steal children. The Lichou ally neutralized the Vietnamese diplomacy in Tungchuan.

THE CIAO CHINESE KINGDOM

Quo Yu

DIPLOMACY: Bao Ding(a)

Quo Yu was a good king. He kept the distant regions in line and the government happy. He had the time to produce many children, 'Ciao Babies'.

THE GURVAN ZU OF ANSHAN

Burkhan Riugoy

DIPLOMACY: Ongut Nation(f)

On the way to the south, The Gurvan got snagged by the populated Thurian tribes. The first group to challenge them were the black clad Ongut in Sunghari. The 30,000 Ongut were angry and attacked. They were outclassed by a factor of six. 12,000 of the 180,000 Gurvan tribesmen were killed in the fracas. After picking up the womenfolk of Ongut, the Gurvan stumbled into the turf of the Singing. The Singing had 96,000 nomadic warriors to back up their property rights. The Gurvan were reduced by 135,500 cavalry fighting these obstinate natives and lost their khan Lagogar; he had been captured. Prince Riugoy who had valiantly led his father's horde was acclaimed as the khan. He negotiated passage at the cost of his father's permanent imprisonment.

Finally a haggard Gurvan horde reached civilization. A welcome sight it was. Parhae was attacked and pacified. Two tribe points were settled there inciting a rebellion which was easily crushed. The already sacked city of Liaoyang was destroyed. Anshan was conquered and also was settled. This region became the Gurvan homeland. The Gurvan then attacked Koguryo the economic heart of the Silla. Yixo Fox fielded 7000 against 134,000. Yixo Fox and his men annihilated. Sunto was assaulted with no damages and then was sacked. Two more tribes were settled in Koguryo as well. All three of the conquests became Asia-Pagan due to settlement.

THE NEW PROTECTORATE OF SILLA

Yixo Fox died fighting the Gurvan. There was no one else willing to stand up for the Protectorate against a mighty horde.

THE MONGOL KHANATE

Temujin

DIPLOMACY: none

From the Lands of the Far North, some 205,000 Mongols have risen to the call of Temujin.

The Pacific Rim

Mercs: 10mhi, 10mi, 10mw

THE AMAGO SHOGUNATE

Tenno Fushimi, *81st Emperor of Nihon, Decendent of Amaterasu*

Amago Michiyanja, *Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan*

DIPLOMACY: Hokkaido(f)

To appease the hairy people in Hokkaido, a city was built as a port to the Peruse Strait: Ikanawana. Although the Japanese have been isolated for a decade or so now, new Chinese goods could still be seen in the marketplaces. The Shogun Michitaju died in the fall of 1320.

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM

Sunlight that shines upon the Moon, *Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

DIPLOMACY: none

In Otago, the port of Riddle was built. More fishermen were trained to keep the Agricultural balance good.

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Kagagor, *Sorcerer-King of the Aketta*

DIPLOMACY: Iriedh(a)

There was demand for more cities in the imperium, especially to help diplomacy in near-friendly regions.

The NEW WORLD

The Grand Massif

Mercs: 10mi

MERCAIN

Malcolm

DIPLOMACY: none

Malcolm got his men involved in the Chowan Civil War (Part One). Prince Fleance led 5000 heavy infantry and 10,000 regulars to a region he has had difficulty holding, Mohawk. After the 4000 Manhattanites were defeated by the Mercain, Mohawk was pacified. A modest treasury was recovered in the city. Due to distance, Wyandot revolted. Trade with Hopewell was interrupted. Malcolm might consider moving to a more central location.

THE Over-extended CHOWAN SUPREMACY

Taget, *Chief of Chowan*

DIPLOMACY: Catawba(f), Delaware(f), Powhattan(f)

Taget sent his lieutenant to wage war on the old regime, the potentates of Manhattan. This was a mission easily accomplished. Powhattan, Delaware and Catawba were recovered. Sitting on the very edge of his kingdom, in Atakapa,

Taget expected to rule regions one thousands miles distant! Fortunately neither Rudi nor the far-flung regions of Delaware, Powhattan and Catawba rebelled. But they will if Taget insists on staying in Ayeol plotting the destruction of Caddo. The Cheraw allies forced tribute from Tonkawa, for their part in the Caddo gang-bang. Rudi and his 10,000 followers, half of the mercenaries, pacified Yamasee and the city of Kolomoki.

THE MANHATTAN COMPACT

The Mercain cut off the head. The Chowan took the body. Geshmal's body was not among those found in Mohawk. No one knows where he's gone.

THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Black Lynx

DIPLOMACY: Potawatomi(ea)

In alliance with the Chowan and maybe Wyoming, the Hopewell finally geared up to destroy the Caddo. Silver Lion, the heir, led the 25,000 braves and defeated only 45,000 Caddoans in Michigamea. Since there were no Michigameans present, the region and city (Cahokia) had to be pacified. Meeting the 2500 heavy infantry in Kaskinapo. Tunica and Taposa were pacified. With 21,500 available braves, the Great Snake was crossed and the Caddo home garrison of 3500 heavies and 9000 archers were challenged. It took a couple of skirmishes and at the end of 1320, Caddo was occupied by the Hopewell. The last bastion of old Atakapa had fallen.

WYOMING

Lake Hawk

DIPLOMACY: Muskegon(c), Kickapoo(f), Sauk(f)

The Wyoming also joined on the attack on the Caddo like a scavenger picking on a dead carcass. A combined force of 9000 men crossed from Sangamon and attacked Quapaw. There were 5000 Michigameans there, they were wiped out in a couple rounds of battle in 1317. In the battle, all 1000 of the Fox were killed. A new Fox ally has replaced his dead father in Fox. The Great Trackman of Kickapoo was wounded and stayed in Quapaw. What was left was enough to occupy Osage after defeating the local force. General Red Fox did a survey of Caddo's forces. There were more in the region than the initial Wyoming war party. So the Hopewell eventually came in and closed the Caddo themselves.
