### ANNOUNCEMENTS

**Lords Account Unification:** As of this week, I have unified the Player Accounts for all my games: Lords 11, Lords 10, Lords 9 and Black Empire 2. As a result, some of you will notice lots of credits. Others of you may be behind in credit far more than normal. If you are delinquent between the amounts of \$3 to \$6, I will send you your Lords 10 turn instead of holding, but I will not run your orders if payment is not forthcoming. If you delinquent more than \$6, I will hold your results until such time your account has been brought back to black.

Let me know if something doesn't seem kosher. I admit intense player demand has swayed me to Unify all the accounts.

### LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 300 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly warriors.

## AFRICA

### West Africa

**Mercs:** 10mc, 10mi

### THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Maleek, *Emir of the Fulani*

DIPLOMACY: Adwaghost(t), Kanuri(nt), Daza(c)

Numga Omar, after experiencing moss growth on his butt, stirred. He visited Adwaghost and found a wife for his kinglet son, Maleek. General Argabak, new

to the staff, was chosen to lead 38,000 infantry to attack Igbo. The Dongo were taken by surprise by this move. They didn't expect such a hostile action from a trade partner. A heavy garrison was needed to pacify the wilderness and pagan Igbo land. The Emirate Road was extended from Jenne to Segou to Kumbi-Seliah of Ghana. Those two cities plus Sokoto expanded. Numga Omar's long rule ended with his death in 1330.

### THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Winye

DIPLOMACY: Senufu(fa, until it revolted)

Almost on cue with Fulani, the Togo messed with the northern possessions of the Bakongo. But neither leader could foment a rebellion in Benin. Meavis' death was celebrated by the whole populace. He was a deviant malcontent slob and no one likes him. It was a fluke that he was able to reproduce. His son, Winye, took over as much of Togo was in a state of chaotic joy. Burkina revolted and so did Senufu. The leaders in Benin ran away. Asante stuck around and so did Mossi to see what kind of king Winye was.

### THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Akashua, *King of Ba-Congo*

DIPLOMACY: none

Trade was suddenly lost with Fulani when they attacked Igbo. Akashua could have easily stopped the aggression but did nothing.

### THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, *Immortal Ancestor of the Zimbabwe*

Crane Feller, *Chief Zimbabwe Royal*

DIPLOMACY: none

Crane Feller was into ruling. Five Twin Jackal would not stop talking. He talked about the 'good old days' when termite mounds were knocked down regularly. But no one else remembered these days. They were 150 years ago.

### THE BASOKO

Ramujet

DIPLOMACY: Burundi(f), Kikuyu(ea), Mogadishu(ea), Mombassa(nt)

After a long wait, the Basoko regained the allegiance of Mogadishu. Ramujet went to Burundi because he liked it better there. A city, Mwanza, was built there.

### THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Jngawa, Ras Opa, *King of Aethiopia*

DIPLOMACY: none

The sudden realization that disaster was just around the corner spurred the Ethiopian elders to divert many of their fleets to fishing. The root cause was the expansion of cities to great levels. Umgawa and Jima both grew. A royal road was constructed to connect Omdurman to Dongola. Haraskan was satisfied with his efforts. So he starved himself to death.

## EUROPE

### Western Europe

### THE AR ROCH SULTANATE OF IEST

Ar Rod Abu'l Hashim, *Governor of the Vermin insects*

DIPLOMACY: Al Hauts(c), Barqa(f)

Perhaps as an appeasement, 50,000 dinars was shipped to Genoa. This kept them from interfering with an economic transformation from slavery to a guild system. There were some disruption but it pacified quickly. In Barqa, Benghazi was built as a port city.

### THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Edward III, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Saxons bought more grain from the Andalusians to hold down the food prices. More cities grew: Tours, Toulouse, Barcelona, Helston, Bruges and Vienne. While hunting fowl with his son, Edward II was killed in an accident. Days after his coronation, Harold caught a cold that led to his death. After some scrambling, the Saxons set up a regency for the seven year old king, Edward III.

### THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: none

All the money Saxon had paid the Andalusians was stored in a special room - to check for contamination. Walid's death caused a bit of an updrar. Ministers Ubek and Abu'l Sanuan attempted to toss out the new Emir Marwan II. Marwan was clever enough to stop the rats. After a complete purge in the capital, some new blood was installed in the palace. Marwan hopes to keep the Alhambra at peace for a long time. News from Morocco was a disappointment.

## Italy

### THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Reginald, *King of Liguria*

DIPLOMACY: none

Bakonnio died to make way for Reginald

### THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Lucius IV, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Rome Pontiff certainly had something to say about the Moldavian Massacre. He placed the fault of this disgrace on Wulharrik the Younger, who was excommunicated. Wulharrik was commanded to present himself before the Pope in Rome for judgment and penance for his heinous crimes against the Christians of Moldavia. 1327 was a year of mourning for the Moldavian martyrs including the Greek crusaders who were slain by the Poles. The abbeys of Spoleto, Commachio, Emeliano, Abruzzo, Chiana and Umbria were upgraded to full monasteries.

### THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Gugliano, *Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith*

DIPLOMACY: Matese(a), Tronto(ea), Bari(a), Apulia(a)

The Spoleti made some significant progress recruiting former Tarantum land to join the central Italian kingdom. The events in Russia seemed not to affect the relations between Catholics and Orthodox in Italy.

## Eastern Europe

**Mercs:** 30mc, 10mi

### THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Ebert, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: Pereaslavl(f)

After so much effort (that took decades), the Pereaslavans finally allowed full Thærrian jurisdiction, despite the Moldavian thing. The news must have caught Maxim by surprise; he had a heart attack. Up in Hordaland and Romsdal, the troops were evacuated, seeing how the regions were 'officially' Roman Catholic. When the late king Maxim decrees something to be such, it must be so. But when the garrisons departed, the former Hordel territory reverted to Euro-Pagan and are both hostile. The new king, Eibert, didn't care, he's only 13 years old. His aged great-uncle, Simon, was made the regent to rule for the years it will take to get Eibert up to speed.

### THE KINGDOM OF FRANCIA

Ekhart II, *Panarch of Francia*

DIPLOMACY: none

After some heavy thinking, Ekhart made Bluto the heir over his twin brother, Bruto. An evil chemist discovered a potion that turns men into green scaly amphibians.

### THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Volazarn IV, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: Kiev(hs), Masuria(f), Cherven(f)

Volazarn reinforced Wulharrik with a reaction force of 25,000 knights led by Dirmindus. Dirmindus tried to smooth things out with Kiev, but the metropolis would not allow public works to be built in their land. His stumbled words only earned him and Volazarn their hatred. As Catholics were expelled from Kiev, the Kievans applied to Byzantium for Nikephorian protection. The refugees settled in Cherven and Goryn. Cherven was given a new city, Volazarnya (named after the megalomaniac) and in Masuria was founded the town of Wayness (after the megalomaniac's wife).

In 1327, Dirmindus' 65,000 heavy-light cavalry were challenged by 53,000 crusaders. They fought like berserkers and drove a wedge of death in a wing of the Polish horse formation. The superior equipment prevailed. The crusaders were not backed by the Nikephorian military might. The fanatics were trampled to death and the Poles suffered only 10,500 casualties. Dirmindus was killed in the final gasp of the battle. Wulharrik was not a part of this for he was excommunicated. The troops would not follow him because of his soul was lost. He hid in an unmarked cabin. No mom will ever name their child 'Wulharrik' ever again.

### THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Sergey the Severski, *Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Novgorod pleased the sourpuss Muscovy by giving their chief the hand of Princess Tariana in marriage. Vitebsk expanded to 2 GPV. Viktor twiddled his thumbs.

### THE KAMA BOLGAR STATE

Hunzal, *Emir of Great Bolgar*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Bolgars built ships. No one knew why. They were not doing anything.

## ASIA

### The Middle East

**Mercs:** 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms

### THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus X, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*

DIPLOMACY: Wallachia(t), Temesvar(t), Kiev(nt)

The crusade made their way north, stopping at Varna, then crossed into Vlachite territory. The Vlachites didn't want to be the object of the crusaders' ire. Wallachia and Temesvar converted to Eastern Orthodox and sent some tribute to Nicepolis. Marius lost his heart to evict them. He left them be. His true intent was to inflict chastisement on Poland and Wulharrik. The Poles were better prepared with 50 field forts and lots of cavalry and were perfectly nappy to defend a bad guy on the battleground. The crusaders went to heaven, the Byzantines won a moral victory. Though some priests complained, the Emperor didn't spare even a fraction of the great Byzantine standing army to stick to the evil Poles. Kiev appreciated the effort even if it was nominal and joined up. So did Ozu and Ateikuzo. Of course all this broke trade between Poland and Byzantium. A new route to the bizarre Chalukyans was started when they finagled an outpost in Aswan.

A new port city was built in Cyprus, Nicosea.

### THE ALANNICHARG HOST

Subatoi, *Khagan of the Alans*

DIPLOMACY: Tatar horde(f)

Subatoi rode his horde back to Turkestan, away from the Mongols. He stopped in Beshbalik to water his horses. His horde would have been doomed otherwise.

### THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

As Sa'id, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

DIPLOMACY: Qatar(c), Fars(a), Madina(c)

The Caliph's Road was connected with the Persian Gulf when the Najat-Baghdad link was finally built. Cities expanded. Basra, Aleppo, Acre to 7 Gold Point Value. Hasakah and Niksar to 5. Sarid to 4. The conquest of Muslim Aswan by dirty Hindus was of some concern to the Caliph. The fleet expanded and was placed in Sar'dn's command.

### THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces III, *Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*

DIPLOMACY: Yazd(c), Karatou(t)

Ahuramazda returned to Shadad and led 10,000 heavy infantry and 22,000 light infantry. The great general plus 6000 Makrani flattened Kirman. Typical of Parthian incompetence, another insufficient garrison was left in the wilderness region (sigh). While Laristan was being conquered, Kirman rebelled. The Makrani have had enough. They joined Kirman and became an independent, neutral region.

The Parthians had also made preparations for Horde attack. They built a great wall on the Karatou side of the Karatou-Argu border mountain range. They also financed the Ghur's mountain wall of Ferghana-Kuldja. There are significant gaps, though. A horde can penetrate through Aral'sk, Argu-Khokhand, Kuldja-Khokhand and Yarkhand-Ferghana.

### THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Omar, *Sultan of Afghans*

DIPLOMACY: Ferghana(f)

The regency had to step aside for Omar, a popular guy but with terrible administration skills. It is doubtful the Ghurids can hold on to Ferghana even though a wall section had just been built there by the fruit of Afghan's youth.

## India

**Mercs:** 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

### THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE

Beljanapala, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*

DIPLOMACY: Sukkur(a)

The Chalukya gave gifts of barley bread and jewel stones to honor the great Harayuk. The new wealth helped increased and beautify Benares. From Benares, a new trade route was sailed to Pagan.

The Andaman Islands were invaded by 10,000 men on 50 transport closer to home. Jhelum was pacified by 25,000 cavalry. But these some cavalry ran into some trouble in Ajmer's 12,000 horse-nomads. After heavy casualties (7000 men) the desert region was pacified.

### THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dantidurga II, *The Great Muta*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Chalukya conscripted many coastal fleets to be used to transport an invasion army against Aswan in northeast Africa. They encountered by a very sly and dangerous chieftain which the Chalukyans called the Lava Lord. There were 6000 nomads at his side. The Chalukya general Yasinditya commanded 35,000 men and crushed the Lava Lord. Bitter Aunt Sai settled a tribe point of Hindu settlers in Aswan which then precipitated a second conflict. Another Lava

Lord appeared. He led another 6000 nomads. They too were destroyed. So Aswan was transformed into a mostly Hindu region much to the bitterness of the surrounding Muslim regions. A city was built along the Lower Nile called "D'nile". A port fortress was constructed by the Red Sea which got tagged "Bitter Sar" after the cranky woman. This new outpost immediately began trade with Byzantium. Goa was expanded to facilitate the new shuttle fleet that was sent to the Nile.

## THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Faraja, *Emperor of Manyakheta*  
DIPLOMACY: Bhutan(t), Sikkim(t)

The fall of Tibet opened up new Buddhist territory for the Rastarakuta to diplomacize. The foothills of the Himalayas were the first areas to be approached.

## South-East Asia

Merces: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

## THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

K'awrahta, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*  
DIPLOMACY: Sagaing(t)

Rurang returned home with accolades of triumph and celebration. 100,000 taels of silver were shipped to Rastarakuta to keep the western neighbor happy. K'awrahta himself had a lot of children. He doesn't need any more.

## THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Walleyamsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*  
DIPLOMACY: Bengkulu(a), Sulawesi(a), Palawan(c), Sarawak(f)

The King gathered all the troops from all the islands and put them in his command. Aceh and Palembang, Singapore and Kadaram expanded. Many things were built to make Prambanan, Timor and Srivijaya look better. Allies were found in Bengkulu and Sulawesi. Runan went to Palawan, a tropical isle people by ethnic Japanese huddled around the venerable Castle Hagi. It was an unpleasant trip.

## China

Merces: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 10mew

## THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Vandiem, *Wang Dai Viet*  
DIPLOMACY: Preikuk(fa), Hmong(f), Lingsi(f)

The Vietnamese prepared for a coming Mongol onslaught by expanding their elite army. Nahonbana got Lingsi back into the fold. The Hmong Prince married Hip Voan, sister of Vandiem, and was given a wing of the palace.

## THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Guan Ungzhang, *Celestial King of Chekiang*  
DIPLOMACY: Lichou(t)

The Emperor was alarmed at the collapse of Ciao's military and began efforts to solidify his own - and strengthen defenses. Advisors whined that the preparations were just window dressing but these were ignored. The cavalry patrol was handed off to Koeli Luang who moved his camp to Houma at the invitation of the Ciao. Tao Fong was also supposed to go north but he didn't know what route to take.

Admiral Sou Yi with 505 elite warships sailed north to pound on the Japanese galleys that were trying to close down the lucrative smuggling business that Chekiang had supported all this time. The Japs fought with usual vigor but it was useless. They were tossed overboard as all their ships were boarded and manned by the ex-elite Chekiang marines. About 30 Chinese ships were destroyed in the one-sided naval battle.

## THE CIAO CHINESE KINGDOM

Quo Yu  
DIPLOMACY: none

Every available man and boy was drafted to join Ciao's reorganized cavalry force to make up for the loss in Tsingfeng. In Pei Huang, 45,000 men nervously watched beyond the wall for thundering gallops and dust clouds. King Quo Yu with 25,500 men stayed in Hopen and remained optimistic. 130,000 well-trained, well-equipped Chekiang cavalry moved into Houma. The Gurvans showed in Houma too with force of 133,500 tribesmen. They kept a respectful distance from the Chinese for the Gurban were Mongoloids themselves.

## GURVAN ANSHAN

Shutson  
DIPLOMACY: Bando(nt), Liaotung(nt), Yen(nt)

Gengsuar sent his son Shutson to represent him against the expected Mongol attack in China. By moving the army from Koguryo to the heart of China, Korea has been left unprotected. Gengsuar didn't care about that - he's a fool. And he died a foolish death. The new king Shutson is too far from home and must come back immediately to present rebellion and disaster in the homeland.

## THE MONGOL KHANATE

Temujin, *Genghis Khan*  
DIPLOMACY: Umlot Horde(f), Stigham Zu(a), Xao Ongut Host(a)

Like a magnet the Mongols picked up all the Horde tribes who lived in Mongolia except the Zandang who dwell in Wudan. 110,000 Zandang horsemen

ran against almost 500,000 Mongols and allies. The Zandang were creamed so utterly that no horde will ever inhabit Tumet, Chahar nor Wudan again.

The Mongols then went to the land of the Manchows where the local nomads were too scared to come out. Owing the whole steppe Temujin was called the Genghis Khan. It's his the Great Khan's ambition to conquer the entire world and to collect every unusual object known.

## The Pacific Rim

## THE AMAGO SHOGUNATE

Tenzo Kuzuyu, *82nd Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu*  
Amago Michikafu, *Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan*  
DIPLOMACY: none

The Emperor inaugurated the Yamato Agricultural Project increasing yields allowing for more population growth. The ports of Yanago and Kumamoto were placed under interdiction to stop the Chinese contraband from coming in. The criminals had an ace in the hole - the Imperial Chekiang Dragon - whose ships captured the entire Amago fleet. Hosakawa and the Admiral of the Navy were left with a oceanful of drowned men. Maybe interdiction on land will stop this smuggling and force the Chekiang, who have laughed so hard at Japanese sovereignty, to invade at a time when Chekiang itself may fail to Genghis Khan.

## THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM

Sunlight that shines upon the Moon, *Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*  
DIPLOMACY: none

Alone under the starry night the Storm Empire sleeps.

## THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Sular, *Sorcerer-King of the Aketta*  
DIPLOMACY: Pechua(neutral), Eha-Rana(nt), Toowomba(t), Nokama(hs)

The Aketta built up their army too, expecting the Mongols to invade. The king picked up 20,000 men and threatened Temora. They would not be intimidated. Kagagor beat them and forced tribute from them. Pechua softened up their hostile stand after Temora's defeat.

Kadinah expanded to 4 GPv. Kagagor died in 1330 so his son, Sular, was crowned. Sular is a famed high priest of the Dark Goddess. The Nokama killed Bestan who was a bad diplomat anyway.

## The Grand Massif

Malcolm  
DIPLOMACY: none

Old Malcolm strained to reach Mohawk, now under Dumain's watchful eye. Dumain had less troops than Fleance. So the Mohawk took a chance to revolt again. The Mohawks defeated Dumain and forced him to Iroquois. Trade was lost with Chowan. The lack of trade has brought up discussions to deal with the problem. One suggestion has merit - to build great canoes that sail the seas delivering and picking up goods from distant ports.

## THE CHOWAN SUPREMACY

Skor, *Chief of Chowan*  
DIPLOMACY: Santee(ea), Okahawa(c), Texas(c)

Before contact was lost again, the Mercan had sent the Supremacy a sum of 20,000 clams. This allowed Taget to lower taxes while he was in the last years of his life. A new route across the Gulf has brought exotic Caxaca merchandise into the stores of Chowan.

## THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Silverton  
DIPLOMACY: Saginaw(nt), Muskegon(t, no longer a part of Wyoming), Wenro(nt)

In Miami, a new city, Wilkesboro, was founded. The rights to Muskegon was bought from Wyoming.

## LAKES WYOMING OF ILLINOIS

Hawkeye  
DIPLOMACY: Noquet(a), Ojibwa(c), Kansa(t)

The Wyoming got less money from Hopewell than they expected. The new chief Hawkeye (since Lake Hawk croaked) was told by Sangamon that they won't promote themselves without a city. Hawkeye had bad administration skills.

**THE POPOCELOTL KINGDOM**

Tezozomoc

DIPLOMACY: Mogollon(ea), Chiricaua(a)

The Jaguars shifted their trade to the sea lanes.

**OAXACA**

Nenetati

DIPLOMACY: Cuyutec(nt)

In Nahuatl, Acapulco was built. It is a port. A coastal fleet was placed there. Cuyutec opens the door for land trade with Popocelotl.

**South America**

Kevrit

DIPLOMACY: none

Alagoas expanded. Ulanku and Milkonu perished in an epidemic. Milkonu's son Kevrit is now the king.
