ANNOUNCEMENTS

I'M BACK! There is nothing you can do about that. It was a good vacation and all games are now properly aligned. Let's get this train moving again.

\$13 Rulebooks: Thank you for sending \$13 checks to Thomas Harlan. Those of you who send \$10 to Thomas to get the new Rulebook will have their checks returned. The exception to this are those of you who can pick it up locally at Thomas's house in Tucson

Guard Units: Guard Units cost 2 NFP and 10 GP initially and then, must be invested in for its level to be increased. They can move by themselves at the leader's rate but cannot lead armies. They can perform some Intel operations (depending on their level), especially Counter Assassination and many leader/army operation. They cannot Diplomacize regions. This rule is effective in all Plate Games.

Agro Cash In Rule: Those of you who have incomes 50 GP or less can cash in 1 excess AGRO for 1 GP or 2 AGROs for 1 NFP. With incomes between 100 to 50 GP. 2 AGROs can buy 1 GP and 4 AGROs make 1 NFP. Above 100 GP you can only use AGRO to defray the NFP cost of building Megaliths or maintaining them at a rate of 5 AGRO for each NFP. This rule is effective in all Plate Games.

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. The guard unit = a thousand of your empire's toughest, most gnarly

THE AKA MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Maleek Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: Mandara(n), Galam(c)

Maleek mustered 16,000 young men for his own personal guard while the war against Togo continued. But the steeping tion had awoken and came back at the Fulani with a vengeance. Ife, Nupe, Hausa and Kebbi were oven un. The Togo horde now sits at the gates of Gao, preparing for a siege. Ghana, Kanuri Khalem, Senegal, Zerma and Adwaghost rebelled. A former lieutenant, Mohammad of Ruatu, has joined Adwaghost as an advisor. Boure, Galam. Takrur and Gambia are now isolated from the rest of the Emirate. The old Prince Crecrum is keeping them in line these days. On the other side, Zaria, Gwari, Daza and Borna are only accessible by an oasis route through the Sahara Desert. Trade with Andalusia was interrupted.

THE NIGER BASIN WAR

Togo vs. Fulani

Caught by surprise with the sudden Fulani attack on Ife, the Togo elders conferred. As would be expected the war party prevailed. The Obs-king Kutoba stopped by every hut handing out spears and shields. he had finally called on his waiting man power to build a humungous army. When all had gathered, King Kutoba, Captain Gumbani and Colonel Kuta counted their trains, there were 95,000 men ready for war 25,000 of them were heavily armored with ivory and wood. On the way to Ife they were joined by 1000 Asante machete men, 1000 Mossi archers and 2000 non-tribal warriors who life it was to fight battles. In June of 1336, this Togo caught 32,000 mixed equipped Fulani infantry, trying to invade Yoruba. The Fulani leader was Argabak who hung the fingers of his would be Togo killed around his neck. Argabak was outclassed by three to one. Not a single Fulani warrior was left to resist the Togo march. During the rest of the summer,

Ife was liberated - returning to friendly Togo control.

In the following spring the Mossi detached, taking 10,000 additional men into their tribe. The Togo caught another Futani force, crossing the Niger, attempting to invade Oyo. The 11,000 Muslims were pulverized to jelly under the feet and spear butts of 81,000Afro-Pagans. The Fulani leader, Simtah, was captured by a mop-up patrol. He immediately repudiated Islam and offered his services to the Togo king in exchange for his life. Under advisement from Colonel Kuta, Kutoba agreed to spare him. There may be use for this wight.

Nupe quickly paid tribute to the great mob of Togonads, who had crossed the river in the fall, rather than face an ugly ravage. During the winter months, Gumbani and the Assante split off and raided Daza and Kanuri. In the summer of 1338, Kutoba and Kuta and their forces invaded Hausa, exacting tribute. Simtah earned his keep by tricking the Katsina guards to open the gates, saving Kutoba some time. Rejoined by the Asante and Gumbani armies, the Togo forced tribute from Kebbi in 1339.

Meanwhile, the exhausted Mossi men braved the unpopulated jungles of Tusyam to attack the garrison in Niani. After the initial attack, the inhabitants joined up with the Mossi tribe and overthrew their Sunni Muslim masters. Niam reverted to Afro pagan. The Mossi then attempted to raise Cain in Ghana and Segu but were unsuccessful. They

ducked in the uninhabited forest of Garou. They rejoined the main army in 1340.

Maieck stood with his 31,300 knights, 21,000 soldiers and 250 catapults in Songhai. He listened to the war reports - it was all bad news. If he cannot stop the barbarians in Songhai, he might as well roll over and die. They came after the first planting in 1340. still 80,000 strong, confident as all goons could be. And they fought like devils. Maleek was not a good coach. His home team took 29,500 injuries before the Gaoti had enough sense to retreat into Gao's 50 foot wooden palisades. The Togo had suffered only 11,500 losses and were reinforced by 7500 Mossi. They wanted to passive siege but this could not be accomplished without warships. Songhai was held by the Togonads against the city. Simtah could not find a passage inside for the Fulani were now wise to his treason. Both sides waited for the final act of the conflict.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

DIPLOMACY: Asante(nt), Nupe(t), Niani(t)

Young king Kutoba and his pale really showed the Fulani. The Asante chief died in the battle of Songhal and his nation has become non-paying tributary. Simtah's bureaucratic staff escaped from Gao to become part of Togo's growing government.

THE BANTUKINGS OF KONGO

Akashua, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: Benin(a), Yaounde(nt), Nyuzu(c), Mitumba(nt), Sangbe(nt), Bandundu(nt), Likasi(nt), Mankim(c)

The Congo folk expanded Port Kachunk and Nyembo and built some public works. Akashua looked to the inland jungles for expansion. Zwellithini who had himself 'fought' the Fulani died in 1340.

THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, Immortal Ancestor of the Zimbabwe

Crane Feller, Chief Zimbabwe Royal

DIPLOMACY: none

The Zimbabwe were very sedentary. Five Twin Jackal is now 187 years old.

THE BASOKO

Mamileke

DIPLOMACY: Kimbu(nt), Mogadishu(a), Lamu(nt), Gamo-Gofa(nt)

The Basoko recovered (again) their lost territories. Trade overland with Abyssinia was secured.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Ansarto, Ras Jemo, King of Aethiopia DIPLOMACY: Atbara(f), Kordofan(f)

Honoring the new alliance with their Kordofan allies, two cities were founded. Ganeti, a Nilotic port in Kordofan. Artoli in Atbara with docks toward the Nile. Dungunab and Tobruk expanded.

CUROPE

THE AR ROCH SHELLANALE OF FEST

Ar Rod Abu'l Hashim, Governor of the Vermin Insects

DIPLOMACY: Al Hauts(t), Yemen(f)

For a nominal fee, the Chalukya were sold the technological secrets of medicine. A royal road was built connecting Oujda to Fez. Another road connected Madiera to Granada in Spain. Palma and Bani Suwayf expanded. Bunki found a saucy wench in Barcelona and sent a resignation letter to his tather, so that he could shack up with her.

CHT NORMAN REMEDOM OF SAXONIA

Edward III, King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois DIPLOMACY: none

Amid fantare and cheering in London, King Edward III announced that he'll take full control of his kingdom. The regent, Richard de Stopol, bitterly opposed the accession and he took the command of the army in Normandy. The villain gained control of Normandy, Brittany, Maine, France, Ponthieu, Flanders, Vermandois, Lorraine, Anjou, Poltou and Connaught. The King's supporters in London ensured that Strathclyde, Lothian, Northumbria, Anglia, Murcia, Weesex, Sussex, Cornwall and Dyfled remained in Saxon hands. The Almonds preserved their grain but no Saxon ships arrived to pick up the food barrels. It seems they had their own problems.

Italy

CHE RENGED & OF THEREIA

Reginald, King of Liguria DIPLOMACY: none

Reginald joined the cows and ate some grass. Some thieves stole a portion of the treasury.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Boniface VIII, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church DIPLOMACY: none

The continuing Polish coddling of Wulharrik the Butcher grated against the Papal See. In response to this, the holy pontiff issued the papal buil, 'Pro Gloria', depriving Poland participation of the Educational Trust Fund so long as Wulharrik remains free, denying absolution to any person who consorts, supports anyone who has been excommunicated, and condemning secret societies.

Without a Cathedral in Paris and with the ban of King Richard, the Vatican moved most of the University to the Cathedral of Lyon (a possession of King Edward), founding the University of the Sorbonne. In Rome, the Vatican library

has been redubbed the University of Saint John.

Elbert, King of the Danes DIPLOMACY: none

King Ekhart went 'road crazy' again building 'Reisbahnen' from München in Bavaria to the new port city Sancelade in Swabia, then to the new port city Murko in Franconia then turning east through Thuringia to link with Hamelin in Meiseen. Celebrating the glorifled event, all the workers and new scholars were given bratwurst and beer, enough to pass out with.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Volazam IV, Grand Prince of Warsew

DIPLOMACY: none

Having gotten the cold shoulder treatment from the priesthood, Prince Volazam kicked them out of his palace so that he could pray in peace. Wulharrik complained that his status quo as national hero was hollow. He remained in Moldavia, far away from Warsaw, and is treated like a leper or a demon by everyone he meets, including Volazam's couriers.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF NOVGOROD

Boris II, Prince of Novgorod DIPLOMACY: Muscovy(nt)

In Smolensk, inland from the river, Minsk was founded. It was Novgorod's 5th city. The princelet Valerus found a wife in Muscovy, a region that has long forgotten the violence done to it in past times. The heathen Kursk wouldn't hear loeip's ideas. General Feoldor died in 1340.

THE JEWISH STATE OF THE VOLGA

Salomon, Emir of Great Bolgar

DIPLOMACY: none

The new Jews remained fixed in their homeland, frozen with fear with the fear of horde activity.

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus X, Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople DIPLOMACY: Klev(f)

"Mirror, mirror," on the wall, who's the meanest, richest, toughest, most deadly emperor of them all?"

"Why you are you pretty thing."

Nicephorus smiled broadly because he like it when his reflection told him lies. But this time the lie was a truth. Sallors from Corfu reported a civil war in the Varangian Saxonia Empire. Many cities were fortified, with the dire news of nomadic migration looming. The city of Klev became an integral part of the Byzantine Empire, Polish influence and all.

THE DAR ALISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

As Sa'id, Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful DIPLOMACY: Taman(c), Fars(f), Berbera(hs)

The Caliph extended his glorious road network along the north shore of the Perstan Gulf from Khuzestan to the new city in Mand, Siraf. The lest ambassador was curious about what had happened to this Black Tower Thing. Sittia, Homs and Najat each expanded in size. The Tigris river delta area was heavily invested with almond butter and gilded pistachio shells. Old man Is'mail really angered the non-submissive Berberans. He had to escape their infamous eating man trap.

THE SHAHDOM OF PARTHIA

Arsoces III, Shah of Parthia, Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria DIPLOMACY: Kuldja(nt), Makran(fa), Yezd(n), Khvor(hs)

The Parthians cut trade with the Bolgars who had rejected Islam so rudely. Three cities expanded Bulchara, Timova and Babol Sar. The whole nation wa put on horde alert, worrying more about the Mongol than their smaller closer but still deadly cousins the Alanni. For it was the Alanni who burst over the mountain walls to raid Ferghana while Cornholls watched. But neither horde seemed interested in the riches of Persia. So Commander Funjaz was free to conquer the deadbeat Kyzl-Kum nomads with 20,000 troopers. Prince Xerxestri had trouble making deals in Yezd and Khvor.

THE CHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Omar, Sultan of Afghans DIPLOMACY none

The Afghans watched helplessly as two mighty horde trampled through their territory, eating all the grass, kicking up dirt and spoiling gardens. The uncountable Mongols were courteous enough not to attack anything on their way through Kashmir (from Yarkhand) and Pathan. But the Alanni were twice as rude, raiding Ferghana after jumping over the wall. They then ducked through Yarkhand to follow the Mongol path, raiding Pathan on their way out. Omar would love to ticket the two hordes with fines but then he would be trampled upon if he confronted them. At least they didn't sack his capital and looted his substantial treasury.

India

Mercs: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE MONGOLOID INVASION OF INDIA

Mongols, Alanni vs. anyone unfortunate to dwell in India

The Mongols, 645,500 cavalry of pure energy and the Alanni, only 278,500 riders made a secret compact to strike India between the years of 1337-1339. The Mongols arrived first, entering Jhelum in May of 1338. The Harayuk were unconquered about this for they had long been confident of their martial prowess. However, the 3000 soldiers who ruled the region feared for their lives and abandoned the region. The Mongols then headed south trampling Multan, to Sukkur. In Sukkur, the Mongol Khan, Temujin was assassinated. The Mongols fell into disarray and lacked the needed cash to support themselves. Sukkur was looted and Jats was raided. A new chief Holakshi, beat his fellow contenders and became the new Khan.

The Alanni showed up in Jhelum in 1340. They raided it as they had raided Ghorid territory. The smaller horde then entered Punjab and chased the garrison away.

THE ALANNICHARGHOST

Subatoi, Khajan of the Alans DIPLOMACY: Tuttork Horde(a)

Substoi mourned the loss of his friend Terrujin. The Alanni have decided to rest in Punjab for the winter, preparing to loot the region the following spring.

THE MONGOL KHANATE

Holakshi Khan

DIPLOMACY: none

The assassin who killed Temujin came from Chalukya. Holakshi swore revenge as soon as he can find the dough to pay off the entire horde.

THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE

Belianapala, Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunai

DIPLOMACY: no effect

Kohanpuram expanded so that trade can expand with the Orient. Maghada developed greatly to facilitate more farming. All the hordes in the area have made it difficult to manage territory. Jats, Jhelum and Sukkur have been lost. Lack of moneoon rain caused a famine along the Ganges River.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dantidurga II, The Great Muta DIPLOMACY: Malwa(c)

Much cash was spent upgrading the Mandalam to a higher technology. Water wheels and windmills were more common. People stared wearing shoes and stirrups were attached to saddles. Dantidurga was wise to the horde attack and rose lots of cavalry to counter them. Time was bought when an assassin killed the Mongol chief in Sukkur. Alchemists in the bakery have devised a new concoction, the pepperoni. It was laced with poleons designed to kill whoever ats it. Sadly much of the nation's crops were far under expectations. Without the food to feed the masses, people started dying. Tripuri, Kolyani, Goa, The Golden Portals of the Serpent Queen, Surat, Banavasi, Polonarva, Gobliquik and Nils each lost population

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Sinuma, Emperor of Manyakheta DIPLOMACY: Bhutan(f), Sikkim(fa)

Facing the Gulf of Mannar was built Farajore in Sri Lanka. Chanda's short reign ended in 1340. Sinuma was elevated to the top job. Like his predecessor, he was caught in Bhutan.

South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Krawrahta, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

DIPLOMACY: Thaton(I), Kachin(n)

Pendash and Mangtu increased in population (6 GPv and 5 GPv, respective). The merchant marine expanded exponentially. Most of the new ships had empty or half-empty holds trading with Java and Chekiang. Lamkang botched his diplomacy with the wilderness pagans of Kachin.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Hallbutimsutra, King of the Spice Islands

DIPLOMACY: Mindaneo(nt), Palawan(a)
Halibut retired his uncle Pikimsutra and accepted the full responsibilities of a Waves Chief Runan arranged an alliance with the Daimyo of Palawan. The Palawan possessed 5 warships whom had escaped the Chekiang destruction of the Amago fleet a decade or so ago, and now serve the Chimyo as privateers.

China

Mercs: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 10mew

THE DAI VIET GUO

Pang Vanyoa, Wang Dai Viet

DIPLOMACY: Kweichou(a), Kwangte(c), Miao-Ling(c), Preikuk(f)
Both gateway cities, Taili and Shau Tachi expanded to 7 gold levels each. Vandem trained more troops and died of influenza. Vanvoa who has three bickering wives is the new master.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKLANG

Quan Cladoi, Celestial King of Chekiang

DIPLOMACY: Yen(nt)

The Chekiang forces, reinforced by 45,000 more cavalry moved from Bao Ding to Houma ready to stop the Mongols at the Great Wall if they de re zigzag toward China. Reports from the steppe indicated that the Mongols had left. indeed for the first time since the turning of horses, the northern prairie has been left void of any roaming nomads.

THE CIAO CHINESE KINGDOM

Geizer

DIPLOMACY: none

The Clao mass conscripted and emptied their force pool to double the size of their cavary patrol. These joined with the imperial Cheklang army and braced for the expected attack. It did come from an unexpected quarter. The Gurvan with a wild hair thought they could conquer Ciao territory. They were wrong, 9000 Ciao horsemen died while all 125,000 Gurvan were stain. At tum's end, King Quo Yu passed away.

GURVAN ANSHAN

Khürkon-Chon

DIPLOMACY: none

Sunto was rebuilt by the Gurvan horsemen. Then Shutson Khan went whacko and attacked the Ciao with his 125,000 cavalry. The Ciao and the Cheldang had awaited for such an attack from the Mongols. Now that Mongols have gone away, the Gurvan will do just fine. 350,000 Chinese cavalry, half of them heavy lancers, half javalineers and archers rushed to defend Chilhi. Shutson was defeated most ignobly and he lost all his troops. Yen revolted and killed the Gurven goat Khan. Liaotung and Bandao also rebelled. Wheil was left: Anchan, Parhae and Koguryo remained loyal to each other and their new Gurvan King, Khurkon-Chon.

The Pacific Rim

THE AMAGOSHOGUNATE

Tenno Kuzuyu, 82nd Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu Amago Michikafu, Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan DIPLOMACY: Okinawa(nt), Hokkaido(ea), Satsunan(t)

The Amago sent their spies out to find out if the Chekiang Dragon had infiltrated them and to find out their leaders' loyalty. Kamokagi objected to this kind of scrutiny but he died from a sudden seizure.

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM

Roots that grow Deep in the Sand, Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom DIPLOMACY: none

Everyone in the islands helped out the government. There was talk wondering if too much regulation could restrict productivity and free trade. Much of that is academic now

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Sular, Sorcerer-King of the Aketta

DIPLOMACY: Pechua(nt)

Geelong increased to 6 gold value and is a gleaming beacon of civility in a wild continent. Kalik trekked up the west coast but found both Tir-ar-Dha and Eha Rana too distant, too far away from Geelong to diplomacize

THE NEW WORLD

The Grand Massif

Mercs: 10mi

COCRCAIN

Fleance

DIPLOMACY: Mohawk(n)

The Mercain moved their capital to Duncan from Katherine to get closer to Mohawk. 20,000 clovers were shipped to Chowan. By diplomacy effort Mohawk no longer hated the Mercain and were granted their freedom. Land trade was stopped with Chowan, again.

THE CHOWAN SUPREMACY

Skor, Chief of Chowan

DIPLOMACY: Creek(fa), Santee(f), Texas(ea)

Skor went up to Creek without a paddle. The Santee chief went to Caddo but was unable to diplomacize a region already friendly to someone else. Hata of Potawatomi even attacked him with 2000 braves. All the Sanlee men (1000) were killed but their chief got away and died of a spider bite in Choctaw. Ayoel

grew to 4 GPv. Trade by sea with Mercain was wisely started.

Texas was attacked by the newly formed Mescalero tribe. 2000 Cheraw were present to defend the frontier region -and 10,000 Texas. The Mescalero had 12,500 armed men. It was eventy matched. Though Chowan force had the slight edge. After years of battle, the Mescalero retreated with only 1000 mercenaries left.

THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Баскреаг

DIPLOMACY: Taposa(nt), Wenro(f), Chitimacha(a)

The Hopewell worked to expand their hold of the Mississippi Valley. There was diplomatic interference by the Chowan in Taposa but the agent was later chasticed by the Potawatomi in a skirmish in Caddo.

LAKES WYOMING OF ILLINOIS

Hawkeye

DIPLOMACY: Kansa(ea), Noquet(f)

Chicago was expanded. A port fortress was built in Quapaw, facing the Lower Great Snake.
