THE NIGER BASIN WAR

Togo vs. Fulani, lest

Kutoba had some great plans to complete the job he started and do away with the Fulani Emirate once and for all. But he would never get that chance. The tide had turned. An assassin posing as an tire salesmen managed to get shish kebobed by King Kutoba's protectors the Renegade Twinkee Patrol. While that commotion was going on, the Mossi took the Mali garrison and went back to their home territory as a free and independent place. Kutoba announced that the invasion was still on and that heartened Togo's military might.

Bromo Roach who was earmarked for an unpleasant death had escaped the clutches of the Togonad invasionary force in Songhay. He made his way into the deep forests of Garou. The wild animals thought this to be an excuse to maul him and did so wounding

the stupid insect-man. Bromo limped into Mali (returned to Fulani control) nursing many wounds. He swore that he'll never go back.

Kutoba and his forces exacted tribute from neutral Kurfei and then congregated in Kebbi meeting up with his brother Bomva and reinforcements. In 1352, the combined force now up to 10,000 heavy infantry, 48,500 light spearmen and 10,000 mercenaries attacked once again Songhay in force intending to do the same thing as before but with greater numbers to effect another passive siege. This time though, the Fulani were ready to play ball. Their 24,500 cavalry and 15,000 infantry made a brave stand in Songhay. Not used to facing opposition, morale in the Togonad camp sunk drastically. So bad it was that even the best weather conditions and the sun on their back, the Togonads were beaten by the smaller defending force. The Fulani Captain Muwakkil and all his cavalry broke easily the Togo advance and hacked down 26,000. The heathens ran off first to Kebbi and then to Nupe after Kebbi rebelled. The sad defeat in Songhai pushed the Togo frontier back to pre-war boundaries. Kutoba and Bomva regrouped in Nupe with only 25,500 soldiers. General Kokou maintained the maintenance of the 100 river warships.

THE BANTUKINGS OF KONGO

Akashua, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: Okoyo(ea), Yaounde(a), Owando(t), Sangbe(f), Ngoko(t),

Mankim(a), Lunda(ea, then neutral), Igbo(fa)

The Ba Kings of Kongo stood neutral, not involving themselves in the Nigerian bloodfest. A postal road was built from Borna to Port Kachunk. The eldest son of Akashua's beloved, late, first son, Mambele was told that he won't be next in line for kingship. His uncle Ungani was declared the helr. So Mambele was given the Vili army, he marched on Borna and demanded he be given back his birthright. After some fears of dynastic warfare, Akashua caved and allowed Mambele to keep this status as the first in line to succeed. Kongo diplomats have gathered so many commitments from the lands that the governing apparatus is strained to rule it all. Due to distance Likasi, Etosha, Lunda, Mitumba and Nyuzu rebelled.

THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Ansarto, Ras Jemo, King of Aethiopia

DIPLOMACY: no effect

The Abyssinians expanded Artoli, Ganeti, Khartum and Kusti. The chancellery allowed for the construction of many coastal fleets, consisting of government financed transports. The legend of the golden hoard was confirmed by a traveler from Baghdad who viewed the acres of treasure in a cave under heavy guard.

THE ARROCH SULTANATE OF IEST

Ibn Rod Al Makdat, Governor of the Unclean Vermin Insects DIPLOMACY: Al Hauts(f)

The lest Sultan put his weight for the collapsing Fulani against the Togo heathens. A force of 25,000 heavy camel riders and 29,500 light humpers dived deep into the southern dunes. The Roach leaders of this expedition have taxed that their trip single handlily toppled the evil Togo Empire and saved Islam. At home the road was extended from Surt in As Skirah to Benghazi in Barqa. Every city got new paved streets and walls with artistic looking pots on them. Prince Abd Allah died of canary pox.

CIVIL STRIFE IN EUROPE!

lt's Winding Down, Folks. Liguria vs. Neustria. Thaery vs. Lorraine

In a secret deal that every one later found out about, the Saxons allowed the Neustrian army to live if Beyers took them to the Russian steppe to become a horde. What King Edward didn't guarantee was that the rebels would not pass unmolested if they went the wrong way. The Neustrians strayed from the agreed to pathway and cross the Rhone to enter Provence. There, they ran smack into a prepared Ligurian legion. The Ligurians had wisely called a mass conscription and pumped up their fighting force to mighty swell. All 294,000 horsemen and rakemen were ground to vulture chow by 88,000 Piedmonte knights, 75,000 Genoan cavalry, 80,000 Florentine halberdiers and 40,000 Bologna butchers. All the Neustrians died including Beyers. Only 14,500 Italians died smiting the European devils. Just like that the doom of Europe vaporized.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF NEUSTRIA

The Neustrians didn't last long after they made peace. For whatever their purpose they have changed forever the balance of power in Europe.

THE ALMORAVIDEMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, Emir as Sevilla DIPLOMACY: no effect

All the reserve manpower of the nation were mustered into the Andalusian army expanding their army to hopefully not confront the Neustrians. The Valencia and Malta garrisons were recalled to the Emir's command and he waited in Aragon, waiting for trouble. The good word was - It's no longer a problem. In the far south, along the Senegambian coast Shimad revolted to become an adventurer. Prince Malik tried to stop him but was killed in a duel. Marwan's position in the north had nixed expansion to the south. Cities were fortified. Field forts were built.

Italy

THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Vandallo, King of Liguria

DIPLOMACY: Polesine(ea), Lepontine(n), Tortona(f), Langhe(f), Versilla(a)

King Vandallo, Minister Sangelano and Duke L'Barnertul and their army beat the Neustrians in Provence in the autumn of 1351. In the Neustrian scattered camp was found the prize, a treasure of hundreds and thousands of golden imperials. A Spoleti diplomat visited Naples and Amalfi. Another checked up on Salentina. And another surveyed Lucano. Grain was shipped to Chalukya.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Gregory IX, Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church DIPLOMACY: none

The Pope prayed for an end to the violence. Rome was given a new corp of street sweepers.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Jacapo II, Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith DIPLOMACY: Basilicata(c), Squillacia(c), Calabria(t)

Spoleto's diplomats were frustrated that Campania, Amalti, Lucano and Tarantum are friendly to Liguria's realm. But the remainder of former Taranto lands were still neutral. Prince Isaco died in 1355. Jacapo became the new master with much furface.

Eastern Europe

Mercs: 30mc, 10mi

THE REPUBLICOF STYRIA

Eugenus Von Zankel, Grand Doge of Wyst DIPLOMACY: none

With the understanding that the Polish Prince Konrad of Krakow would be the next Doge of Wyst, the Republic gained the right to control the conquered regions of Thuringia, Franconia, Bavaria and Nordgau. But none of these would stick. All except Franconia rebelled. The Prince rode in to Wyst on a white horse leading a personal army of 15,000 knights and 5000 engineers, heralded by trumpets. The Papal legate William Grenstad watched the frontier for disturbances but there was none. Pigeons have nested in the ceiling of Eugenus' bedroom, occasionally dropping eggs on him while he slept.

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Elbert, King of the Danes

DIPLOMACY: none

Prince Tobu, Generals Knats and Rujen and 115,000 soldiers left continental Saxonia and occupied Lorraine and found 150 foot tall walls surrounding Kön. They had no orders concerning this city so they held the region against it. Trade with Rayy was stopped. København and Maimo grew much larger. Public works were built in many cities.

THE UNITED DUCHIES OF LORRAINE

Albrecht

DIPLOMACY: none

The entire Lorraine army: 6000 cavalry, 3500 infantry, 25 watch towers were destroyed by the invading Danes. But the long walks of Köln kept out the bad guys. Albrecht avoided an assassination attempt.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Casimir, Grand Prince of Warsaw

DIPLOMACY: Bohemia(aw, had to be pacified again)

King Volazarn IV with over 100,000 knights tried to diplomacize Meissen, a region friendly to Lorraine and failed to get any result. With all the troops he had he could have easily pacified the region but that would have been too obvious. Volazarn's tongue grew so tired that it felf off. Volazarn then died of stone tonsils. Now Casimir has to be the Grand Prince. He is proud that his brother will soon take over Styria. Yoseph and 8000 men were killed by the Muslim Dihai norde when they tried to foment rebellion in Zaporozhie. Chernigov, Gomel, Danzig grew and were made more beautiful. The Teuton knights are guarding the treasury in Deanograd.

THE KINGDOM OF THE BALTS

Valerus, King of Baltica, Prince of Novgorod

DIPLOMACY: none

Vitebsk expanded to 3 GPv. Kama Bolgar was colonized, now, to (1/6). Valerus presided over the expansion of prosperity in the Baltic realm.

ASIA

The Middle East

Merce: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5ms

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

Nicephorus XI, Eastern Roman Emperor, Baelleus of Constantinople

DIPLOMACY: Croatia(ea)

Seven cities grew in gold value. Trade expanded. The guild system was slowly breaking down. Oats were teleported to the starving Indians. Emperor Nikephorus X is dead.

THE DAR ALISLAM - ARBILIQ GALIPHATE

Al Ma'mum, Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful

DIPLOMACY: Taman(f), Hadramunt(ea), Don(c)

The Caliphate kept with the Nikeys expanding seven cities as well. Edessa and Sarid were really cleaned up. Cilicia turned cultivated. No money was allocated to connect Adana with Antioch.

CRISIS IN PERSIA

Rayy vs. Bajjid vs. Karatou vs. Makran

Crisis in Persia? Give me a friggin' break. There is no Crisis in Persia.

THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAYY

Yuhana bin Isma'll, Shah of Rayy

DIPLOMACY: none

The Parthids allowed the start of trade with the Bajjids. A severe famine starved many people in Persia. Isfahan was reduced to 0 GPv.

THE BAJJID EMIRAT OF MERV

Suleiman, Emir of Mery, Archon of Bactria

DIPLOMACY: none

There were riots in Bactria and Samarkhand. Samarkhand's population reduced to 1 GPv.

THE KHANATE OF KARATOU

Ishfat, Khan of Karatou

DIPLOMACY: none

Funjuz died in office. His grandeon ishfat became the Khan of all the pastures. Lack of funds meant that the garrison in Kyzi-Kum was let go, so the desert region has become neutral.

THE GOD EMPTRE OF CHAH BAHAR

Arlaxeran the All Right, God Emperor of Chah Bahar, The Blazing Scepter of All Known Earth, Might Master of Makran DIPLOMACY: none

Ahuramazda fell to his long standing illness of the red spots. His not so gifted son Artaxeran has got the big boots to fill.

THE CHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Omar, Sultan of Afghans

DIPLOMACY: none

The Ghurids didn't take advantage of the continued unrest in Persia and India. They also didn't move.

India

Merce: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE MONGOLOID INVASION OF INDIA

Mongols, Alanni, Lenolik, Ekgol vs. anyone unfortunate to dwell in India & beyond

Mongol Chief Holakshi evaded assassination attempts but his son Kunai and a general Volnai were hurt by flying knives. The Mongols grazed the grass in Dravidia and kept the Chalukya forces bottled up in Kollam. The Alanni split off and began their rampage through Chalukya's hinterlands. Buhnchun's horde forced tribute from Madurai and Vengi. Kalinga remained unsubdued because the Chalukya lord Manathu defended the port city, Gunter. Rastrakuta Orissa also survived the Alanni onslaught because Sakaugampa guarded Konorak. But the little Empire lost Pundra and Kosala. The Chalukya then lost Dahala and its city Tripuri and Pawar to the Alanni tribute makers. At the end of 1355, the 'smaller' horde attacked Lata but after realizing they could not fight anyone, they withdrew to Pawar.

The Lenolik were destroyed by the Alanni as they attacked Madurai in the summer of 1351. The Akgol bravely attacked Burma, badly defended by Mavinok. Mavinok withdrew his forces to hide inside Pagan. The Akgol looted the region some and headed off into the Shan Mountains. They raided Korat, traveled over Padishan, lost a few troops and attacked in the end, Nan Chao. The Vietnamese did not foresee the danger and allowed their region and the city of Taili to be partially plundered.

THE ALANNICHARGHOST

Romghak, *Khajan of the Alans*

DIPLOMACY: none

Dutchorn the Bluedon was killed by Rastrakuta dagger throwers. Buhnchun didn't really miss him. He attacked Madurai and had to maul the Lenolik in the ordin really miss nim. He attacked waddral and had to mail the Levick in the process. The 270,000 man horde disrupted the Chalukya and the Rastrakuta Empire forcing tribute from any region left to tend for themselves. The Alanni's trip went through many wildernesses raising troop support greatly. Buhnchun periehed of hay fever and was succeeded by the strongest man - Romghak. A bull's eye was hung around his neck.

THE MONGOL KHANATE

Holakshi Khan

DIPLOMACY: none

The Mongols watched the walls of Kollam and the increasing amount of bodies they contained. Dravidia was still occupied.

THELENOLIKHORDE

Destroyed by the Alanni in Madurai.

THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE

Nagavijaha II, Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj

DIPLOMACY: none

The Harayuk expanded their cavalry patrol and defended their cities. Nagavijaha died young of bad humors and bile. The 10 year old Nagavijaha II has been crowned.

THE CHALUKYA MANDALAM

Dantidurga II, The Great Muta

DIPLOMACY: none

Dantidurga prepared for a siege or an assault but the twin hordes didn't want to play. One stayed behind to mock the Mandalam. The other split off to tear the Mandalam apart. What Dantidurga needed was a leader that can defend each and every Chalukya city. The army cooped up in the stark confines of Kollam is itching for a fight. Large amounts of grain was shipped from Byzantion and Liguria.

THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE

Sinuma, Emperor of Manyakheta

DIPLOMACY: none

The Rastrakuta lost their two wilderness hinterlands to the Alanni. Orissa was protected. Sinuma didn't move from Bhutan. He didn't know the pathway.

THE AKGOL HORDE

Totot Sutrekdi

DIPLOMACY: none

The Akgols boldly attacked Burma and lost 5500 of their 17,000 cavalry and drove the Burmese garrison inside the city. Many public works were ruped and razed. Sated a little bit, the Akgol moved on. By 1355, they reached Nan Chao. Their 9500 cavalry wasn't enough to thoroughly loot the Vietnamese region or sack the city. They conducted another raid and got all they could from the area.

South-East Asia

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Awg Sau, King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar

DIPLOMACY: none

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Halibutimeutra, King of the Spice Islands

DIPLOMACY: none

King Hallbutimsutra released the Vietnamese prisoners allowing them to count all the ships in his navy and report to their master. He made an announcement:

'As stated by my ancestor, the Javan Territorial Waters (coastal waters) are off limits to other nations' warships, violators will be detained and ships confiscated. All peaceful trade ships have protection in Javan Waters. Trade will only be stopped upon by consensus of area powers (The Enforced Indian Neutrality)

His boundless navy patrolled the Java Sea and didn't capture any other interlopers.

China

DIPLOMACY: none

In the ports of Thanglong, the Vietnamese shipwrights designed and built many high quality warships to counter a growing threat. He spoke as if to answer the shark tank guys:

The Dai Viet Guo protests the piracy and torture practiced on his high seas by the Aquarium of Java. Failure to return our warships and make amends will result in an ever increasing naval arms race which will be to the detriment of both nations

King Vanvoa stressed that he will have freedom of navigation by force, if necessary. So fixated he was to this high seas problem that he neglected to react against the pittly-equat Akgols who crossed the Padishan Mourilains and ravaged Nan Chao. Shao's vacation in Tonkin was overtly fun.

DIPLOMACY: none

The regent stayed in Michigamea and the natives at home got real uppity. Creek revolted. Catawba rebelled. Delaware uprose. Blioxi, Ayoel and Kolomoki are all isolated. Trade contacts were lost. The army eventually made it to Atakapa and Macqua came of age in Chowan.
