## ANNOUNCEMENTS

**About Building Public Works In Non-Cultivated Areas:** As stated in section [5.3.2] of the 5th Edition Rulebook, public works has a varying cost due to the terrain. As always, 1 NFP can be used in place of 2 GP when building public works.

If this cost is not made when when building your PWB, I will find a place that will match the amount of GP or NFP you committed to building a PWB.

### Rules Additions & Clarification (From Lords 1, turn 176):

#### [2.14.9] The Garrison (change)

Paragraph two, sentence two should read: "The number of units required for a successful garrison is equal to the city GPv." This matches the requirement that is expressed in [2.14.14].

#### [5.6.5] Maximum City Wall Points:

"The maximum number of total wall points (wp) that can be built on a city is limited to the Siege QR of the nation constructing the wall points. If a nation captures a city with more wall points than they could build for it, then they can keep the extra points, but if those points are destroyed by siege or assault, they cannot be rebuilt."

#### [6.1.5] Lieutenants (Addition)

A Lieutenant can also be dismissed, in effect, by granting them a province (Pacified or Friendly) or their own. In this case, the Lieutenant can be granted province becomes a Feudal Ally of the nation. Note: that the Lieutenant must be replaced by a Prince in this event. Which means, of course, that you must a Prince hanging around to promote into the Lieutenant's slot.

All these above rules are in effect now. Nations with city WP or citadel WP that exceeds their Siege QR can keep all existing WP that exceeds their listed limit.

**Color Maps:** Every turn in this game, I make a full color map of all the nations in each hemisphere. This map is on a 8 1/2 x 11 inch sheet. The Old World map includes all the regions in the Old New World and the New World map shows all the regions of the New World. Each nation is represented in its own unique color on these maps. When processing turns, I use these maps as a handy reference in determining who controls what and where. If you want to order a full color map for a particular turn, just let me know in your 'Notes' section in your orders. They cost \$3.00 each.

## LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts.

## AFRICA

### West Africa

Mercs: 10mw, 20mi

### THE AKA MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Mustafa II, Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: no effect

After years of idle time, Mustafa chose to inflict his dominance over some of the squabbling states fighting over the pieces of Togo's old empire. With an accumulated force of 38,000 infantry and ex-cavalry units (You can thank the dreaded tse-tse fly for that one), Mustafa attacked the benighted locals of Nupe. The Nupe men were bewildered. They thought their revolt from Oyo would be enough to make them pals of the Fulani. Not good enough if you're still an infidel. Mustafa then picked on Gwari for a Fulani traitor, Falei, still ruled there. Both regions' militias were easily crushed. Sympathetic local chiefs were chosen to rule the newly conquered territories as dependencies. As the Fulani army campaigned down river, Takur finally revolted because of both distance and isolation. Only Boure remains faithful west of the Niger River's source. Trade was restored with the troubled Bakongo.

### THE KINGDOM OF BORNU

Belgun Malik

DIPLOMACY: none

Belgun's son Shimbakata was killed in a bar fight. The old chief wonders if he can still sire kids. Public works was built in Bornu to improve the sorghum crop.

### THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Bakambo, Supreme Oba of Togo

DIPLOMACY: none

Bakambo suffered from a restless populace who demanded more goodies. There was a near riot in Accra, just because the young men have nothing better to do.

### THE OYO SUPREMACY

The Oyo Kingdom was unable to make the payroll of their soldiery and their government. They had to let some of them go. Many of these became mercenaries. From 1367 to 1370, Loya ruled just the regions of Oyo and Gurma. Then he died. Civil unrest swept the little country just as a blazing white fire streaked across the sky. Eventually Gurma and Oyo fell under the sway of Ungani of the Bight.

### THE KINGDOM OF THE BIGHT

Ungani, Major Oba of Benin

DIPLOMACY: Yoruba(h), Oyo(f), Gurma(f)

Early in 1368, Ungani was wounded by a poison knife cut and was bedridden for years trying to break the bug. Eventually, his former Kongo friends showed up to pay their respects. After taking Benin and Ife, King Mambele challenged Ungani for the right to hold Yoruba. It was a tough battle but the Bight-men stood firm. Perhaps Benin was lost, but Yoruba would be a better home. And with the death of Loya of Oyo, Ungani managed to finagle control over Oyo and Gurma. Meanwhile the government's collapse (Bight City was captured by the Kongo dogs), led to the mutiny of Benue's garrison. The warriors of Kwararafa and Igbo remained true, at least for now. Ungani's other son, Tjala, joined his daddy at the new capital, Leopards, and was expected to be the heir now that Nbutai is dead.

### THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Mambele, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: Kinsasha(hs), Cameia(hs)

It was a desperate effort of get very big, very soon. Mambele and his force of 5,000 mercenary swordsmen, 15,000 wood armored men, 30,000 spearmen and 3000 ditch diggers headed up north, following the rebels. The first order of

business was to pacify Benin, the capital of Ungani's rebellion. This was achieved with many a struggle. Ungani's son Nbutai was wounded then killed by the clumsy but brutal Bakongo soldiers. He was subsequently captured but it took too much time to pacify this land. In Yoruba, Ungani and his 29,000 men gave Mamebele a good fight, even though Ungani had been wounded by an assassination attempt. The Kongo king inflicted heavy damage to the rebels but was unable to get Ungani to cry 'uncle'. Somehow, Mamebele was hurt and had to withdraw from the battle. His about-to-be-victorious army had to follow him. While Mamebele nursed his wounds, the distant south became uppity. N'gao, Loangar and Cuango rebelled. Furthermore Ematlika made no friends in Kinsasha and Cameia.

### East Africa

### THE GREAT ZIMBABWE

Five Twin Jackal, *Immortal Ancestor of the Zimbabwe, Chief Zimbabwe Royal*  
DIPLOMACY: none

Five Twin Jackal was up to his old tricks, knocking over termite mounds. "They're a great source of protein," the Immortal King reminded us. He became very popular with the aardvarks. Someone (or something) broke into the treasure room and stole some of Zimbabwe's saved gold. When Five Twin was told of this he said, "Yeah, it's the no good rotten punk kids". They would be caught, he predicted, but all their ill gotten money would have been spent by then. When the fiery portent blazed across the sky, no one panicked because the venerable ancestor reported that it shows up every 77 years.

"It's will be very bright until 1986 near the time of the fourth animal."

Stickform died in 1370. The doomed Jackal Hand became the last Zimbabwean heir of the Big Burr Grog dynasty.

### THE BASOKO

Mamileke

DIPLOMACY: Mogadishu(f), Gamo-Gofa(f), Malaw(f), Sakalava(t), Tongaa(oe), Luangua(n), Ruvama(n)

All those allied leaders made Mamileke nervous. So efforts were made to get them friendly. Many allies diplomacised other allies, but most were for naught. The most critical of these, Mogadishu and Gamo-Gofa, were bought. It was too late for two of them. When the leaders of Luangua and Ruvama died, their successor called for independence. Only the Brava and Nyasa are left. After a show of strength in the south, Prince Mwuddi returned home to the Prideland where he retired. Lord Lwæbazi was the next selected to go to Sakalava. By avoiding all those natural hazards, he managed to convince the funny men there the prudence of Soko protection.

### THE ZAGWE KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Ansarto, Ras Jerno, *King of Aethiopia*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

The Abyssinian crown made it a point that organized crime was not tolerated in their kingdom. In their patrols in Soba and Tobruk, petty thieves were caught but no evidence of a cartel was found, even though the Crescent Moon mob was heavily rumored about. Manstan was told by the Darfur that a city would be required to get them friendly. Khartum and Kusti expanded. Internal trade in the Nile and Red Sea increased.

## EUROPE

### Western Europe

### THE AR ROCH SULTANATE OF IEST

Juroha, *Governor of the Unclean Vermin Insects*

DIPLOMACY: none

As Juroha oversaw the construction of public works in Sicily and a new royal road from Cairo to Sinai. The Roaches ate a lot of sugar in Iest. One of their order crawled to El Golea and found nothing interesting from the Sussudio citadel there. The Blank Roach married into the ruling family with his vows with Juroha's sister Vanda. Crime activity was on the rise with the word of a new mafia muscling in Sussudio's old territory.

### THE COUNTY OF CONNAUGHT

Dewey, *Count of Connaught*

DIPLOMACY: none

It's no longer a secret. A County thrives on the Emerald Isle. The High Count Dewey has Connaught (home), Munster (non-paying tributary) and Ulster (tributary) as his estate. Galway is the capital.

### THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

Levbert, "The Lanky", *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: Poitou(f)

Edward III's declining years were not any of note. When he died the king's mantle passed on to Levbert, his uncle. Princess Martina was married to the Duke of Poitou, a kind man with a small manor.

### THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: Senegal(fa)

Sevilla grew to 10 GPv as the noble crowd watched from their foliated balconies. In the south Mahgreb, Madas settled farmers and engineers to cultivate Senegal someday. The famous Alhambra Madrasa got more books, faculty and lecture halls. Since their university wasn't the largest (Constantinople Academy was), the lecturers are considering field athletic events to draw crowds.

### Italy

Merces: 10mhi, 10mi, 5rrw

### THE KINGDOM OF LIGURIA

Marcus, *King of Liguria*

DIPLOMACY: Eufemia(fa), Commachio(f)

The Ligurians too heard of the dark threat of the Crescent Moon. They would have to scour the country at random to spot the nest of bandits. Fortunately the church's influence was strong in Italy and that kept the bad guys away. Vandalio had gotten too fat in his old age and died of a heart attack. His younger brother, the even more obese Christof has become the regent-guardian of the six year old (and still slim) Marcus. The princess Donna Allie married the court of Commachio, Balscar, so that he would become a Dynastic Prince.

### THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Honorius III, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*

DIPLOMACY: none

In his last days, Gregory X did very little to help the plight of the poor. He was replaced by a Roman cardinal who became Honorius III.

### THE PRINCIPALITY OF SPOLETO

Jacapo II, *Prince of Spoleto, Defender of the Faith*

DIPLOMACY: none

Jacapo puttered around outdoors and grew flowers.

### Eastern Europe

Merces: 30mc, 10mi

### THE REPUBLIC OF STYRIA

Konrad Von Faustus, *Grand Doge of Trangau*

DIPLOMACY: Nordgau(fa), Bavaria(a)

Eugenus passed away as the fiery comet jinxed the heavens. Konrad from the royal house of Poland was accepted by the ruling families to become the new Grand Doge of Trangau.

### THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Elbert, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: none

Marshal Knats was asked to take out the real big FFF lodge in Stockholm. When he got there he found that the real big FFF lodge was a butcher shop that sold green sausages. After a thorough search it was determined that the intelligence report was a hoax. Since Rujen was getting too old for sea exploring (he died in 1370), he hand his rutter books to the up and coming Hanes. Hanes finished the job fully exploring the route to Greenland, land of Ice Sheets. The comet in the sky caused panic. Many killed themselves. Others disappeared.

### THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Casimir, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: none

Casimir and his army withdrew from Atelkuzo, perceiving the Dihaj has a non-aggressive horde. In the streets and gutters people died in droves. From plague? no, fright. A blazing star with a beard outshone the brightest planets and was visible even during the day. It was a sign that God was not happy with the Poles and had plans to pelt the entire nation with mothballs. Chernigov turned cultivated.

### THE KINGDOM OF THE BALTS

Rurik II, *King of Baltica, Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: Polotsk(t)

Rurik continued reclaiming lost territory by taking command of the Baltic army himself. While stopping over in Polotsk, he found a wife. Then after some blissful moment, the young king rode off to join Captain Feodor who pacified Kalinin and Starodub with his force of over 60,000.

### THE BALTIC PRINCIPATE ON THE VOLGA

Nikolai Yaskusk, *Prince of Kubishev*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Volga Balts were left alone to guard what's left of their pathetic little country. Sergei died at the young age of 46 of the flu. His just born son, Nikolai has been crowned the new king.

**THE DIHAJ HOST**

Togortak Jamali, *Mighty Servant of Allah*  
 DIPLOMACY: Khazar(f)

The Dihaj wanted to build an expensive mosque in Donets but didn't have the scratch nor the bodies to pull it off. The slaves were put in a pen in Levedia guarded by 35,000 cavalry. The rest of the horde, 75,000 guys, rode back to Rezh and attacked the poor fools, despite the fact that Rezh is pro-Dihaj. The Rezh, surprised and dismayed, were crushed easily and left pacified. Don, Levedia and Survar didn't like this behavior and rebelled. In Levedia, the rebels freed the captives from their pen and then tried to disarm (and de-horse) the garrison. The scoundrels killed 3000 cavalry but where smited most ugly. Like Rezh, Levedia fell under harsh military rules. Togartak and his men continued their warpath. Nogai had no inhabitants so it couldn't be conquered. Yayik was pacified and Atil with no walls surrendered. In Khazar, Togartak's 67,000 encountered the 46,000 cavalry Vasir Horde. After a fight 14,000 Dihaj and 33,500 Vasiri were slain. Their khan ran for his life, the Vasir survivors were absorbed into the Dihaj. Khazar became friendly henceforth. Those Vasir who remained pagan, The Chechens of Terek and the Circassians of Kuban were attacked and enslaved. Terek and Kuban are now uninhabited.

**THE DESPOTATE OF CRIMEA**

Masses of Byzantine troopers and warships converged on Crimea and demanded Cornelius' surrender. Cornelius mocked them with taunts. That got the Basileus' goat. The Byzantine Emperor threw rocks, stones, bricks, arrow, darts, iron balls, broken chains, apple cores, cats, chickens and custard pies until the 80 foot walls were converted to powder. Cornelius was captured and was shipped off to Nicepolis. New walls were built and Cherson was placed under the command of Mateus of Pytus until things returned to normal.

**ASIA****The Middle East**

**THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION**

Nicephorus XI, *Eastern Roman Emperor, Basileus of Constantinople*  
 DIPLOMACY: Croatia(f)

In exchange for the 50 GP and the chest that contained that sum, the weirdos lets Phormio go. Phormio was given a nice retirement fund and bought an isolated house in the mountains. Nicepolis, three generals and Prince Basil with 30,000 cavalry, 75,000 infantry, 2000 galleys and 250 transports crossed the Black Sea and landed at Crimea. They surrounded Cherson and forced its surrender by shattering its walls. Some 15,500 men died of dust, disease and battle wounds. The remainder turned the city and Crimea inside out but found no cultic influences. Everyone but Mateus returned to what they were doing before. Basil guarded the Lower Danube to prevent any nomadic fording. Nicephorus went back to his government functions in Thrace. Yurios and Stephanos looked for more traces of the secret cult activity. Nothing was found. Nothing odd happened. Croatia became friendly when their leader's son, Heflia Poskos, was married to the Byzantine princess Irina. The region also converted to Eastern Orthodoxy. The World's Largest university system at Constantinople expanded. Belgrad in Bosnia expanded.

**THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE**

Al Ma'mum, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*  
 DIPLOMACY: Socotra(c)

In the lands of Arbilq, seven cities expanded. Baghdad and Basra to 10 GPv. Sarid to 6. Hamadan to 5. Najaf, Samarra plus Adana to 7. Some gold points were shipped to the Harayuk idlers to keep them protected from revolutionary forces. The silk road continued to be paved, this time from Diyala to Hamadan.

Astronomers in Ma'mum's court marveled at the hairy star that dominated the night sky.

**THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAYY**

Yuhana bin Isma'il, *Shah of Rayy*  
 DIPLOMACY:

The Tabaristan became cultivated. This helps future agro outputs.

**THE BAJJID EMIRAT OF MERV**

Haskath, *Emir of Merv, Archon of Bactria*  
 DIPLOMACY: Kuhistan(f)

Perceiving no threat, the Bajjid demobilized 25,000 men to help build public works in Bactria. What units were left were divided between two armies. The regent for Emir Haskath regained Kuhistan, taking it from Chah Bahar (and suspending trade). Abu'l Kabesh with his 12,500 cavaliers crushed the defense team of 8000 yokels who guarded Gurgan. When Gurgan was pacified Abu'l Kabesh came home. A note was sent to the Ghorids of Ghazni asking for peace between Haskath and Ibrahim. Nishapur grew to 5 GPv and Bukhara got to 4 healthy levels. A Karatou army of 3000 engineers was spotted near Bukhara scoping out the neighborhood at the end of 1370.

**THE KHANATE OF KARATOU**

Ishfat, *Khan of Karatou*  
 DIPLOMACY: Soghdia(ea)

The Khanate themselves saw some urban growth: Khiva got to 3 GPv. Tashkent to 2. Ishfat remained in Soghdia to smooth out future plans. Dirgham found Bactria unresponsive to Karatou union - because they're already friendly to Bajjid.

**THE GOD EMPIRE OF CHAH BAHAR**

Wachar Pasha, *God Emperor of Chah Bahar, The Blazing Scepter of All Known Earth, Might Master of Makran*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

Artaxeran's unremarkable stewardship ended when the comet appeared. His grandson, Wachar Pasha, had new ideas he wants to test out. The Bajjid nabbing of Kuhistan was not contested.

**THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN**

Ibrahim, *Sultan of Afghans*  
 DIPLOMACY: Yarkhand(fa), Ferghana(rt), Shadad(hs), Zamindavir(n), Dasht Margo(c)

In Yarkhand, the long sacked city of Kashgar was rebuilt, given walls and public works. Ibrahim also expanded his army to counter those Indian hordes. The University got bigger too. Ibrahim's awesome administrative skill allowed him the opportunity to expand the empire. Neutral Ferghana, Zamindavir and Dasht Margo were approached. Shadad, a subsidiary of Chah Bahar, chased Mas'ud out and told him not to come back. The long bearded star was greeted with some curiosity. Some spoke of doom. Some told of boon.

**India**

**THE MONGOLOID INVASION OF INDIA**

Mongols & Alanni vs. Harayuk, Chalukya vs. Santanu

After toppling the Chalukya Empire, the Mongols became pliant and bored for they had done what they had set out to do but weren't quite ready to settle down.

"Let us ravage this Chalukya remnant. Perhaps we could cause it to implode", suggested the Alannicharg master, Cankor the Crafty.

So the 184,500 Alan tribesmen and the 392,000 Mongol horse archers rode first to Kerala. Holakshi snorted, "This is like burning a burnt out house", and then he squished the worm that told him to assault Cochinar.

Kerala was raped and, burned out again. Its earth scorched. Its soil was poisoned. Once that was done Malabar was given the same treatment. Holakshi was right it wasn't as fun the second time around. Not as many people lived in the countryside as before and wild plant growth had made the way more difficult. After the Malabar was ravaged, a northern army showed up. Its herald, a funny midget named Nagantha rode up and taunted the hordes.

"You Mongols are pansies who drink soda water. You Alanni have women with hair on their butts!"

That really riled the hordes up. The midget fled fast and the hordes followed to do damage upon the Harayuk. But the Harayuk were ready, from a concealed position some 178,000 heavy lancers and 214,500 regular cavalry and 10,000 mercenary aides and their Khan Nagavijaha charged the combined Mongol-Alan force of 576,500 light horse. The heavy cavalry patrol drove through the Mongoloids, shattering their formation. The Mongol and Alan flanks were constantly harassed even as the heavy units drove wedges. When the battle was fully committed the Mongol Khan Holakshi realized his doom, "We've been tricked. My men demand blood and will not withdraw."

Fighting against a heavy/light combination in a wilderness proved deadly to the Mongoloids. After two rounds, the Mongols once insurmountable force were wiped out. Holakshi became a civilian leader and Konai his son was killed. All that was left were the Alanni led by the persistent Cankor who wouldn't admit defeat. In the third and final engagement, the 183,000 Alanni made a charge uphill against 227,000 Harayuk horse. It was a bloody stalemate, but the numbers told the horde world who was boss. The Harayuk had gotten what they wanted and withdrew when their king Nagavijaha had been killed in battle. That, at least, was good news for the Alannicharg. Those 77,500 Alanni warriors that were let considered themselves lucky to be alive. Once they discovered the Harayuk were not coming back, they proceeded their plan as before. The Mongol tribes (all 25 of them) were absorbed by Cankor, as the Mongols had lost their balls. Karnata, Konkani and Santanu's Lata were despoiled, but without the enjoyment, just the cruelty. Some 739,000 lives were lost at or near the battle site forever known as Londa Pass. As if to accentuate the disaster, a bright comet appeared in the sky the following year.

**THE ALANNICHARG HOST**

Cankor, *Khagan of the Alans*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

In 1366, Cankor's useless son Korbakuk was wounded. Cankor didn't need him except as a body shield against Harayuk arrows at Londa Pass. The Alanni found an adequate campsite in Lata to grumble over their reversal of fortune. The 38 tribes are all clambering for a home: they want to settle down now.

**THE MONGOL KHANATE**

Without an army to back him up, Holakshi surrendered his nation to the Alannicharg. Holakshi remained active, as one of Cankor lieutenants.

**THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE**

Nagantha the Mongol Slayer, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

All the young men and infantry were trained in armor and each were given a lance and a horse. Thus the Harayuk expanded their Araik horde by 80,000 men. King Nagavijaha II had grown up in the fear of the Mongols and now, having been left alone for a generation, he could now do something about it. The entire Harayuk force was to go down south and fight the vicious hordes in Chalukya territory. The Rajah Nagavijaha was to serve personally as the battle commander with the lieutenant Nagantha as the aide d'camp. On the way, the Araik army had forced tribute from Gujarat, a possession of the hapless Santanu. Lata, the Santanu capital, could not be captured because Nagavijaha was unwilling to invest his mighty force on such a diversion as a 150 foot tall rampart. There were bigger hordes to kill.

When the Mongoloids and the Alannicharg Host were sighted near the pass of Londa, March 1368, battle was assured on Harayuk terms. After a glorious victory and much death (including the Maharaja), Nagantha led the victors back home. Since he was a war hero, Nagantha had a lot of political clout. This he used to depose Yahalapa, Nagavijaha's uncle who had temporarily taken up the office of Khan of Khans. Nagantha reorganized the palace to his own liking and presiding over the beginning of what could only be a great age of glory for the Harayuk.

**THE SANTANU DYNASTY OF SURAT**

Santan Humbow  
 DIPLOMACY: none

Humbow was thrice unlucky. The Harayuk took Gujarat away and trampled on Lata. The Alannicharg burnt Lata's fields and plundered the villages. Then the famine that had afflicted Santanu continued. Surat fell to 1 GPv. Goa is all but uninhabited, dropping to 0 GPv.

**THE CHALUKYA KINGDOM OF BAN AVASI**

Chalukya Vishuvardhana  
 DIPLOMACY: Dravidia(ri)

Unlike the Harayuks, the Chalukyas seem unwilling to pull themselves out of the ditch. The Chalukya cowered in their cities even as the Harayuk tore the hordes apart. Only one man, Prince Vishuvardhana had the courage to venture afield. He sailed by way of the Gulf of Mexico (finding a wife in Polonarva) and 'liberated' Dravidia. The Dravidians were happy to see the royal kid but weren't too impressed because he brought only 2500 men. With those troops, brave Vishuvardhana foolishly challenged 5000 local militia for control over Madurai (what ever happened to diplomacy?). He got his rear end swatted and lost all his troops. Vishuvardhana returned home and became the new Rajah because Amma died of chicken pox. Trade was allowed with Tulaka and Santanu but it wasn't highly appreciated.

**THE TULAKA RAJ OF KALINGA**

Manathuraja Tulaka  
 DIPLOMACY: none

No one bothered the Tulaka, not even the Chalukyas.

**THE RASTRAKUTA EMPIRE**

Kunara IV, *Emperor of Manyakheta*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

The sacked city of Bhagalpur was given a fortress that would defend the ruins from tourists. 50 warships were scuttled for more infantry that would guard the Bhagalpur citadel. After months of nervousness, Lombabaga had to retire, for Kunara had come of age. The departure of China from Kedah was a critical blow to Rasttrakuta merchants counting on the silk traffic to keep them busy. And cutting trade with Java only depressed the economy further. Hardly making up the slack were new sea voyages to Gihor (from Sri Lanka) and the Banavasi Chalukyas.

**South-East Asia**

Merces: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

**THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN**

Awg Sau, *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanma*  
 DIPLOMACY: Kedah(ri)

Trade was halted with Java as the Burmese broke down many transports to expand their army. Ramparts were built in Bassein and Pendaah. Public works were constructed in Burma. In 1378, the Chinese left Kedah and handed control of the outpost to Awg Sau. Awg Sau sent an army Pewe to claim the new land and Kwa as well. The Tulaka would not surrender Kwa though so Pewe left it alone. When the captain arrived at Tani, Kedah had rebelled, so he diplomacized it.

**THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA**

Bluegillimsutra, *King of the Spice Islands*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

Halibutimsutra floated around a while and then he died. His body had to be quarantened because it looked especially gruesome. The new Bluegillimsutra noticed that the elite ship captured from the Java had disappeared. Furthermore, foreign merchants hardly ever showed to trade at the Aquarium's ports.

**China**

Merces: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 10mew

**THE DAI VIET GUO**

Van Nguyen, *Wang Dai Viet*  
 DIPLOMACY: Kweichou(ri)

Perhaps expecting hair to fly, the Annamese built walls around all their coastal cities except the two in China. Leichou expanded to 3 GPv. As part of a feeling of dread, trade was cut with the Tulaka and Java. The merchants complained - Java was the richest route Vietnam had.

**THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG**

Quan Yaozhuan, *Celestial King of Chekiang*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

The fall of Chalukya spooked the Chekiang Dragon. So they gave up Kedah and let Pagan have it. This ended trade relations with Harayuk, Tulaka and Rasttrakuta. The extra transports were needed because there was a foreign crisis. It seems that the poor Nihon peoples have been deprived of the finest silks, teas and ginseng because of the cruel "ascetic oaths" of the Shimane warlord. A relief mission was assembled and was shipped off to Saga to save Japan. This was led by Lord Fuchoi (This is a different Fuchoi than the one who served in the Java campaigns) and was assisted by Quai Chang and Kue Wong. A fleet of 1000 galleon sized junks caught the 500 ship Amago fleet in the choppy waters of the Tsushima Strait. These were all sunk with the crippling of only 25 Chekiang craft. The expeditionary army (49,000 elite cavalry, 18,000 elite infantry and 150 elite catapults) encountered a force of 5000 Amago soldiers, 6000 Saga militia. These were easily swept aside so that Saga and the city of Kumamoto were forced into a pacified tributary status. Without any further reprisals, most of the troops and the navy returned back to Linan and a garrison of 30,000 elite cavalry were left behind with Kue Wong as administrator. The inhabitants were given all the Chinese goods they could buy but were put off because they were denied the products of Japanese labor. Trade with the Amago didn't begin as was promised by the occupation force. Astronomers reported that the celestial event was indeed a comet that shows up every 78 years or so. Interest in night sky watching increased.

**THE CIAO CHINESE KINGDOM**

Geizer  
 DIPLOMACY: Bao Ding(ri), Yen(a), Shantung(fa), Liaotung(ri), Bandao(ri), Anshan(ri)

Geizer with 11,500 elite heavy cavalry and 15,000 elite light horse rode overland to do battle with the Sunto king and regained their lost bureaucracy. The effort would have been in vain had not Liaotung, Bandao and Anshan allowed free passage to the Ciao Master by virtue of the quality and number of his troops. The sleepy troops of Koguryo were roused by advance scouts to fight for their lives. The 5000 heavy elite cavalry and 5000 light elite riders were overwhelmed and their morale was shattered. As the last of them were hunted down, the hated pirate-lord Puang Ching was killed. He was thrown in the sea. Sunto was sacked and the hostage lieutenants were rescued. Geizer returned back home, after having succeeded in doing something right. The Bao Ding ally died. His son degraded the region to non-paying tributary in relation to the Ciao Dynasty.

**THE KINGDOM THE SUNTO**

The sudden Ciao attack ended Sunto's history. They already were unable to support their troops. After Puang Ching's demise and the sack of Sunto, Silla rebelled. Koguryo became neutral.

**The Pacific Rim**

Merces: 10mhi, 10mi, 10mw

**THE AMAGO SHOGUNATE**

Tenno Shimei, *84th Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu*  
 Amago Kafubeji, *Boss of Shimane, Shogun of Japan*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

To fulfill a promise, a city was built in Cheju Do called Keiuto. That turned the island to Shinto. The Amago were treated to a visit by 68,505 unwelcome visitors. They stole saga and then left a garrison to protect it. To make way for them, another imperial navy was sunk. The Japanese people were distressed because the Chinese invasion was unprecedented. The Nihon islands were violated. Young Emperor Shimei was alarmed.

**THE EMPIRE OF THE STORM**

Underwater Coral, *Storm Queen, Empress of the Middle Kingdom*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

The Empire continued urban renewal in Moonbeam and Dark Skies. The Storm Queen was fascinated with the appearance of a 'striking planet'. She renamed her son, Fire Between the Fixed Stars, in its memory.

**THE AKETTA IMPERIUM**

Chetimaja, *Sorceress-Queen of the Aketta*  
 DIPLOMACY: none

Restless thugs stole a portion of the Imperium's treasury. Chetimaja did very little to stop them.

## THE NEW WORLD

### The Grand Massif

**Merca:** 10mi

#### MERCAIN

Valentine, *Elder King of the Land*

DIPLOMACY: Mohawk(a), Wyandot(f)

Brutus' effort to persuade Wyandot to become a full part of the Mercain realm was helped by the founding of Gwent, whose port faces Lake Huron. From Gwent, it was possible to trade with the Michigan ports of Lakes Wyoming. Leonard's health deteriorated in 1370 when the sky fire appeared and the chief died soon after. A brother, Valentine, succeeded in his right to control the seat of power. When he did so, he had his subject call him 'king'. The Cayuga didn't want to do that and rebelled. Others in the court grumbled but eventually gave in. A gift of ten bags of cowries came from the governing body of the Hopewell.

**Cavalry Count:** 74 years.

#### THE CHOWAN SUPREMACY

Maoqua, *Chief of Chowan*

DIPLOMACY: Caddo(nt), Catawba(ea), Timuca(fa)

Maoqua headed back to Mississippi country to reassign garrisons. While there, he secured travel rights from Caddo just recently abandoned by the Hopewell. A postal road was built from Pasquotank that connected Cheraw and Catawba to the capital.

**Cavalry Count:** 74 years.

#### THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Snow Fox

DIPLOMACY: Potawatomi(a), Calusa(c), Quapaw(f), Osage(nt)

The Hopewell sent money out and got lots more from alien tribes who crave horses. The Popocelotl and Oaxaca successfully delivered huge piles of jade, copper bits, eagle feather and sea shells of all kinds at the feet of Chief Blackbear. The Hopewell could well afford to build a new city, Nanikoke, along the Great Snake of Timuca. Just as Hopewell abandoned Caddo to the Chowan, the Wyoming gave them the right to own Osage. Blackbear and Tall Elk died within days of each other. Tall Elk's young son, Snow Fox, has become the new chief and is protected by an elder, Prairie Dog Pelt.

**Cavalry Count:** 74 years.

#### LAKES WYOMING OF ILLINOIS

Goosefoot

DIPLOMACY: Yanktonai(nt), Ottawa(t)

The colony of Missouri got pumped up to (1/2) Native Amerind. With this new land, Wyoming didn't need Quapaw nor Osage. They were passed off to Hopewell including all those stones and canoe shelters. Osage rebelled from this swap. The fire star seen in the sky made people nervous.

**Cavalry Count:** 74 years.

### The Rocky Sierra Cordillera

**Merca:** 10mi

#### MANITOWISH

Skysong

DIPLOMACY: Patwin(fa)

Sealfoot was granted a feudal fief in Yokuts so the chances that Yokuts would go friendly would be less likely. To replace Sealfoot, Prince Run Hound was given a lieutenant's commission. New sweat lodges and running water were installed in many of the northern villages.

#### THE POPOCELOTL KINGDOM

Acolnahuacatzin

DIPLOMACY: Yuma(c), Karankawa(c)

The Huachuca-Chaco postal road was completed. The one that goes to Papasukaro was worked on some more. The final installment of horse payments was delivered with great effort to Hopewell.

**Cavalry Count:** 94 years

#### OAXACA

Pichutzol, *Leader of the Quetzal World*

DIPLOMACY: Cuyutecl(f)

The Oaxaca expanded Cuyutec's city Capacha. That really helped make Cuyutec a more friendly place. Pichutzol sent more baskets of wealth to Hopewell for those god-mounts. The priests have decreed that the presence of the Hairy Planet could only mean the return of Quetzalcoatl (or the increase of toad populations). Human sacrifices must be stepped up. Trade with the Inka was halted due to the distance.

### South America

**Merca:** 15mi

#### PARAIBA

Nevix of the Cactus Bouncers

DIPLOMACY: none

Sergipe grew to 3 GPv and has more wooden statues of fish. Wadowan ruled all turn. Raboskit tried to get children born all turn. Bilstar administered all turn. All three died of the beehive plague. A new dynasty, that of the Cactus Bouncers, took over the Paraiba nation.

#### TUPINAMBA

Sizzler Toad

DIPLOMACY: Guayaki(nt)

Sizzler Toad worked on preparing his other sons to become important citizens of the Tupi nation. To maintain Tupinamba's martial tradition, Twisted Flower took the 10,500 fighters to beat up the Lengua. Lengua lost and must now pay tribute to Sizzler Toad. Twisted Flower wilted in 1370. He was only 48.

#### THE INKA EMPIRE

Coxcomb VII, *protector of many crunchy grains and nuts*

DIPLOMACY: Kuelap(nt)

Being too far away, the Oaxaca trade ended. Inka bought Mapuche grain, some of it wasn't preserved and thus it rotted on Mapuche's seafloor.

#### MAPUCHE

Cefalo

DIPLOMACY: Quillaca(ea, but it rebelled)

Casey did his level best to keep the country together. All areas except Quillaca and Guanacane were covered by Casey's command control. Wafford of Uyuni was also too far away and was not loyal. He rebelled. Uyuni went with him. Guanacane, however, stayed true. The strain killed Casey. His brother, Cefalo with slightly better administrative skill has assumed control.
