ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mistakes: Because Lords is a Human moderated game, I make mistakes. If something looks wrong, it probably is. Let me know about them. The more I know about my errors, the more likely they won't happen in the future.

Unspent NFP: Beware of your NFP is you save it from turn to turn, if they have been unspent for 3-5 turns they start rioting. If this continues they become a full blown peasant uprising.

Chancellor Leaders: If your nation is Imperial, Constitutional Monarchy or Federalized Democracy, you can replace your heir with a Chancellor (c). The Chancellor will ensure stability and continuity in the imperial court when your King or Queen is not yet of age. In some nations this leader is called the vizier, prime minister and vice-president.

This rule has been suggested by Kurt Fangmeier.

Allied Troops: Rule [5.4.8] is right on. There IS a rule about the building of allied troops. Therefore, Allied half NFP builds are allowed in Plate Games. Anyone who attempted to build these in the past 10-15 turns, let me know. There is no such thing as allied MSP, allied cities, allied fortresses, allied mega-constructs, allied public works or allied strudelwagons.

Road Count: This new stat counts how many cities are connected by royal roads. This stat affects inter-city trade. If the number is wrong, please let me know, and I'll adjust it.

Four Year Turns: After turn 60, Lords 10 will switch to 4 years per turn. This is why regional cultivation takes more turns. At that time, the full tax rate will drop to 80% and most supports will drop also to 80% as well.

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. An artillery point = 5 guns and assorted men.

West Africa

Merces: 10mw, 20mi

THE AKAMURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Sekdez, Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: Ghana(f)

No one bothered the Fulani Emir. He watched the wind breeze through the trees.

THE KINGDOM OF BORNU

Guvani of Daza

DIPLOMACY: no effect

Guvani's son Maldun found that friendly is the highest diplomatic status you can achieve. He wasted his time. The lieutenant Kerka was not very effective with the heathen wood dwellers of Mandara.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Okbewto, Supreme Oba of Togo

DIPLOMACY: Asante(a), Mossi(t)

Ihambu went over to Mossi to pick up that key region and the tribe agreed the old days meant something and sent tribute to the new Togo king Okbewto. The Tharian Danes want to see Togo boats visit Vigo in Galacia.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Mambele, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: Cuango(f), Loangar(t)

The King released Mankim and Ngoko, north interior regions. The big man also had his son Npotagui withdraw the garrison from Ite. Ite became a neutral region. The diplomatic corp went into Loangar instead. Douala became cultivated.

Five Twin Jackal, Immortal Ancestor of the Zimbabwe, Chief Zimbabwe Royal

DIPLOMACY: none

Doing away with the sham of heirs, Five Twin Jackal appointed an Advisor Chief, Smart Toast, to assist in governmental affairs.

THE TULAKA RAJ OF SAKALAVA

Vishuhapa

DIPLOMACY: none

Vishuhapa didn't really plan to improve the economy. He instead wanted literate subjects to rule. A university was established in the country of Sakalava.

THE BASOKO

Zharru the Unfortunate

DIPLOMACY: Ruvama(c), Kilwa(nt), Nyasa(t)

Zharru had much pride so much that he refused to be pushed around by Ethiopian diplomats. Just because (a) his nation wasn't Christian, (b) Basoko was a bunch of backward hicks, and (c) Basoko has no real army, doesn't mean high handed Abyssinians could blow into Mwanza and make demands that go against the sacred ways of Soko ancestors. The King headed south with his leadership to regain the lost territory. Kilwa and Nyasa were gained but Tukh, the second Mwapwa to serve Zharru, had some difficulties in Ruvama.

THE KRAKAS KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Dahangeo Krakas, King of Aethiopia

DIPLOMACY: none

The regent Izekel sent Morel against the Kusti. Morel pacified Gezira suffering no resistance. Morel came home and hoped for a smooth transition with young king Gobbu's coming of age. That wasn't possible. Izekel wanted to seize the crown himself but was stopped by Dahangeo. But Dahangeo wasn't a savior for Gobbu IV. He overthrew Gobbu's partisans and placed his own men instead. Morel swore his loyalty to the usurper. Still there were many Zagwe princes to deal with. Gobbu and his brothers plus Izekel were exterminated. Dawas and Ahab were exiled and later became court guests in Iest and Andakusia. This latest shake-up caused no ripples in the Empire. Nothing revolted. Cities expanded: Omdurman to 2, Massawa and Dongola to 3, Bur

Sudan to 4, Aseb to 5 with taller walls and Soba up to 6 GPV. The new dynasty wonders what the Basoko midgets are all worked up about.

THE PRINCIPATE OF KUSTI

The Ethiopians attacked Gezira and reabsorbed the government in Kusti. Left without money, Gauman's band dispersed, leaving Ain Farah to fend for themselves.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 10rnw

THE SULTANATE OF IEST

Ahmad

DIPLOMACY: none

The Iesti guarded their coasts against any spillover from the war in Greece. New cities were built. In Egypt was Alexandria facing only the Gulf of Cyprus (it cannot also harbor to Nile) and Malaga, a port in Granada. Iest expanded to its third level.

THE PIRATAS OF GULIO DULIO

Oskar Voncamp, *Pirate, Esquire*

DIPLOMACY: none

"Leave us alone or we'll kill you."

Oskar Voncamp with even more warships (now 700 of them) sailed to Crete expecting to take over. The native Greek authorities wouldn't even let them gain entry to the port of Candia, remembering past misdeeds. Oskar blockaded Crete for this, effectively isolating the island from the rest of Byzantium [The Styrians left Corsica be]. Amazingly enough, there were no other navies patrolling the Aegean waters.

THE COUNTY OF CONNAUGHT

Pitooy Mac Duc, *Count of Connaught*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Kelts began building boats. These were sent off to trade with Saxonia. The Papacy aided the struggling Irish with an economic grant.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF ENGLAND

Eric, *King of England*

DIPLOMACY: none

King Eric guarded his coastline in case the continental Europeans ever choose to express their hatred against them. Helston grew to 5 GPV.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

William (III) the Cavalier, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: Orleans(f)

Ten cities expanded: Tours, Toulouse, Barcelona, Bruges, Paris, Sete, Cologne, Vienne, Rouen and Soissons. William III's lousy administrative skills were not good enough to hold the Spanish possessions. The southerners were loyal enough and remain friendly to the Saxon monarch. It took a lot of sweet talk to wrap up the Orleans.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Almoravids tensed for invasion in case the Christians were to vent their frustrations on them.

THE DUCHY OF BURGUNDY

Titus di Haas

DIPLOMACY: none

The Duke has already made plans to take over former Styrian territories.

THE LIGURIAN KINGDOM OF ITALY

Marcus, *Rex Lagobardum*

DIPLOMACY: none

Small change was shipped to the Ethiopians and Iestians for their presence in the Nile was an affront to them. Aswana grew to 3 GPV and merchant ships were encouraged to increase trade out of there. Closer to home, more people lived in cities. Marseilles, Pescara, Livorno and Venezia were pumped up each to 4 GPV. A postal road was dug out connecting Genoa to Bologna. One of Liguria's transport fleets began to trade with the Rajetaluds of Asia.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Benedict X, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Papal See made a final push to convert the Byzantine Church. Unfortunately for Catholics in the area, the Pope didn't support the existing Greek communities in his bid to convert every one else. With an Orthodox backlash,

this failure led to a total and complete reversal of Papal ambitions in Constantinople. The new Psechulen Dynasty drove the Catholics out of their country even to the point of shutting down the monasteries of Temesvar and Wallachia. Considering the new hostile environment, Benedict X canceled his trip to Constantinople. Efforts to crush this 400 year old heresy went no where. So was the attempt to gain the 'Gospel of Saul'. This heterodox document disappeared when the Nikephoroi were overthrown.

At least Reichenbach completed some of his tasks building abbeys in Friesland and Banat. One in Connaught was lost lacking supporting monasteries in Brittany or Cornwall. Crete was a lost cause due to its Orthodox faith. The Dulio Pirates didn't help things much. Economic development fund moneys were sent to Ireland and Baltica. Educational funds matched investments in Thery, Baltica and Styrian universities. A bishop came back home to Rome as a result of the latest unrest in Styria.

Eastern Europe

Mercs: 30mc, 10mi

THE REPUBLIC OF STYRIA

Rolto Untero, *Grand Doge of Trangau*

DIPLOMACY: Thuringia(ea, but rebelled), Bavaria(ea, rebelled had to be attacked to pay tribute)

New cities built aiding otherwise lackluster diplomacies. Munich in Bavaria was rebuilt along the royal road. Murke was founded along the Elbe crossing in Thuringia. In 1395, Othello died in Thuringia. His son Titus was a clever conniver who had many enemies. Among them were two other oligarchic families, the Untero and the Charofsi (The Faustus family have been rendered unimportant). The Untero candidate made a deal with the Charofsi and threw out Titus di Haas. Titus escaped in Burgundy and set himself as Duke in Lelander. Kawelt Parur remained loyal to the new Doge and with 8500 heavy cavalry forced tribute from the rebellious Bavarians. Alsace, Swabia and Thuringia revolted from the mess and Titus carved out Burgundy and Champagne for his own personal fiefdom. The Untero still own Austria, Bakony, Bavaria, Carinthia, Croatia, Dalmatia, Franconia, pacified Hesse, Illyria, Meissen, Nordgau, Podravina, Slovakia, Slovenia, Switzerland and Tyrol.

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Romer III, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: Hordaland(nt)

The Danes girded their navies from seaborne invasion. That world-wide anti-Thaerian coalition has yet to strike. Hordaland, that ever lovable non-Christian land, has agreed to pay homage to the man with the golden hat. While Poltava grew, a new city, Bremen, was built in Saxony next to the North Sea. A gift of 50,000 marks propped up the needy Baltic economy.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Dmitry, *Grand Prince of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: none

King Casimir died of bladder stones in 1395. He was sixty one years old. His affable son, Dmitry, became the new Great Prince with nary a snag. Mister Flowerpot brought his circus to Warsaw. It featured horseback trapeze artists and a real live bear.

THE KINGDOM OF THE BALTS

Vladimir, *King of Baltica, Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: Veposkava(f), Viatka(ea)

The struggling Baltic economy was assisted by the Church and the Danes. Kirvich's public works were improved and a new sparkly, clean city, Lagoda, was laid down next to Lake Lagoda (where else?). Veposkava appreciated the effort and regale King Vladimir with celery stalks. Boris Tchulna reigned the fur trade, baby.

THE BALTIC PRINCIPATE ON THE VOLGA

Nikolai Yaskusk, *Prince of Kubishev*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Volga Balts began their world conquest plan by laying claim to the entire Siberian Taiga. Nikolai hired all 20,000 mercenaries and attacked Muslim Suvar. The Suvari accepted defeat and allowed to rule themselves a while pining for Dihaj intervention. Nikolai went back to the cozy bedchamber to perform the necessary measures to ensure a proper bloodline. So far only girls. Furline Pelym was colonized to (0/9) Roman Catholic.

THE DIHAJ HOST

Tagaktu, *Mighty Servant of Allah*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

While more was put into the city under construction in Khazar, Tagaktu harassed the Crimeans. It turns out Crimea is now the homeland of the Psechulen Dynasty and that the Dihaj weren't exactly welcome. But what could the Romans do to evict them? Tagaktu's horses found the grass very green in Crimea.

ASIA

The Middle East

Mercs: 10mhc, 10mc, 10mhi, 10mi, 5mrs

JIHAD AGAINST BYZANTION (1379-1395+)

Abydus Comnenii vs. Byzantine Cherson vs. Rahjetalud, Islam, Dihaj?

The Two Muslim armies that conquered Asia, withdrew leaving garrison detachments in Optimaton and Paphlagonia. Since these regions were already under Rahjetalud control, the Caliph troops set up their own camps away from population centers. In 1393, an Arbiliqi navy led by Kabogha blockaded Nicosea. He was joined by Bin Ardan who with 26,000 infantry invaded Cyprus and assaulted Nicosea, taking it at the end of 1394. Cyprus and its city was militarily converted to Sunni Islam in 1395.

The Greek speaking Empires made no counterstrike against Muslim positions, being preoccupied in civil and religious strife. Crete was isolated by Dulio Pirates. The Rahjetaluds were inactive due to a lack of initiative by their ruler, Mohammad.

THE NIKEPHORIAN EMPIRE OF BYZANTION

The last Nikephorian Emperor, Michael VIII, unleashed a tempest when the 14 year old announced that he would be Roman Catholic. This switch did not endear him to his own subject and his court was divided. Some thought the Constantinople Patriarch had been shafted. They wanted the Comnenii to save them. Michael was arrested by his best general Thadius Kovich. The Chancellor Mark Phadilon was killed. In Crimea, Demetrios Psechulen expelled Matus Onkron and called for an Eastern Orthodox Empire with its capital in Cherson. This idea was supported by Thadius in Constantinople who then went on to suppress Catholic uprisings in Thrace, Wallachia and Temesvar. Eventually with new troops the Psechulen gained the upper hand controlling all Nikephorian regions except Epirus. Without any measure of support, Michael VIII, was induced to take his own life by swallowing a poison pill.

THE PSECHULEN ROMAN EMPIRE

Demetrios Psechulen, *Imperator Romanus Orientalis, Despot of Crimea*
DIPLOMACY: none

For purposes of safety, Emperor Demetrios moved the Byzantine government from Constantinople to Cherson. His army of 40,000 legionnaires now stationed in Cherson wondered if the 54,000 Dihaj will ever leave Crimea.

"It would be a shame if we have to fight them instead of the Abydus."

Crete was blockaded by the infamous Dulio Piratas, whose fleet it was said exceeded that of the Psechulen, or the Rahjetaluds.

THE EMPIRE OF ABYDUS

Stephanos Comnenus, *Imperator Romanus Orientalis*
DIPLOMACY: none

The Comnenii were unsure whether to liberate their lost Asian territories or attack Constantinople. Stuck in a quandary, they did neither.

THE JIHADINE NAVY OF EL RAHJETAKU

Mohammad
DIPLOMACY: none

Mohammad fretted with the entry of the Dulio pirates in the Aegean. What if they turned on him. Otherwise the waters were still.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

Aj Mutawakkil II, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*
DIPLOMACY: none

All the cities (except Hamadan) expanded. If there were walls surrounding the urbanities, those were knocked down. The exception was Niksar whose ramparts were improved. Neutral Cyprus (with Nicosea) was attacked and placed under military conversion. This was accomplished with the help of the 540 ship navy of the Caliphate built to replace those the Rahjetalud took away.

THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAYY - Yuhana Faction

Yuhana bin Isma'il, "The Conqueror", *Shah of Rayy*
DIPLOMACY: Uzbek(nt)

So long as Yuhana drew breathe, he would fight his enemies in Central Asia. He demobilized his field forts and idle transports to draft new infantry. Yuhana needed these to switch with cavalry garrisons so his patrol could get the numbers. Yuhana's untrustworthy son, Batin, was given the job of hiring the mercenaries and marching the army to Soghdia. By the end of 1392, Yuhana gained an army of 29,000 mountain horsemen plus 22,500 mercenaries (They weren't needed further west). Those were more than enough men to attack (to make tribute paying) Khokhand, Karatou (had to be pacified), Kyzl-Kum and Khwarzim. At the end of 1395, Yuhana made it back to Bactria just in time to find out his own flesh and blood had rebelled. The twerp took all the friendly regions and left his own father with Bactria, Gurgan, Jowzjarian, Soghdia, Uzbek, Khokhand, Karatou, Kyzl-Kum, Khwarzim and Uzbek.

THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAYY - Batin Faction

Batin el Partah, *Shah of Rayy*
DIPLOMACY: none

Batin was tired of being a chose boy for his vainglorious dad. So in 1393, he took over the government in Kumis and greedily scarfed up Tabaristan, Daylam,

Zagros, Arran, Georgia, Dasht Kavir, Khurasan and Kumis (of course). Batin must know something his father doesn't because he thinks he can win.

THE KHANATE OF KARATOU

The Karatou Khanate ended when the Parthids invaded. Of the regions that Karatou once had only Bogazgol was left unconquered, and they went neutral. The Karatou treasury was confiscated by Yuhana who surely now needs it to fight his son.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Abbas Ughat, *Sultan of Afghans*
DIPLOMACY: Khuttal(nt), Tukharistan(nt)

This time, an army accompanied the tribes in the quest to settle those (now) hostile desert regions. So when Abdul showed up in Dasht Margo, he was attacked by the 8000 inhabitants. The Dasht Margo were well led but were outnumbered this time. The 2500 heavy cavalry, 7500 light horsemen and 12,500 infantry absorbed the assault suffering 500 casualties and pacified Dasht Margo long enough to ensure its colonization to a (1/7) Sunni Muslim region with an unhappy Shi'ite minority. Shadad too was colonized (its native resistance was defeated at the cost of 1500 more lives). The popular Sultan Ibrahim died in 1395. He helped rebound Ghor from the ravages of the Black Death with wise economic planning and good governing skills. A new dynasty took over led by the captain of Ibrahim's personal guard Abbas Ughat.

India

Mercs: 10mwe, 10mhc, 10mc, 10mi, 5ms

THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRE

Rupika Isanavara, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*
DIPLOMACY: no effect

The urban spaces, Goa, Multan and Khairpur attracted new inhabitants. Charukapa was frustrated by the presence of a Shagunga patrol who neutralized his diplomatic entreaties. Sakandavara's death in 1395 meant a new round of dynastic ugliness. Sakandavara had no children and his only brother Bhojapala was eaten by a crocodile, the year before. Charukapa refused the top job, six Rajput families fought each other to rule the whole pancake. After some months of chaos, the leader with the best charisma beat all the others. Nothing revolted in the meantime, not even the Sanhaja. Isanavara Rupika, the new Khan doesn't have a good administration rating. So less taxes were collected.

THE CHALUKYA KINGDOM OF BANAVASI

Chalukya Saivehesa
DIPLOMACY: Andhra(nt)

Saivehesa discovered some virtue to being small. The cost of societal transformation was cheaper for instance. Chela finally rebelled (now I don't have to roll those dice anymore).

THE SHAGUNGA EMPIRE

Dhruva Shagunga, *Emperor of Konorak*
DIPLOMACY: Kosala(n)

Sakakulula and the Kosala went to Maghada to make new friends. The prince there was indecisive because he had to choose between the Harayuk and Shagunga. They chose to go neither way. The Kosala ally died and his region became independent. Trade with Ghor was set up from Farajore. King Derajtra died in 1395.

South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 5mc, 10mhi, 20mi, 10mw

THE KINGDOM OF PAGAN

Taninganwe Umon *King of Pagan, Maharaja Myanmar*
DIPLOMACY: none

The Burmese people are getting testy over Taninganwe's inaction.

CRISIS IN INDONESIA (1385-1395+)

Chekiang, Vietnam, Makassar, Bengkulu vs. Java

1385 to 1390

It started with a civil war. Bengkulu incited a rebellion in Sumatra and appealed to Chekiang for help. The Chekiang navy and the famous general Quai Chang answered the call with an elite navy and took on the Java fleet at Tanjung Jubung (a Jambi peninsula). The Chinese lost and withdrew back to China. The Bengkulu rebellion was all but crushed. Only Bengkulu's homeland was left defiant. Everything else rejoined Java. The enemies of Java felt cheated. They had long wanted Java to be sunk and made new plans that would leave Bengkulu out of the loop.

1391

Long Joe Mo, King of Java, moved from Perak to Lampung where naval reinforcements awaited. In June, 9500 Bengkulu raiders were detected trying to evade into Jambi. Long Joe's army of 19,000 mixed warriors of 2100 catapults crushed them utterly. In the carnage, 41 strings of silver were recovered. The leader of Bengkulu No-Snakes-Here was captured in battle and executed. Those that replaced him sued for peace. But Java's troubles were only beginning.

1392

Quai Chang left Linan with new ships and a desire for revenge. He made a port of call in Thanglong in the summer and was joined by Vietnamese ships led by Monsoon

Mau, Viceroy of Makassar, a newly created nation dedicated to replacing Java. As a group they sailed south to fight the Java navy one more time.
1393

The Chinese Makassar fleet spotted the Java fleet in the Palembang River estuary in Lampung. Efforts to draw them out to the open sea was futile. Long Joe Mo guarded the river approach to Srivijaya and kept his countless ships together despite threats and taunts and a feigned retreat. When 50 decoy ships sailed into the estuary at night, they were ignored until the flotilla was set afire. The Java navy scrambled to get out of their way but 50 Java ships were lost because they could not evade the fire ships fast enough. Those ships that didn't sink were boarded the following day, no one was aboard. Finally the Chinese-Makassar lost their patience and in July they landed troops in Jambi. Long Joe wouldn't let that happen. His navy responded against them right into a trap.

In the sea battle of Apullango, off the coast of a swamp, the 1595 Java warships attacked 1115 Chinese elite chuanbo, 110 Makassar elite chuanbo, 435 Makassar storm galleys. The terrain was to the invaders benefit. The catapults couldn't get into the swamp soon enough to bombard Aquarium enemies. The Chinese erased all their supply negatives by garnering Vietnamese support. Now the better leadership, training and higher morale told the story. The Javanese were routed, 1025 Aquarium ships were sunk or rendered inoperative, 50 were captured. The Makassar lost only 240 galleys. With victory in sight, Quai Chang and Monsoon Mau pursued Long Joe Mo to the Palembang River and attacked again in sight of Srivijaya. All the rest of the Java's navy was crushed but in the hail of stones of arrows, the Makassar lost 180 more boats. The Vietnamese observer, Lo Far, had enough of this and left. He was never seen again. The Java captain Kettle Krong was captured. Quai Chang sailed right up to Srivijaya's docks and declared victory shooting fireworks into the sky. The populace shivered in terror while Long Joe Mo braced for a landing.
1394

In May led by Monsoon Mau, 10,000 elite heavy cavalry, 10,000 elite light cavalry and 13,000 Chinese and Vietnamese marines rushed Srivijaya's harbor in an effort to take the city.
