ANNOUNCEMENTS

Four Year Turn, In Effect Right Now: Lords 10 is now switching to 4 years per turn. The full tax rate drops to 80%. Troop Support, Government Support and Project Support also drops to 80%. Intel Support & Religion Support remains as before; this is because they are now being used once every four years instead of once every five years.

Saved Gold and NFP: If the Saved section (at the bottom of the Order Form) is left blank, I'm going to assume that you are saving 0 NFP and 0 GP. I warn you now.

Protectorate (pt) Regions: Just because Pacified-Tributary regions are henceforth called Protectorate regions with the control code of 'pt'. They are created upon the action of the Attack to Make Tributary (AT) action (Please note that Attack to Pacify's code is (A)). If left alone, Protectorate regions may eventually become Tributary. If Diplomacized, Protectorate regions are likely to revolt. Protectorates are the most likely to rebel or switch sides in a war. Protectorates do not require garrisons. Garrisons are most vulnerable in Protectorate regions.

Moving Leaders Overseas: A leader doesn't need ship units to move overseas. A leader can move anywhere overland, overseas without any kind of military units. Indeed, assigning naval units to a leader, slows down the leader.

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. An artillery point = 5 guns and assorted men.

West Africa

Merces: 20mi

THE AKA'MURRID EMIRATE OF FULANI

Seldez, Emir of the Fulani

DIPLOMACY: Kanuri(ri), Kebbi(fa), Kurfe(fa), Segu(a)

The Emir was pleased to hear of the construction of D'Jenne upon the ruins of the old city in Segu. It was another stop along the Sahel Road. A significant part of Hausa have become Sunni Muslim.

THE KINGDOM OF BORNU

Maldon

DIPLOMACY: none

Guvani died in 1400. His son succeeded him.

THE SUPREMACY OF TOGO

Okbewto, Supreme Oba of Togo

DIPLOMACY: Asante(f), Mossi(a)

Trade was attempted with the Thaeians but the Vigo port was 2 sea zones too distant. The Togo merchants weren't told that by the Danes. The chief of the Asante, Wuhuci has married Okbewto's sister Igno.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Npotalgui, King of Ba-Congo

DIPLOMACY: Igbo(fa), Ite(ri)

The Kongo Prince who would soon be king gathered a force of 21,000 spearmen and 10,000 wandering swordsmen. His plan was simple: empty the inland population of Okoyo and Yaounde and force them to live in a new city in Teke. In 1397, Npotalgui's forces attacked Okoyo and enslaved its population. The populace resisted this - 2500 Kongo soldiers died in the round up. They were moved to a pen along the coast of Teke and were told they would become the inhabitants of a new city. The following year, Npotalgui's army invaded Yaounde and defeated its local army, 3500 Kongo were slain in battle. All the villagers were roped together and were marched over mountains to join the other captives. Upon his return to Teke Npotalgui discovered that the Okoyo had escaped the pen. The gold that would have been used to build the city was lost. Mambele died in 1400 making a fuming Npotalgui the Ba King.

Five Twin Jackal, Immortal Ancestor of the Zimbabwe, Chief Zimbabwe Royal

DIPLOMACY: none

The Jews wondered what the Basoko were doing on their borderland.

THE TULAKA RAJ OF SAKALAVA

Vishuhapa

DIPLOMACY: none

Vishuhapa did a little building in Sakalava then he died.

THE BECDBA NATION

Kankarunka, Fortune Smiles Upon He

DIPLOMACY: none

Late in 1400 a transient band entered Tongaa. Kankarunka had heard that they were loaded with riches and jewelry but were unwilling to share it. So the wanderers were attacked by the Bemba chief's 6000 men. All were slain - none were allowed to escape. Kankarunka found in the ox carts of the wanderers, a treasure beyond his wildest dreams.

"Now I can build my dream castle."

So an obscure tribe in the Zambian highlands can play with the big boys. No one dared to mess with Kankarunka for his reputation as a warrior was already established.

THE BASOKO

Zharu recruited 2500 soldiers and turned them on his own capital city - sacking Mwanza in the fall of 1396. The Soko people were shocked and horrified. Zharu blamed it all on the Ethiopians, pointing his sword at his subjects, taking the treasure south. Ankolye, Kimbu, Lamu, Malawi and Mombassa rebelled. Gamo-Gofa, Buganda and Mogadishu were granted their independence. Because of a government collapse, Tukh took his 4500 infantry to Brava and became its lord. What was left had to fend for themselves.

Zharu's following had a run in with the Kimbu but evaded them at the cost of 1500 followers (7000 were left alive, including the armed men). The Soko were granted sanctuary in Nyasa thanks in part to the silver tongue of Mitwaba. Late in 1397 word did arrive of an Aethiopian invasion force in Gamo-Gofa. Soon the Copts would march on his former homeland, it was time for Zharu to fly further into the wilderness.

Rumors spread faster than foot traffic and all the villages knew of the Soko wanderers and their golden hoard. To the lucky chief who could catch them

would be won a big prize. The Malawi tried first scaring away 2500 but Zharu escaped them. The Luangua killed Zharu and the remaining 2000 non-fighting men. Mitwaba and 1500 spearmen escaped to Tongaa enduring a gauntlet of flying arrows. But Tongaa was not a safe haven. The Tongaa finished off Mitwaba and his weary men and too the treasure himself. With nothing left, the Basoko faded into history.

THE KRAKASKINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Dahangeo Krakas, Ben Unis, *King of Aethiopia*

DIPLOMACY: Ain Farah(c)

The new Ethiopian King finally decided on the Soko question:

"After suffering intolerable insults of accusations of theft and betrayal of an ally, we have no choice but to declare war on Basoko. We have no quarrel with the people of the region only the Basoko rulers."

In command of 15,000 bucklers and 15,000 marksmen were placed Generals Karped and Tuwasef. They marched from Meroe south by road into barbarian Kefa. Without securing a supply road, the army attacked the newly independent Gamo-Gofa. The Amharans possessed the technical skill to overcome their supply problems and place a protectorate government in Gamo-Gofa after defeating the locals in battle. This whole process took the good part of a year. Late in 1398, the Abyssinians forced protectorate rule against the Buganda. The supply problems got worse, morale even dropped, but the Abyssinians had the power to knock down their opponent. Finally in the spring of 1400, The Kilkuu jungles were assailed. The Basoko land hadn't really much of a chance, being poorly led against an invigorated Coptic army. A protectorate was clamped on them and Karped's march to an end. Karped died of insect bit leaving Tuwasef and 28,000 soldiers to sweat under a tropical sun. The soldiers are threatening mutiny if a supply line isn't secured soon. That means Kefa or Funj must be controlled by the Lion -or- at least 15 GP has to be sent south - by the end of 1401. A small gratuity was received from Ligurian messengers, adding a few coins to Dahangeo's golden vaults.

EUROPE

Western Europe

THE SULTANATE OF IEST

Ahmad

DIPLOMACY: none

Talinuh and the vizier Holus responded to the Straits of Messina when they found out that the Dulio Duke had fled through there in the aftermath of the Battle of Kolpos Kissamau. When the Iesti navy of some 755 warships (including 50 privateers) arrived, Oskar had given them the slip. They returned home to grumble over their failure. Iest got its 4th population level. Benghazi was built in Barqa as a port city.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF THE ISLES

Oskar Vancamp, *Pirate, Esquire*

DIPLOMACY: none

Oskar and Ermanno remaining at Crete lacking the navigation books for the Mediterranean (someone must have thrown the rufflers overboard). In August of 1396, the navies of the Caliph and the Rajhetalud bottled the Dulio ships in the Kolpos Kissamau. Oskar still had his 700 galleys but the Saracens possessed three times their number. Within hours, the entire Dulio fleet were trashed or sunk and Oskar Vancamp escaped through an opening made by his ill-fated ships. The Duke fled by way of the Ionian and Tyrrhenian Seas to his only island, Corsica, where he became a prince. His son, Ermanno couldn't join him, he died along the cliffs of Crete.

THE COUNTY OF CONNAUGHT

Pitooey Mac Duc, *Count of Connaught*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Irish noticed the appearance of Danish ships off their coast. The Pope sent money to Galway in support of this tiny country.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF ENGLAND

Eric, *King of England*

DIPLOMACY: none

Since Thaeary wouldn't trade perhaps a little bit of piracy would get their attention. The fleet of 500 war ships entered the English Channel. Much gold was stolen mostly from Moorish and Danish trade ships. Trade with the Andalusians began but they really weren't enthusiastic now that they are trading with pirates. A famine really ruined everyone's day.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

William (III) the Cavalier, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*

DIPLOMACY: no effect

The Saxons figured they could win Cherbourg peacefully but the city wouldn't hear of it. Tours, Toulouse, Bruges and Cologne grew to 6 levels of habitation. Sete in 7 GPv. Barcelona is up to 8.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, *Emir as Sevilla*

DIPLOMACY: none

The 107 year old Emir wonders how he should deal with the English buccaneers whom had reduced Almoravid trade with Thaeary. The populace was getting real restless, on the verge of vandalism.

THE DUCHY OF BURGUNDY

Titus was killed in late winter 1396. The Burgundians were thus easy pushovers when the Styrian army attacked.

THE LIGURIAN KINGDOM OF ITALY

Marcus, *Rex Lagobardum*

DIPLOMACY: Atelkuzo(hs)

The Italians built up a navy themselves (660 warships, 100 lanteens). These plus 25,000 infantry and 14,000 cavalry headed off to the Black Sea. The plan was to conquer Özu, kill all the Eastern Orthodox native and settle in their place, building a city to trade with Russia. Marcus was ignorant of his history, only 80 years before the Polish Excommunicate, Wulharik the Younger genocided the Christian Moldavians. Now all the Orthodox steppe dwellers were wary of the Catholics.

Özu was conquered easily enough when Marcus and company landed. While Erbeito prepared to colonize the region and build a city with the 24,500 infantry, Marcus and Mahoni with their 18,000 cavalry sharpened their swords for human slaughter. In outrage Özu rose up against the Italians and were joined by the Levedia nomads. The two sides fought to a stalemate but Mahoni was killed. It was clear, that even if they beat the Orthodox nomads, the Ligurians would not have enough men to perform the genocide. Now the Levedians showed up to deal with the 11,500 Italian cavalry and 24,500 already disarmed infantry. The nomads waited upon Marcus as he and his throng fled to the shore. 7500 would be settlers were killed and the rest were screened for withdrawal. Marcus, Erbeito and Li Hezzi fled back to Liguria, tail behind their legs.

Back at home, Prince Orazio came of age. The postal road from Bologna to Genoa because a regal road. Payment of 4000 ducats were sent to Abyssinia and Mahidia.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Benedict X, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*

DIPLOMACY: none

Benedict X was severely displeased with King Marcus' attempt to mass murder Christians. It was fortunate that the effort came to disaster. Cardinal Drieti went to Crete and were met with the Dulio chief Oskar. He would have begun the process of converting the island but was preempted by the Caliph's forces who landed troops on the mountainous islands and sword pointed the Greeks to Islam. Drieti returned to Rome to consult the Pope.

Abbeys were built in Riga, Galway (now that Helston's upgraded), Kaluga, and Gomel. The abbeys in Latium, Verona, Nordgau, Bohemia and Helston became monasteries. A cathedral was consecrated in Lausatia. Roma grew to 9 GPv. Baked bread was delivered to the Holy See from Liguria but the Church Custom offices didn't want it.

Eastern Europe

THE REPUBLIC OF STYRIA

Rolto Untero, *Grand Duke of Trangau*

DIPLOMACY: Swabia(t)

The Styrians with the force of 18,500 mounted and 16,500 unmounted soldiers and the local mercenaries attacked Alsace and made them a protectorate. Rolto and his trusted lieutenant Kawell Parur took back Champagne before occupying Burgundy, seizing Titus' navy. The Pope matched Styria's university investment.

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Brant, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Thaearian navy wasn't around to stop the pirate activities of England in the English Channel. Romer III sent 50,000 marks to the Balts and built a new city in Halland, a port called Gateborg. The Collegium improvements were matched by the Papacy. Romer III died of breathing problems in 1400 so now his son is the main man.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Kelsida, *Great Princess of Warsaw*

DIPLOMACY: Prussia(c)

Work began on a royal road from Warsaw to Sandomir. Dmitry's death led to the ascension of Princess Kelsida. Shupert couldn't diplomacise Starodub - it was pacified by the Balts. Many cities were scrubbed up.

THE KINGDOM OF THE BALTS

Vladimir, *King of Baltica, Prince of Novgorod*

DIPLOMACY: none

Both Pope and Dane sent cash. Vladimir fell asleep.

THE BALTIC PRINCIPATE ON THE VOLGANikolai Yaskusk, *Prince of Kubishev*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Volgabs also fell under the spell of Orpheus.

THE DIHAJ HOSTTagaktu, *Mighty Servant of Allah*

DIPLOMACY: Urkel(a), Taman(a)

The Dihaj departed Crimea before the Psechulens got tired of looking at them. The city in Khazar, Togortak, was completed. Seafarers from the North Caspian Sea have a port to rest their sealegs. Tagaktu found that diplomacy is irrelevant in pacified regions (will they ever learn?) so this troops ambled to Urkel and stayed there for the land wasn't friendly yet.

ASIA**The Middle East**

IHAD AGAINST BYZANTION (1379-1400)

Last Entry

Islam and the Rahjetahud satisfied the requirements of the Jihad by militarily converting Crete, Optimaton, Paphlagonia and other Greek lands. The Abydus could not object for they were pre-occupied with the Crimeans.

THE PSECHULEN ROMAN EMPIREDemetrios Psechulen, *Imperator Romanus Orientalis, Despot of Crimea*

DIPLOMACY: Özu(f), Aetkuzo(f)

All the Psechulen had after Abydus and Islam's activities was Crimea and Kiev. Because of Liguria's botched invasion, both Özu and Aetkuzo joined up as friends. Now if these steppes are attacked, they have to deal with Imperial forces. The Despot is reconsidering his anti-Catholic stance.

THE EMPIRE OF ABYDUSStephanos Comnenus, *Imperator Romanus Orientalis*

DIPLOMACY: Rhodes(t), Serbia(nt)

The Emperor revived his war effort splitting his armies into three. First Bulgaria was pacified then the Emperor jumped all over Ludgorie and captured Adrianople while Maurice Glykdas advanced to Bosnia. At home, Theopilos guarded Macedon while the others campaigned. Maurice had trouble assaulting city walls for his leadership was mediocre. He lost many men taking the fortress city of Belgrad in Bosnia and was killed when his army assaulted Ariana in Temesvar. Theopilos took his place completing the late Maurice's job by easily taking the city of Bucharest. Meanwhile, Stephanos had it easy taking Varna. The fortress of Constantinople was supposed to be his only challenge. Somebody had opened the city gates though and let the Comnenii in (to everyone's surprise). So Constantinople's University and the sprawling sanctuary of Sante Sophia became Abydus property. All regions that were conquered: Bulgaria, Bosnia, Temesvar, Dobruja, Ludgorie, Wallachia and Thrace, were left pacified. Stephanos retired to his capital and administered the doing of his Empire until the end of 1400. Now if only the Asian Greeks could be liberated from the fearful grip of Islam.

THE JIHADINE NAVY OF EL RAHJETAKU

Mohammad

DIPLOMACY: none

Mohammad lent his ships to the Caliph so that the Dulio pirates could be sunk. Most of the ships (305 galleys) returned to the Kyklades. Al Berayn went ashore and began to do what Rahjetahud was supposed to do and that was convert regions to Islam. He lifted the Optimaton garrison (letting them go free for the time being) and attacked Paphlagonia with 27,500 jihadin cavalry. At the end of 1397, Paphlagonia was converted to Sunni Muslim. 2500 died for this heroic effort. Optimaton was reattacked and converted in 1398. The battle was rough, another 3500 cavalry died. In 1399, was Bithnia's turn. The locals fought hard killing 2500 infantry but in the end succumbed to the crescent moon. Fairly in 1400, Al Berayn with 13,000 horse archers and 10,000 infantry, mostly light put the sword of Islam to Lydia. 4500 foot soldiers died in the engagement in the bloodiest conversion yet. Al Berayn was lucky not to have been killed in these campaigns. There were five regions left to be force-fed the Koran including the Kyklades. The Jihad having been sated, the jihadin cavalry are now just normal cavalry. It's not going to be so easy.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILICALIPHATEAn Nasir, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Caliphate gained mastery of the Mediterranean by building a navy of over 1500 vessels. Karbogha admired these plus the lent Rahjetahud craft and defeated the Dulio fleet at the battle of Kolpos Kissamou. Now the Arabs were free to unload the troops and equipment (17,000 heavy infantry, 20,000 archers and 1500 battering rams) in Crete and converted the lot of them to Sunni Muslim. Both Candia and the Crete citadel had to be captured before sword pointed evangelicalism could begin. Bin Ardin was killed taking the citadel with the city

already captured. Karbogha took command of the ground force and beat some Islam sense into the islanders' craniums. The resistance was easily beaten up.

In Palmyra, Mardin city was created. Al Mutawakkil's life was cut short by the flu. The vizier Ishak Hafiz is keeping things in order for the new Caliph An Nasir (a 6 year old brat who likes to fight cats on fire).

THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAY - Yuhana FactionYuhana bin Isma'il, *"The Conqueror", Shah of Ray*

DIPLOMACY: none

Yuhana hired 10,000 mercenary cavalry and 25 mercenary siege and headed back to his homeland. The old man took back Tabaristan, easily assaulted the Alamut fortress. Daylam and Arran were nabbed before Yuhana turned back to attack Kumis. Batin hid within Ray's 20 foot palisades, but Batin was stupid. Yuhana outfoxed his unworthy son and captured the capital from the back door. Batin was killed and Yuhana adopted his grandchildren. Before Yuhana took a break, Zagros was regained. Yuhana's lack of control continued to plague him: Khokhand, Khwarzim, Kyzil-Kum, Uzbek rebelled. Can you say O-Ver-Ex-Tend-Ed?

THE PARTHID SHAHDOM OF RAY - Batin Faction

Those regions not taken by Yuhana (Dasht Kavir, Georgia and Khurasan) reverted to neutrality.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTANBayezid, *Sultan of Afghans*

DIPLOMACY: Khutla(ea)

The Ghorids rebuilt Akata in distant Ghebel Gharib along the Red Sea. Abbas Ughat died in 1400 and was succeeded by his son Bayezid. Abdul Jekki also passed away leaving two tribes waiting for a home in Shadad. The new Sultan see opportunities in the air.

India

Merces: 10mwe, 10mhc, 30mc

THE HARAYUK RAJPUT EMPIRERupika Isanavara, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*

DIPLOMACY: Maghada(t)

The Harayuk saw to it that no Shagunga presence was tolerated in Maghada. Charukapa noticed that this time Maghada would listen only to him. Multan grew to 5 GPv. As stated before, Isanavara wasn't that great a ruler. His ability to control distant regions was next to zero. Sukkur rebelled. Santanu has become a separate nation. So much for trade with Liguria.

THE SANTANU KINGDOM OF GOBLIGUK

Santanu Sholalita II

DIPLOMACY: none

The Santanu domain (Kutch, Goa, Surashtra and Somanatha) is now ruled by Sholalita II. They trade with Liguria and Chalukya.

THE CHALUKYA KINGDOM OF BANAVASI

Chalukya Saivehesa

DIPLOMACY: Andhra(ea)

Saivehesa made certain that no one snuck into his bedroom at night. Polonarya is a better place to dwell in.

THE SHAGUNGA EMPIREDhruva Shagunga, *Emperor of Konorak*

DIPLOMACY: Kosala(rt)

The port city of Jaipur was built in Nadavaria on the Bay of Bengal. The Burmese sent a few silver coins.

THE ASSAM KINGDOM

U Pyaw (Upalivaman)

DIPLOMACY: none

U Pyaw took the Assam part of the Burmese Kingdom. This consists of Assam, Samatata (with its new city), Manipur, Gtsang and Tibet.

South-East Asia

Merces: 5mwe, 20mhi, 20mi, 10mw

THE KINGDOM OF PAGANBommua Ran, *King of Pagan*

DIPLOMACY: none

Taninangwe Umon finally stirred into action doing many things. Aniruddhan, Pagan, Manglu and Lhasa expanded. Chittagong was rebuilt, Samatata's port city. A royal road was constructed linking Pagan and Bassein. Then the king headed south with 7000 cavalry, 22,000 heavy infantry, 5000 regulars and 1000 catapults to fight Java, sort of. In 1397, the king arrived in Perak and wondered what to do. Eventually someone in his intelligence staff tapped him on the shoulder and told him that he was supposed to Attack Perak.

"Oh really?"

So Perak was pacified. The defenseless city of Malacca was also taken. Taninangwe took his time while in Johor and eventually Singapore was occupied.

Due to Tanagerwe's distance from Pagan, Binnya Ran, his son, declared his father had died in battle. Binnya Ran was opposed of course by his old man and the two generals who went with him. Binnya told everyone that his father is now dead and is being impersonated by a puppet of the two rebel generals who killed him. U Pyaw a man sent to Aniruddhan wouldn't have anything to do with either and broke off his own kingdom called Assam. After some dynastic struggles, Binnya Ran got control of much of the Pagan Kingdom: Burma, Assam, Pegu, Korai, Kayah, Thaton and Lampang. He also controls much of the infrastructure, most of intel and the university. Padishan and Sagaing revolted.

THE MYANMARI KINGDOM OF KWA

Tanagerwe Umon *King of Kwa, Maharaja Myanmar*
DIPLOMACY: none

Having been dispossessed by his own flesh and blood, Tanagerwe Umon and his loyal generals. Hkonmaing and Kaw Man, got control of Kwa, pacified Kwa and Johor, Siam, Mon and Dvaravati. He has most of the bureaucracy and much of the military.

CRISIS IN INDONESIA (1385-1400+)

Chekiang, Vietnam, Makassar, Bengkulu, Burma vs. Java

1396

Monsoon Mau hired the Indonesian mercenaries, outbidding the Burmese for their services. He and Viceregal forces left the vicinity of Saigon and headed up the coastal road to Thanglong, granted free passage by the Vietnamese.

At Prambanan, the Aquarium leader Chahandrasam raised a war fleet of 250 ships. He departed the capital and joined King Long Joe Mo at Srivijaya. From Linan, two Chinese armies: The navy of Quai Chang and a newly recruited force of Zhen Ju headed to Thanglong to rendezvous with Monsoon Mau. They were joined by the Chekiang ally from Kedah and naturally enough Vietnamese forces marshaled by Quoi Udon. Including the Chinese mercenaries, this force consisted of 1275 mostly Chekiang elite chuanbo, 135 mercenary Makassar and Kedahi galleys, 450 junks Chinese and Vietnamese, 250 mercenary war elephants from the highlands of Hmong, 20,000 elite halberdiers, 15,000 elite longbowmen, 15,000 heavy swordsmen, 21,000 standard soldiers, 15,000 elite knights, 11,500 elite horse-archers, 3000 lancers and 5500 light cavalry and 750 catapults. The catapults had to be left behind because there wasn't enough room on the warships and transports.

1397

Monsoon Mau and Quai Chang, co-commandants of this great force sailed south in the South China Seas to the Riouw Sea. There Monsoon Mau was assassinated despite the wards placed against that by Chinese and Vietnamese agents. Quai Chang, Quoi Udon and Zhen Ju powwowed together and determined to jointly command the Makassar army and carry out Mau's battle plans. They would decide who would take over and how Makassar would be ruled later.

At the conclusion of 1397, the allied forces seized some of Singhasari's coastal fleets, throwing the crewmen overboard and used the ships to construct a temporary harbor. Some were used as breakwater. The remainder of them were torn apart to be used as a causeway to quickly unload the troops off the allied navy.

In Malaysia in the spring, the Burmese arrived at Perak and stood around a whole year wondering what they should do.

1398

The Makassar allied army were amazed just how easy it was to conquer Kediri. Singhasari fell easily without any defenses. A Makassar garrison was left to control the region.

The Burmese attacked Perak and its city Malacca. Tanagerwe Umon felt like he accomplished something.

1399

The Chinese-Viet expedition to prop up Makassar conquered Pajajaran and its city Prambanan. This was Java's capital. Their treasury and university were put to the Makassar trust pool. A lot of coastal fleets captured in the harbor were also placed under Makassar ownership.

Tanagerwe Umon entered Johor and then forgot what he and his army were supposed to do.

1400

Tanagerwe Umon finally figured out that Johor should be pacified too. Singapore and its ships were seized. Tanagerwe's absentminded efforts were rewarded with major rebellions in Assam and Pagan. Tanagerwe became King of Kwa with his capital at the Golden Portals of the Serpent Queen.

In the south, the Chinese and Vietnamese allies attacked to make protectorate Sunda. The resistance was light. There wasn't enough time to cross the ferry arrow to Lampung so the expedition retired in the jungle. They eventually fell fighting among themselves. Both Chinese and Vietnamese leaders were outside their respective Kings' command control radii. Of these the Kedah and Zhen Ju rebelled from the Dragon. Zhen Ju had a force of 40,000 heavy-light, elite-regular infantry. Furthermore, none of the fireworks he brought had been used yet. He used these to blast away Quoi Udon and Quai Chang and the feared Vietnamese cavalry charge. Quoi Udon and Quai Chang boarded their fleets and fled to Belitung, both did not want to work with Zhen Ju again.

Zhen Ju declared himself the new Viceroy of Makassar and appealed to the Vietnamese King for recognition (despite his crimes done against Vietnamese armies). He took over the Makassar armies plus the Makassar trust pool. Monsoon Mau's infant son conveniently vanished.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

Long Joe Mo, *King of the Spice Islands*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Java built a few more warships and huddled in Srivijaya. But by not protecting their homeland, the Aquarium suffered a government collapse when

allied forces occupied Pajajaran. Long Joe Mo lost his son when Singhasari was lost. Moluccas and Mindanao rebelled due to distance.

THE VICEROYALTY OF MAKASSAR

Zhen Ju, *Viceroy of Makassar*

DIPLOMACY: none

With all the merchant fleets around and an army of 41,500 intact, Zhen Ju can continue the invasion of Java on his own. The problem is that the Java army hasn't come out to fight yet. the Viceroy could use a friendly capital city.

China

Mercs: 5mehc, 5mec, 10mehi, 10mei, 10mew

THE DAI VIET GUO

Van Nguyen, *Wang Dai Viet*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Vietnamese toasted Monsoon Mau for his bravery and his victory against the Java fleet in recent years. He was sent off to Java with the Vietnamese leader Quoi Udon. Monsoon Mau held it all together. His death in 1397 was a tragedy. Fortunately, the alliance held together long enough to conquer the entire island of Java and hand it over to Makassar authorities, if one can call them that. Personality conflicts finally came to a head in 1400 when Quoi Udon sided with the Quai Chang against Zhen Ju and his feud with the venerable general. Zhen Ju did the unthinkable and turned the deadly fireworks ('flame spurting lances', 'infernal exploding balls', 'divine lightning arrows' and 'earth-shaking thunder devices') against Quoi Udon's cavalcade. Quoi Udon fled with Quai Chang demanding vengeance against Zhen Ju but knew that the serene Van Nguyen would never allow it.

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANG

Quan Zinco, *Celestial Emperor of Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: none

Despite Zhen Ju and Fomoi of Kedah's treachery, the Dragon was overall pleased over the campaign to convert Java into seaflood. Efforts to get Perak and Johor to revolt were rendered moot by the Kwa-Burmese.

THE CIAO CHINESE KINGDOM

Hiacian, *King of the Northern Prefectures*

The old horde practice of slavery was outlawed and the economy was transformed to guild labor. A new imperial road was built from Sarchou to Taiyuan north to Tatung. With this new spur, the Ciao road system has become better than that of their southern neighbors, the Chekiang.

THE NIHON EMPIRE

Tenno Komyo, *85th Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu*

The Japanese improved city public works in three of their cities. Hokii moved across the Dozen Wan to Silla but had no further orders.

Fire Between the Fixed Stars, *Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

DIPLOMACY: none

Stormbringer expanded yet again. A fishing fleet was added in hopes that everyone would eat better. But the harvest was real bad. Many people went on fasts.

THE DARK LAND OF AANX

Kuveras Shadowsinger, *Holy Sahdus of the Akettu, Master of Kabbadi*

DIPLOMACY: none

Vishu Darkheart died before there were problems.

THE AKETTA IMPERIUM

Janggala, *Sorceress-Queen of the Aketta*

DIPLOMACY: none

More fishing fleets were approved to alleviate a possible disastrous famine.

THE NEW WORLD

The Grand Massif

Mercs: 10mi

BONNY KINGDOM OF MERCAIN

Angus II, *Elder King of the Land*

DIPLOMACY: Micmac(c), Huron(ni), Sesquehanna(c)

The elusive land of Micmac was finally claimed by the kingdom. It had been so long. Valentine's productive reign ended when he died at the age of 62. Caranook transformed into a cultivated region thanks to Bath's influence. Cavalry Count: 44 years.

THE CHOWAN SUPREMACYMassapagua II, *Chief of Chowan*

The Supremacy also had a death in the ruling family.
