[2.3.2] **ITV Calculation Clarification:** Because an Internal coastal trade fleet (20msp) acts as if it is a 1 GPv city for purposes of income generation, the third paragraph of [2.3.2] in the 5th Edition Rulebook should read:

"In Addition... your ITV is increased... by one-third for each 20 Merchant Shipping points on Internal Trade..."

LORDS 10 UNIT CONVERSION

Each point of cavalry and infantry (light or heavy) represents 500 fighting men. A transport or warship point = 5 ships with 100 men aboard. A siege point = 5 siege towers or 50 catapults or 500 sappers. A war elephant point = 50 elephants ridden by mahouts. A field fort point = 5 forts manned by 100 men each. A wall point = 10 feet of wall ramparts. An artillery point = 5 guns and assorted men.

AFRICA

West Africa

Merces: 20mi

THE AKA'MURRIDEMIRATE OF FULANI

Seldez, *Emir of the Fulani*
 DIPLOMACY: Segu(f), Adwaghost(nt), Gwari(n)

The armies of Fulani marched to the frontier to deal with the rebellious frontier zones and the nations that court them. The Lord of Kurfei managed to convince Gwari not to honor the Bomu villains. Elsewhere, things weren't so smooth. Estavan and his patrol of 15,000 'goose' riders visited Kham and Gambia but failed to gain any grub for the fat king. The Almoravids are not going away from Gambia. Yoruba, which revolted not long before, was the subject of a

planned attack by Mohammad and 10,000 butter whackers. Upon reaching Yoruba's border, Mohammad was wounded by a fool-man (dressed in bangles) who couldn't subvert him. Soon after, Yoruba became a part of the Togo Kingdom. You could hear Seldez miles from his golden hut, "I hate those foreigners!" Gao grew to 5 GPv.

By building a city level for Leopards (now 5 GPv), the Togo won the undying love of the Yoruba people. Then the evil Fulani came back, 'threatening' the poor Yoruba, but were 'cowed' by the awesome magnificence of Togo arms. It was a good thing, Okbewto was oozing for a bruising. The land prepared for bad harvests that never came.

THE BANTU KINGS OF KONGO

Npotagui, *King of Ba-Congo*
 DIPLOMACY: Lunda(a), Kwararafa(n), Ife(fa)

 DIPLOMACY: none
 Kankarunka died a miser.

THE KRAKAS KINGDOM OF AETHIOPIA

Dahangeo Krakas, Ben Unis, *King of Aethiopia*
 DIPLOMACY: none

There was peace in the prosperous, rich land. Bur Sudan, Massawa, Aseb, Kenma, Luxor, Dongola, Amada and Djibouti grew bigger. The sand merchants are in deadly competition with each other. It seems the sand cartel has collapsed.

EUROPE

Western Europe

Merces: 10mc, 10mi, 10mw

THE SULTANATE OF IEST

Ahmad
 DIPLOMACY: none

Cities were rebuilt in Faiyum (Bani Suwayf) and Sardinia (Cagliari). Iest grew to 6 GPv. The vizier Duben died when his parrot died in 1408. Saxonia sent much gold to Ahmad's bank for the Iesti surplus wheat. In the sewers, rats multiplied.

THE COUNTY OF CONNAUGHT

Pitooy Mac Duc, *Count of Connaught*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Whatever Connaught was supposed to be doing, they're not doing it. The Papacy supported it though.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF ENGLAND

Eric, *King of England*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Even as the army and navy tensed their limbs for potential invasion, there was some increased economic activity. London and Helston grew to 7 GPv and Ipswich got to 6 GPv. Food prices soared up to unheard of levels.

THE NORMAN KINGDOM OF SAXONIA

William (III) the Cavalier, *King of the Saxons and of the Normans, Count of Blois*
 DIPLOMACY: Maine(t), Auvergne(nt)

More of Saxonia's military was retained to build new merchant ships in the southern ports. Money was paid to Muslim and Danish merchants for surplus grain. Saxonia's urban capacity was great and someday a famine might cause starvation. That was no longer a problem and now storage is an issue. A trade connection was made with the Great Caliph of Baghdad.

THE ALMORAVID EMIRATE OF ANDALUSIA

Marwan II, *Emir as Sevilla*
 DIPLOMACY: Gambia(ta)

Saxon gold bought Andalusian bread. The money went to a big festival celebrating the farmer (though the best farmers got most of the glory). It was a good idea to cheer up the dirt plodders because the Mahgrab is getting heavily urbanized. There may come a day when the farmers will stop growing food for other people, just because of all those farmer jokes. Agadir, Cordoba, Toledo grew larger. A royal road spanned from Porto to Leon. Ezzim enjoyed his nutcake in Gambia even with the Futani army watching him in chagrin.

THE LIGURIAN KINGDOM OF ITALY

Marcus, *Rex Lagobardum*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Orazio and his fleet arrived to Corsica first and pacified the island with 30,000 infantry and 1500 cavalry (10,000 cavalry was planned but they couldn't fit in the low cargo capacity warship). Since the islanders were already Roman Catholic there wasn't any need to convert them by force. Gezil's military posse caught no major crime lords. Tarantura, Reggio, Napoli, Marseilles, Pescara, Livorno and Venezia grew to 6 GPv. Genova is 7 GPv.

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH

Benedict X, *Bishop of Rome, Vicar of Christ, Servant of the Servants of God, Supreme Pontiff on the Universal Church*
 DIPLOMACY: none

The Pontiff sent Church aid to the Baltic Kingdoms and the Irish. Scholarly support assisted Novgorod and Thaurian colleges. Abbeys were built in Holland and Ipswich. Monasteries were canonized in Friesland and Hull. Cathedrals became consecrated in Lithuania, Kaluga, Helston and Vitebsk. The Muslim heresy in Corsica was eliminated by Cardinal Drieti even as Ligurian forces occupied that hilly island.

North African spies were caught skulking in the Vatican. They were promptly imprisoned.

Eastern Europe

THE REPUBLIC OF STYRIA

Rolfo Untero, *Grand Doge of Trngau*
 DIPLOMACY: Swabia(a)

A Styrian army loaded up on newly built transports to finally take control of Corsica after so many delays and snafus. By the end of 1406 they arrived one year too late. The Ligurians had already pacified and were making sure there were no Muslims left. Discretion being valor's dirty little secret, the expedition commander Kawelt Panur returned home. The Inner Council voted to keep Rolfo after a motion was made to remove him.

THE NORDIK KINGDOM OF THAERY

Brant, *King of the Danes*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Like the Moors, the Danes sold their surplus harvest to the Saxons. The navies were poised to foil more piracy attempts. All word of Knut Ulang's exploration of Vinland was lost in 1407. Avente grew to 4 GPv. København, 5.

THE GRAND PRINCIPALITY OF WARSAW

Casil Boshnik, *Great Prince of Warsaw*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Two Warsaw armies headed southeast to reclaim the lost land of Kiev, lost in the past by Byzantine diplomatic pressure. This wouldn't be a problem now - there was no Emperor to stop them this time. Jivan Halazar and a newly formed elite corp of 15,000 cavalry and 15,000 infantry plus 13,500 regular auxiliaries made it to Kiev by the end of 1405. They assaulted the city in spring of 1406 and the fortress Hordgrad in the summer. No casualties were inflicted now Halazar had to wait for the other general Casil Boshnik with 59,000 cavalry so that together they could essay an invasion of Aelkuzo. Boshnik was, however, disloyal. After raiding Ozu, he attacked Halazar while shouting his intentions to overthrow Queen Kelsida. Halazar was a smart general and drove the superior numbered cavalry from Kiev but paid a heavy price doing that. Jivan was captured by Casil Boshnik who still having 47,000 knights marched on Warsaw, assaulted the city and deposed the Queens. The government suffered as Boshnik purged those who would not swear loyalty to him. He gained control of the entire country except for Halazar's army occupying Kiev. For that Halazar was executed and plans were made to put pressure on the rival army who has declared Boshnik a tyrant and is calling for a restoration of Queen Kelsida. The claim on Prussia was forfeit.

THE PRINCIPALITY OF KIEV

Othovo Halazar, *Prince of Kiev*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Othovo Halazar, brother of the late Jivan Halazar, could only hold on to Kiev for Casil Boshnik proved to be a powerful influence on the home city.

THE KINGDOM OF THE BALTS

Vladimir, *King of Baltica, Prince of Novgorod*
 DIPLOMACY: Viatka(a), Kalinin(t), Kaluga(ea)

Prince Ivan headed to Viatka and married a really ugly duchess who lived in Viatka. She was fertile, though, and produced three little monsters (For those of you living in Chicago, they are the vampire, the frankenstein and the wolfman) for her grateful husband. The Church supported the Baltic Kingdom in many ways. Vitebsk grew to 2 gold levels. Novgorod has gotten its 6th GPv. Trade with the Mahatomen conquerors of Asia started.

THE BALTIC PRINCIPATE ON THE VOLGA

Nikolai Yaskusk, *Prince of Kubishev*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Pope sent a lot of cash to this little place. Nikolai could ask for no more.

THE DIHAJ HOST

Tagaktu, *Mighty Servant of Allah*
 DIPLOMACY: none

The Dihaj host had enough with the threat and decided to challenge the Blubog head on. Tagaktu bravely led 35,500 riders against Cim. The defenders of Cim were 42,000 nomads led by 'Grapehead' Blubogikan, already ticked off because somebody tried to kill him with a sharp rock. Tagaktu possessed the tactical edge and ambushed the Blubog multitude at the valley of Tawonk in September 1406. Blubogikan withdrew his horde to Emba and did not protect Blubog territory on the Dihaj side of the Urals. Cim was completely enslaved by the time spring rolled in 1406. Burdened with captured humans, Tagaktu realized he could not dispossess Uze so he returned to Khazar with the thralls.

A port area was built in Taman named after the Host Leader. Maniak defended the new facility.

ASIA**The Middle East**

THE PSECHULEN ROMAN EMPIRE

Maximilian Psechulen, *Imperator Romanus Orientalis, Despot of Crimea*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Demetrios died in 1408 of Swine Fever. In his final years, he did nothing while the Poles conquered Kiev.

THE EMPIRE OF ABYDUS

Theopilos Comnenus, *Imperator Romanus Orientalis*
 DIPLOMACY: Serbia(t)

The Abydus giggled when he heard of Psechulen's latest problem. Still something has to be done about the Saracens of Asia. Corinth grew to 6 GPv.

AL RAHJETALUDEMIRAT

Ibn Mohammad, *Emir of Asia*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Mohammad's uninspired reign ended with his death in 1408. He had a son who came of age just in time. Ibn Mohammad is a dynamic kid, everyone wonders what he's going to do.

THE DAR AL ISLAM - ARBILIQ CALIPHATE

An Nasir, *Kalifat Rasul Allah, Commander of the Faithful*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Sixteen cities expanded for the greater glory of Allah. A new town, Hawalli, was founded to be Kuwait's port.

THE KAHINDARID SHAHDOM OF RAY

Al Kahindar, *Shah of Ray*
 DIPLOMACY: Khurasan(a), Dasht Kavir(nt)

Kahindar was a different sort of ruler than his predecessor. He preferred negotiated over conquest. He was a wise administrator, too. No one wanted to revolt. Kids made 'I love K'ndar' banners and hung them on buildings.

THE GHORID SULTANATE OF AFGHANISTAN

Bayezid, *Sultan of Afghans*
 DIPLOMACY: Khuttak(t)

Bayezid wised up and formed an outpost fleet to communicate with the distant port of Akata. With Khuttak friendly, Suleiman the Glib Voice looked at Ushrusana with a longing in his soul.

India

Mercs: 10mwe, 30mc

THE HARA YUK RAJPUT EMPIRERupika Isanavara, *Khan of Khans, Master of Kaunaj*

DIPLOMACY: Maghada(a)

The last of the horde tribes were used to expand Kaunaj, Multan and Khairpur.

THE SANTANU KINGDOM OF GOBLIGUK

Santunu Sholalita II

DIPLOMACY: none

The Santanu wallowed in their liberty.

THE CHALUKYA KINGDOM OF BANAVASI

Chalukya Saivehesa

DIPLOMACY: Dravida(a), Madurai(ea)

The mostly hidden Prince Pulakesin found a wife in Dravida. Konkan returned to cultivated. The devastation wrought by the Mongols a generation ago has almost been fully healed. A scaly lizard-man dropped a note at Saivehesa's mailbox and it warned, "The Sea Zones Conspire Against You!"

THE SHAGUNGA EMPIREDhruva Shagunga, *Emperor of Konorak*

DIPLOMACY: none

Dhruva wouldn't miss an opportunity staring him in the face. He took his little army (14,000 men armed with drums, flutes and bells) and invaded Assam. There was a defender there, Lakrap with 5000 men. They were wiped out. Aniruddhan was sacked because Dhruva was in a destructive mode. The Assam treasury was captured.

THE ASSAM KINGDOM

Pynmana

DIPLOMACY: none

Pynmana withdrew from Kwa in 1406 when the Vietnamese invaded. He retired to Chittagong which he set up as his new capital because Assam had been invaded by the Shagunga. Aniruddhan's fall spelled doom for the remainder of the Assamese government. Now isolated, Gtsang and Tibet, remained true to Pynmana. Refugees from ruined Aniruddhan have come Samatata.

South-East Asia

Mercs: 5mwe, 30mi, 10mw

THE MYANMARI KINGDOM OF KWAHkonmaing, *King of Kwa, Maharaja Myanmar*

DIPLOMACY: Thaton(nt), Kayah(hs)

Hkonmaing's army assisted Saluta's effort to regain Thaton by peaceful means. This prevented Hkonmaing from wasting his army against the 70 foot walls of Fido-town and Fort Fido. Hkonmaing wonders if it was used to let the Vietnamese occupy the symbolic homeland.

CRISIS IN INDONESIA (1385-1408+)

Burmese Civil War: Assam vs. Kwa, Vietnam

Java War: Vietnam, Makassar vs. Java

The Burmese Civil War widened when Shagunga invaded Assam, joining Vietnam and Kwain forces in the festival. Assam's set backs didn't kill them. The crafty Pynmana consolidated his forces at Samatata, preparing to make a final stand.

The Java War intensified as desperation set in for both sides. Java fought for its survival. Makassar fought to protect their new found homes. In 1405, the Java army again tried an attack against Makassar across the Selat Strait into Sunda. By 1406, they made it ashore only to come across a superior army. 21,500 elite cavalry, 12,500 mercenary infantry, 20,000 elite Makassar legionnaires, 4500 Makassar spearmen and 12,500 Vietnamese mercenaries. Long Joe Mo who led the last Java army was killed at Rangu Farms where battle was met. The Java force was wiped out. With all Javans removed from Sunda, Java warships (though Java commander Xhoi Bao was injured) along with local Makassar ships cleared the Selat Strait of the Java Navy and their leader 'King' Chahandrasam. At the end of 1406, Lampung was occupied. There had been no resistance. There would be no further resistance. So Srivijaya was occupied early in 1407. All other Java lands had repudiated the Aquarium to face a cruel, uncertain future. In 1408, Makassar troops pacified Jambi and then returned home.

THE AQUARIUM OF JAVA

The Aquarium's long history ended after so much abuse by its enemies. At one point all the islands were under Java's control but no more. Aijeh, Bali, Barat, Johor, Medan, Mindanao, Moluccas, Perak, Sabah, Sarawak, Sulawesi and Timor have become neutral land.

THE VICEROYALTY OF MAKASSARZhen Ju, *Viceroy of Makassar, Destroyer of Fish*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Makassar found themselves victors of the Jeweled Scepter of Indonesia.

THE BAJAH PIRATES

Koturako

DIPLOMACY: none

Even as the Java juggernaut sunk beneath the waves, sharks from New Guinea have come to devour the floating carcass. A fleet of 120 warships and two tribes are the sea nomads who follow the pirate-king. They have moored their ships at Kepeluan one days' sailing from now neutral Moluccas.

China

Mercs: 10mec, 20mei, 10mew

THE DAI VIET GUOTriang, *Wang Dai Viet*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Viet navy headed off from Tonkin's leafy shore in 1405, splitting in two in the Penunjuk Wan. One went inland to confront the Assamese occupation of Kwa. This was led by Quoi Udou, a veteran of the Java conflict. Quoi easily won Kwa as the Assamese fled like cowardly mongrels. In Kwa was built the port fortress facing the Penunjuk Wan intended for Vietnamese purposes in their final push against the Java Aquarium. Being injured in the battle of Rangu Farms, Xhoi Bao stayed in Lampung to heal his wounds (But the GM moved him to Phan Rang by the end of 1408).

THE HIDDEN DRAGON OF CHEKIANGQuan Zinco, *Celestial Emperor of Chekiang*

DIPLOMACY: Kedah(nt)

The Emperor sent an expedition to Kedah to assert the Dragon's right to claim this outpost and use it to trade with India. Zhan Ju succeeded in this quest and came back with jade tokens. He reported that the planned port fortress was built upon the ruins of Tani. In the woods of Hunan, Jung Li ran into a red cowled man who fought without weapons. It turned out he wasn't that great a fighter and Jung Li beat him. The cowled man down and out, got up when Jung Li was looking away, and escaped into the woods. Then Jung Li discovered he was fatally poisoned and died on the spot. A new city Linchuan was built in Kanchou.

THE CIAO CHINESE KINGDOMHiacian, *King of the Northern Prefectures*

DIPLOMACY: Tsingeng(c), Wu Hai(c), Ningsia(nt)

The Yen Prince is now too old to be bored.

THE NIHON EMPIRETenno Komyo, *85th Emperor of Nihon, Descendent of Amaterasu*

DIPLOMACY: none

The Emperor hired a Karpaku because he didn't want to rule all the time.

THE ESTATE OF AKATA

Akata-no-Dachimosa

DIPLOMACY: Nigata(nt)

The North Daimyo was active, trying to talk Nigata to join. Nigata agreed to be nice to the Akata family.

Pacifica

Mercs: 10mi

THE EMPIRE OF THE STORMFire Between the Fixed Stars, *Storm King, Emperor of the Middle Kingdom*

DIPLOMACY: none

Taranaki was colonized to (2/4) for it has become cultivated. Wild River has muscled his way to the number two spot when his older brother Rumbling Mountain died.

THE DARK LAND OF AANXRuveras Shadowsinger, *Holy Sahdus of the Akettu, Master of Kabbadi*

DIPLOMACY: Tir-Ar-Dha(a)

When Ruveras found he couldn't improve relations in Ilweah, he moved on to Dajarra only to encounter the same problem.

THE VAKAS IMPERIUM OF THE AKETTAVakas Vastakuba, *Sorcerer-King of the Aketta*

DIPLOMACY: Temora(hs), Pechua(fa, lost), Taroola(hs), Maree(hs)

Janggala's lieutenant, Vastakuba, threatened Katooma and got into a fight. After beating them, the general felt his oats. He marched the army to Geelong and deposed Janggala and ancient dynasty. This caused a civil war. Ayr, Pechua and Katooma rebelled. The claim on Warrego evaporated. The Lord of Nokarna formed his own nation tasking Nokarna, Iriadh, Mungo and Paramata for his own. The new Vakas Dynasty seized control of Geelong, Walkaroo, Pechua, Cooma, Goolbura, Taree and Toowomba. The NFP pool is getting restless.

THE NOKAMA KINGDOM

Zeyoma, *Raggold Nokam*
 DIPLOMACY: none

Zeyoma has set up an imperial court in Quom. He is making plans to resist the Vakas.

THE NEW WORLD**The Grand Massif**

Mercs: 10mi, 5mc

THE ULANG DANES

Brant, *King of the Danes*

DIPLOMACY: none

85 light galleons and the fair-haired, bearded men who sailed them, landed upon the shores of Micmac. They raided the land for supplies, angering the savage natives who couldn't chase the Danes with their canoe dug-outs. Having lost contact with the motherland, Knut is on his own.

BONNY KINGDOM OF MERCAN

Angus II, *Elder King of the Land*

DIPLOMACY: Cayuga(f), Sesquehanna(c/nt)

Micmac rebelled when strange men arrived. Has more Volgars arrived to terrorize them? Bilko withdrew from Micmac to Malecite.

THE CHOWAN SUPREMACY

Massapagua II, *Chief of Chowan*

DIPLOMACY: none

Massapagua wouldn't go to Caddo so he found a wife where he was at in Yamasee.

Cavalry Count: 36 years.

THE HOPEWELL CULTURE

Snow Fox

DIPLOMACY: none

Trade expanded on existing routes.

Cavalry Count: 36 years.

LAKES WYOMING OF ILLINOIS

Little Moose

DIPLOMACY: none

Along the Chippewa-Croix border, the Duluth Canal was completed. Now the Great Lakes is connected to the Mississippi River System.

Cavalry Count: 36 years.

The Rocky Sierra Cordillera

Mercs: 10mi

MANITOWISH EMPIRE

White Tree, *Chieftess of the Manitowish Empire*

DIPLOMACY: Klamath(aw), Esselin(nt)

White Bark, one of White Tree's lieutenants, was killed by the Klamath. Klamath was so angry they declared war. Serrano and Yurok are cultivated.

Cavalry Count: 72 years.

THE POPOCELOTL KINGDOM

Acolnahuacatzin

DIPLOMACY: Mescalero(f), Tarahumar(☞)

Axolci of Tarahumar was made a family member, marrying Acolnahuacatzin's oldest grand-daughter.

Cavalry Count: 58 years

OAXACA

Chiconatl, *King of Oaxaca, Lord of the Maya, Master of the Otomi, Leader of the Quetzal World, Emperor of Mexico*

DIPLOMACY: none

A city, Armu, was built as promised in Guayami. There is a harbor facing the Sea of Panama there. Chiconatl went home.

South America

Mercs: 10mi

PARAIBA

Quishula, *Chief of the Paraiba*

DIPLOMACY: none

New City grew to 3 GPv. Araceta is now 2 GPv. There is coastal trade as well.

TUPINACOBA

Green Gill Fold

DIPLOMACY: none

The itch to attack something led to Dogbiter's tragic invasion of the steppe land of Guarani. The 13,500 Tupi fighters got in a bloody battle against the 9000 plains-creepers. Dogbiter was killed and the survivors fled to Parana. Imbituba grew 2 GPv.
